





Equivalent Circuit



- I_{AS} and E_{AS} ratings are based on low frequency and duty cycles to keep $T_J = +25^\circ\text{C}$.
- Short duration pulse test used to minimize self-heating effect.
- Guaranteed by design. Not subject to product testing.




Figure 1. Typical Output Characteristic




Figure 3. Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 2. Typical Transfer Characteristic




Figure 4. Typical Transfer Characteristic




Figure 5. Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Junction Temperature




Figure 6. On-Resistance Variation with Junction Temperature




Figure 7. On-Resistance Variation with Junction Temperature




Figure 9. Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current




Figure 11. Gate Charge




Figure 8. Gate Threshold Variation vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 10. Typical Junction Capacitance




Figure 12. SOA, Safe Operation Area





Figure 13. Transient Thermal Resistance


