PERFORMANCE CURVES**MAXIMUM ON-STATE CHARACTERISTICS****RATED SURGE ON-STATE CURRENT**

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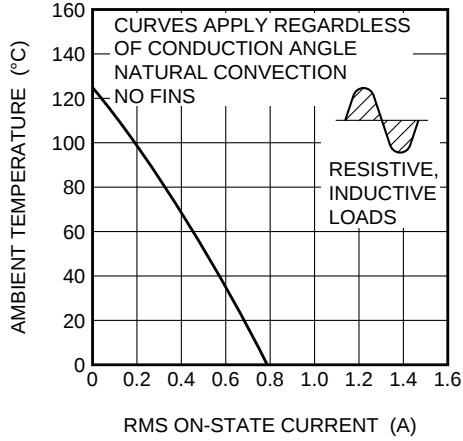

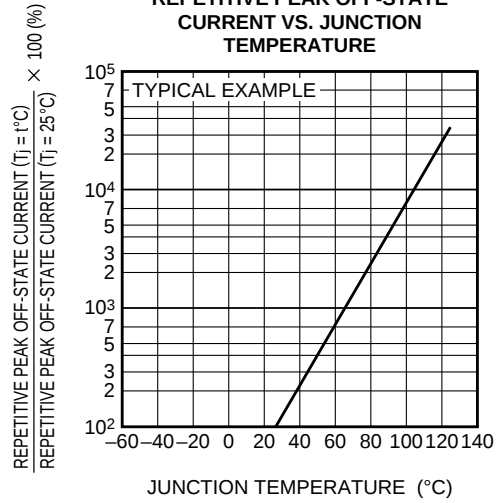

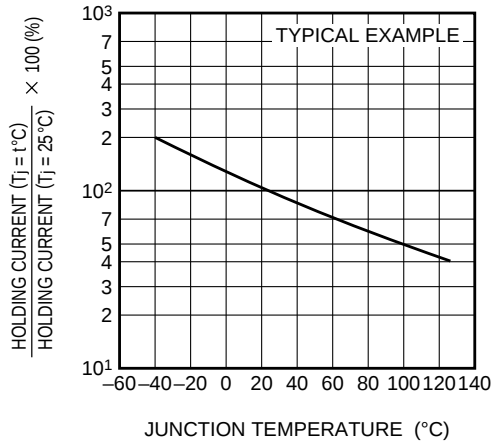
ALLOWABLE AMBIENT TEMPERATURE
VS. RMS ON-STATE CURRENT



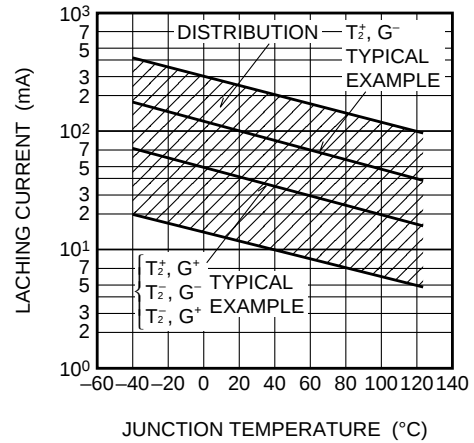
REPETITIVE PEAK OFF-STATE

TEMPERATURE



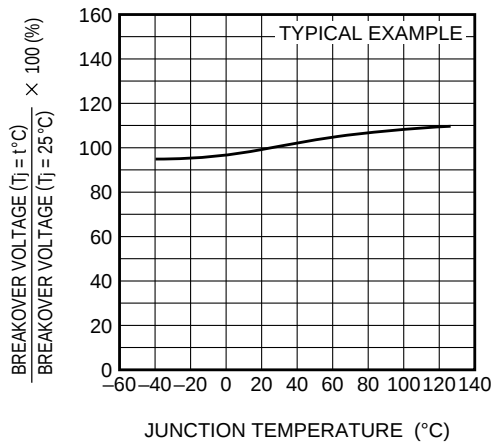
HOLDING CURRENT VS.
JUNCTION TEMPERATURE



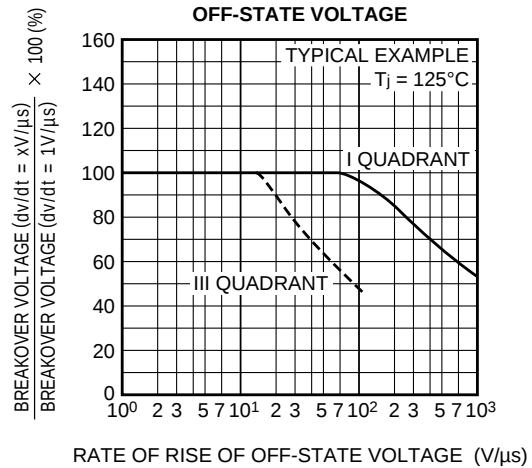
LACHING CURRENT VS.

JUNCTION TEMPERATURE

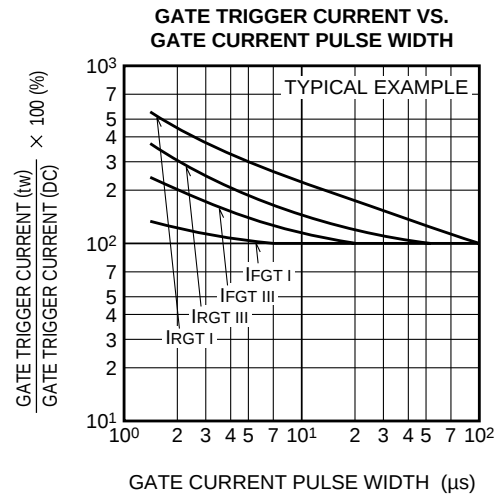
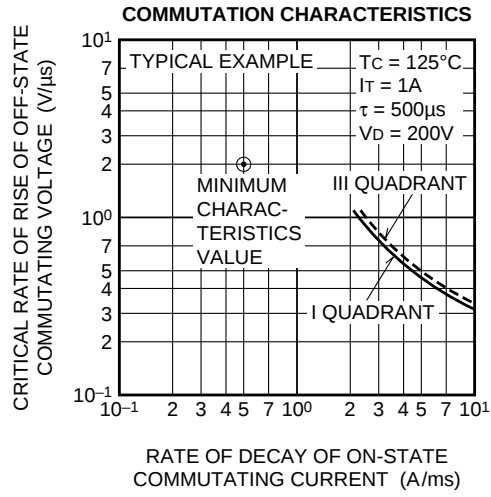


BREAKOVER VOLTAGE VS.
