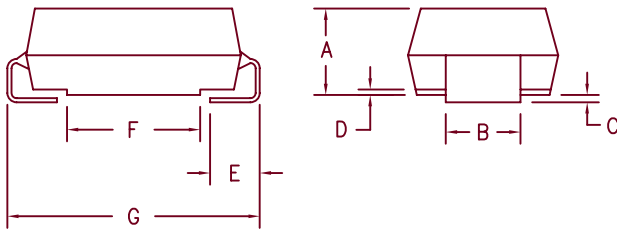
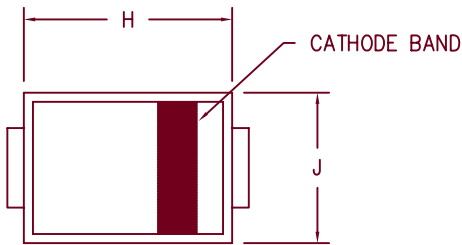

Typical Forward Characteristics

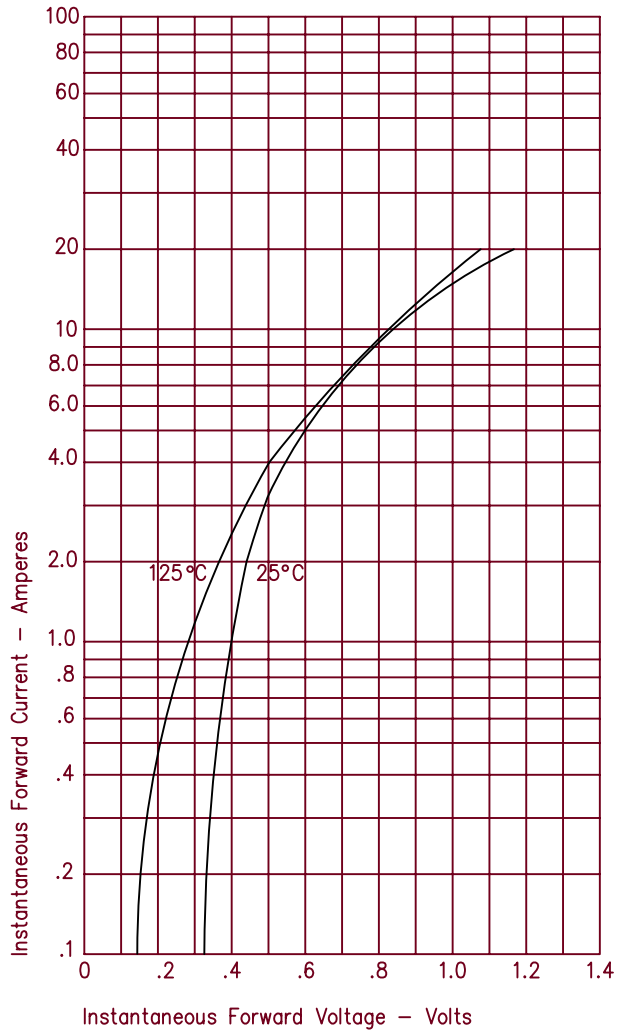

Typical Junction Capacitance

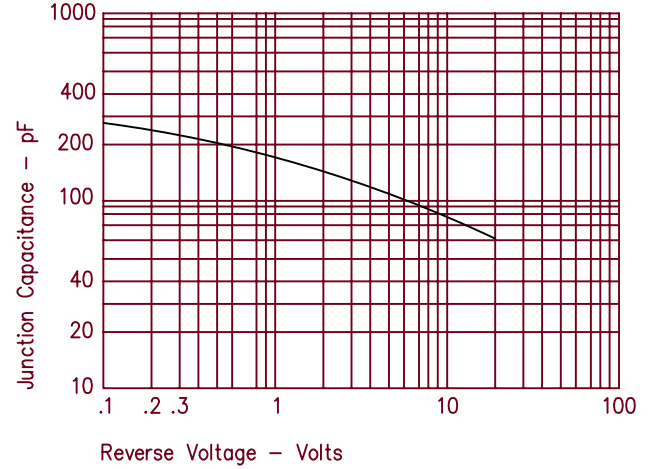
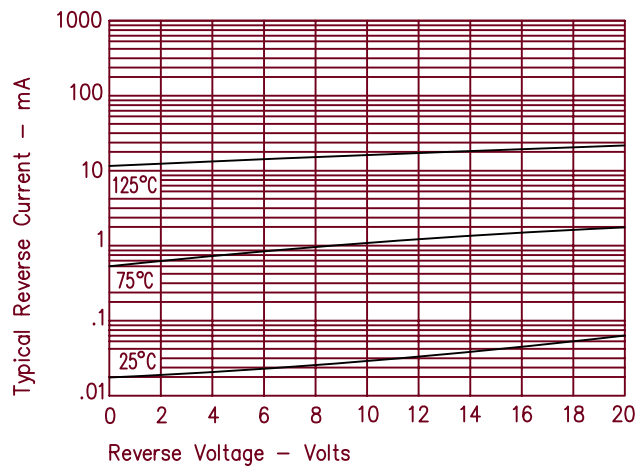

