

# NBXDBA015, NBXDDB015

## 3.3 V, 200.0 MHz/206.9 MHz Dual Frequency LVPECL Clock Oscillator

The NBXDBA015/NBXDDB015 dual frequency crystal oscillator (XO) is designed to meet today's requirements for 3.3 V LVPECL clock generation applications. The device uses a high Q fundamental crystal and Phase Lock Loop (PLL) multiplier to provide selectable 200.0 MHz or 206.9 MHz, ultra low jitter and phase noise LVPECL differential output.

This device is a member of ON Semiconductor's PureEdge™ clock family that provides accurate and precision clock solutions.

Available in 5 mm x 7 mm SMD (CLCC) package on 16 mm tape and reel in quantities of 1,000. Frequency stability options available as either 50 PPM NBXDBA015 or 20 PPM NBXDDB015\*.

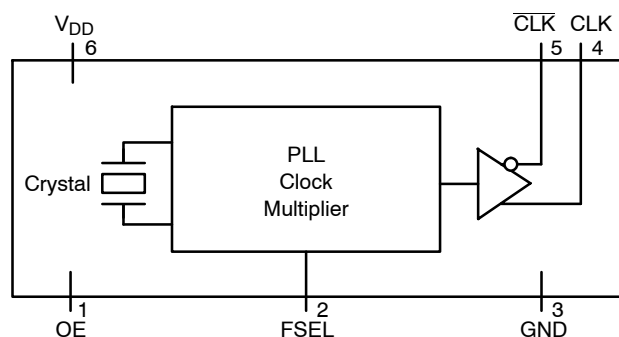
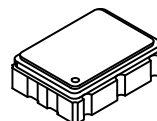


Figure 1. Simplified Logic Diagram



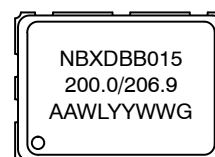
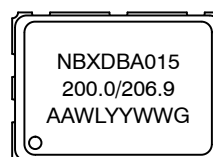

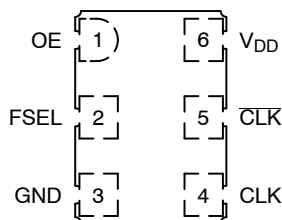

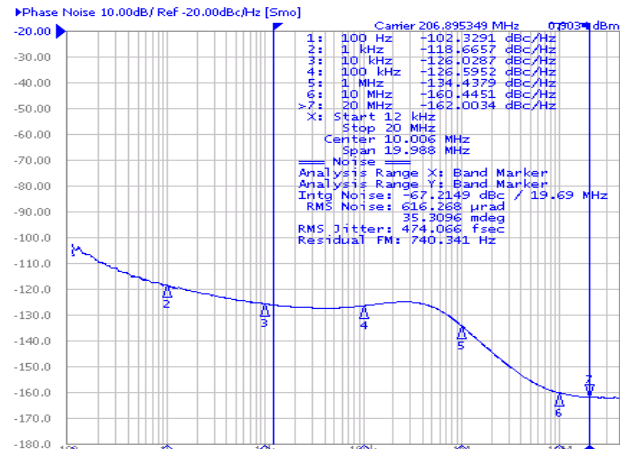

**Figure 3. Typical Phase Noise Plot @ 200 MHz**

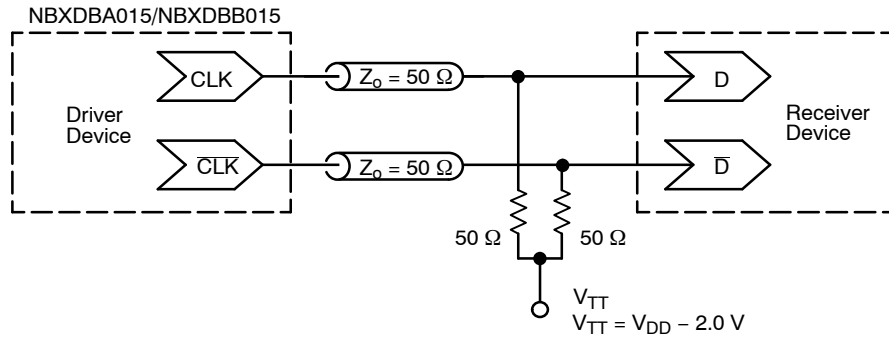


**Figure 4. Typical Phase Noise Plot @ 206.9 MHz**

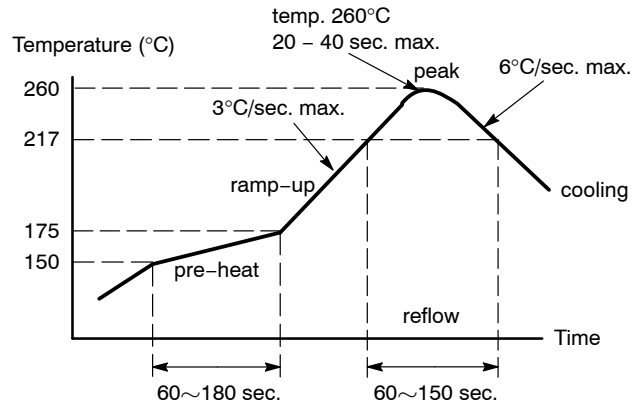

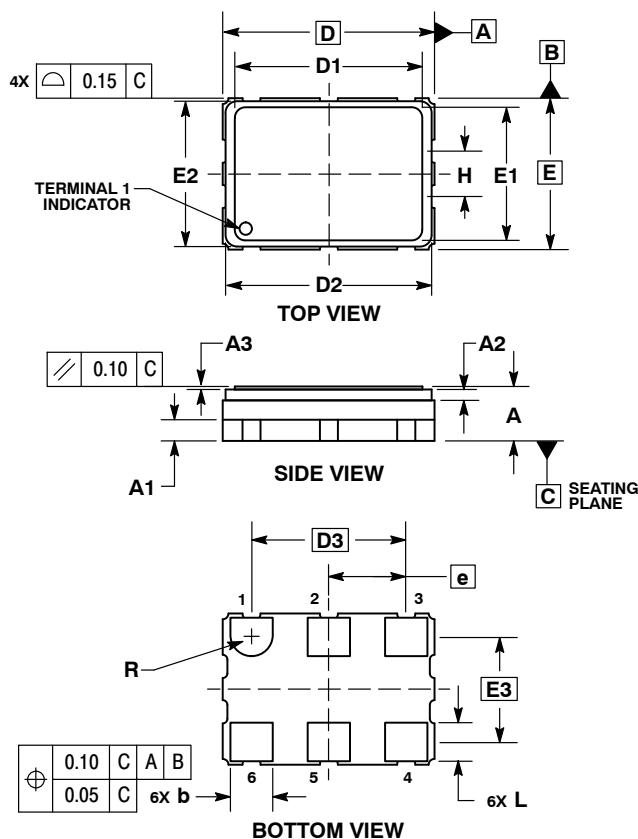


**Figure 6. Recommended Reflow Soldering Profile**

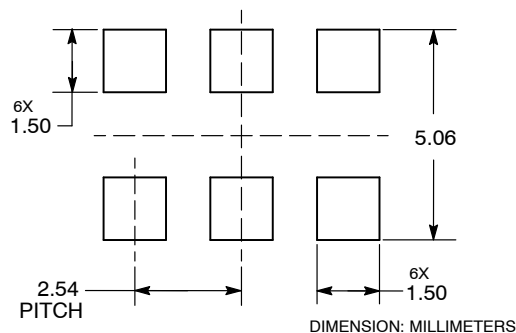
