

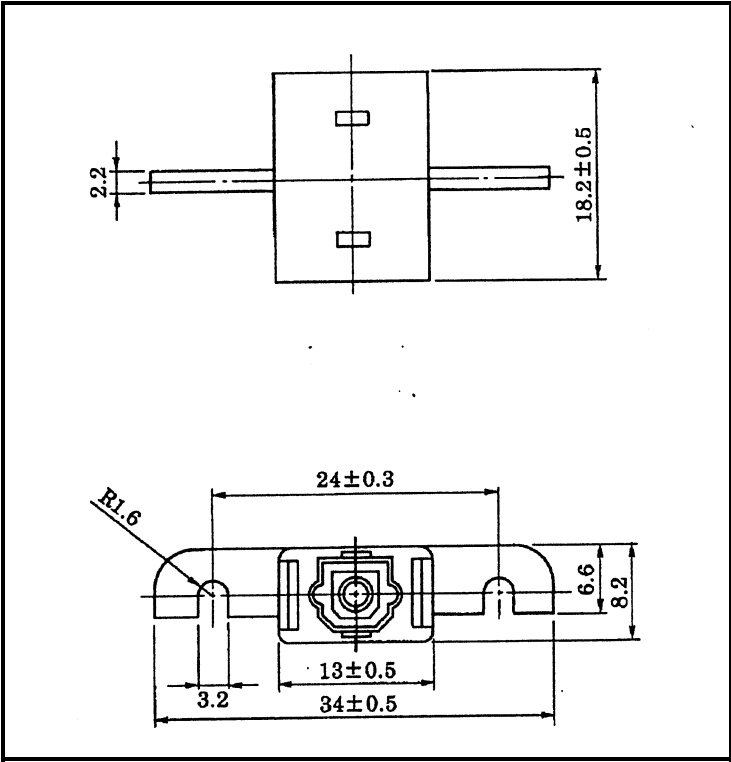

3. Precautions for Operation

- (2) Do not use for fiber optic connectors TOCP155 / TOCP155P / TOCP101Q / TOCP101X / TOCP156Q and TOCP156X.

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