Typical Forward Characteristics

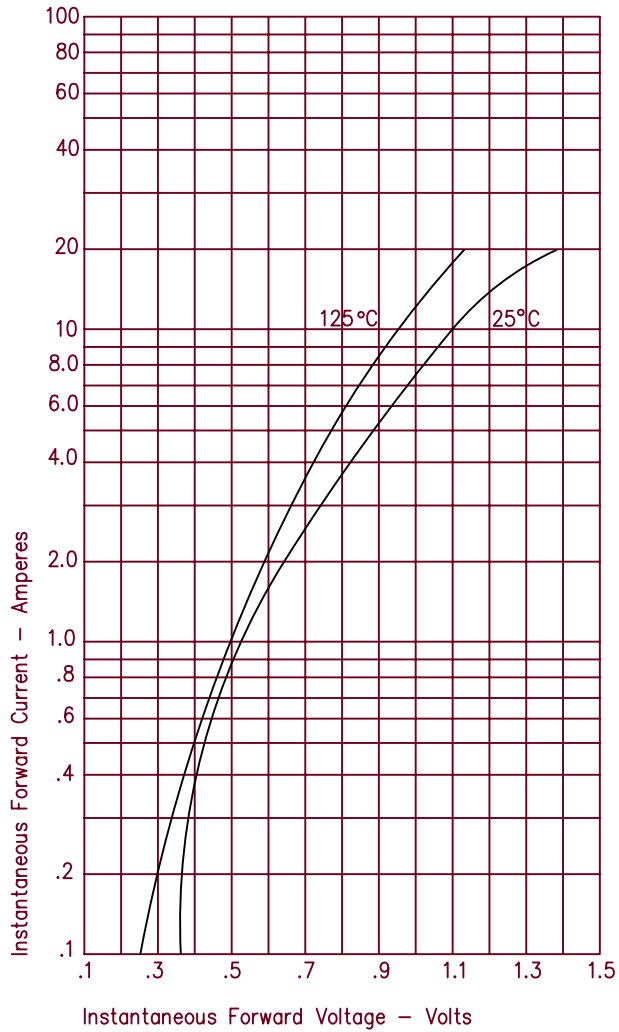

Typical Junction Capacitance

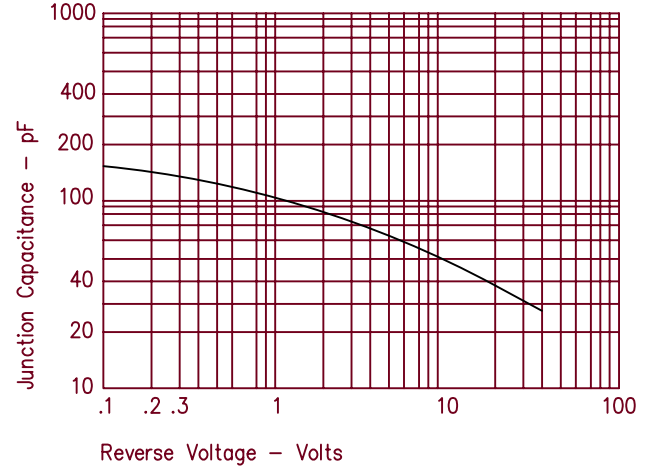
