Information on Substances (SVHC) in Murata Articles

The identification of a substance as Substance of Very High Concern and its inclusion in the Candidate List according to Article 59 (1, 10) of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) create, according to Article 33, the duty to communicate the name of the products containing SVHC, and the name of contained SVHC, but does not impose any restrictions to use or a substance ban.

Information Regarding Candidate List as amended on June 20, 2013

At the current time and to the best of our knowledge and based on the information available to us from our suppliers our current articles offered , except those listed below, do not contain added substances of very high concern (SVHC) as referenced by the amended candidate list above a limit of 0.1 % w/w.
