Remarks:

If special sorting is required (e.g. binning based on forward voltage, luminous intensity/ luminous flux or wavelength), the typical accuracy of the sorting process is as follows:

1. Wavelength: $\pm 1\text{nm}$
2. Luminous Intensity/ Luminous Flux: $\pm 15\%$
3. Forward Voltage: $\pm 0.1\text{V}$

Note: Accuracy may depend on the sorting parameters.
