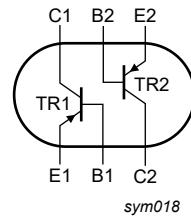
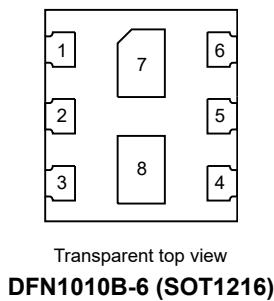

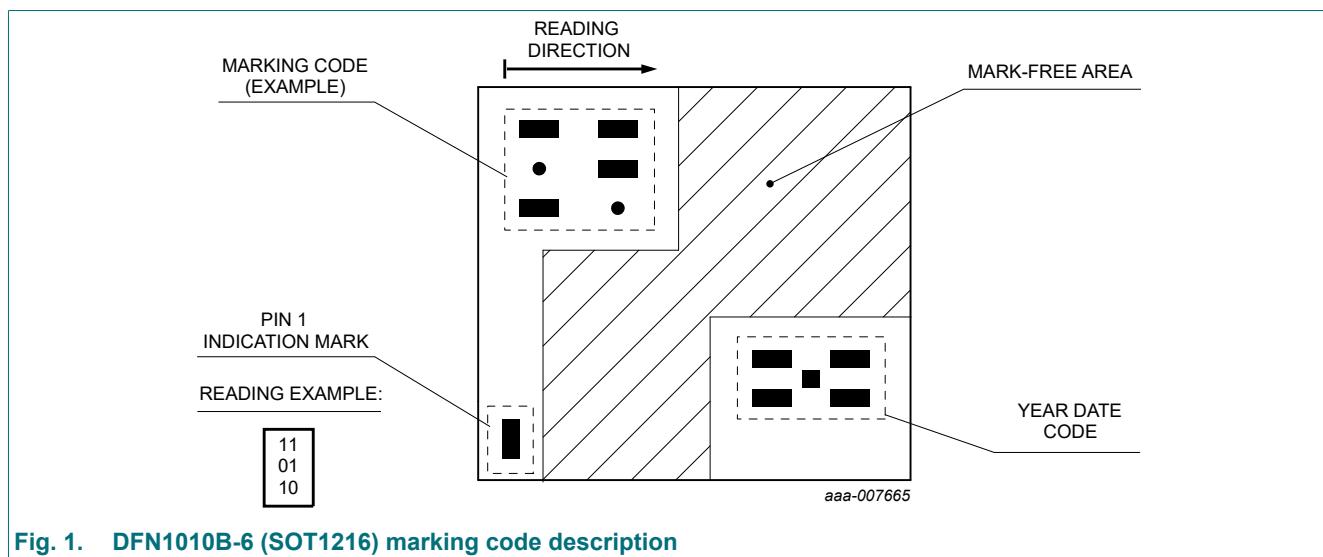

**Fig. 1. DFN1010B-6 (SOT1216) marking code description**

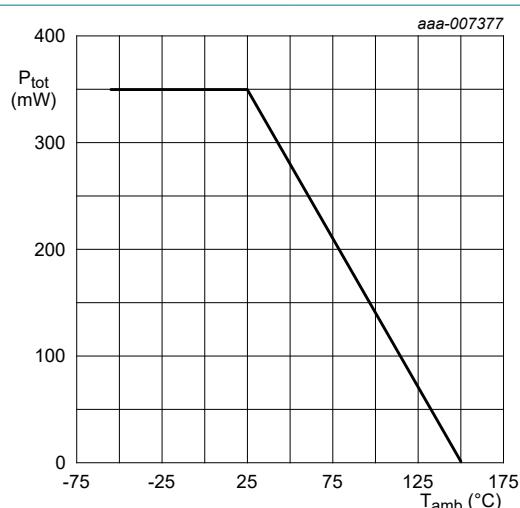

FR4 PCB, standard footprint

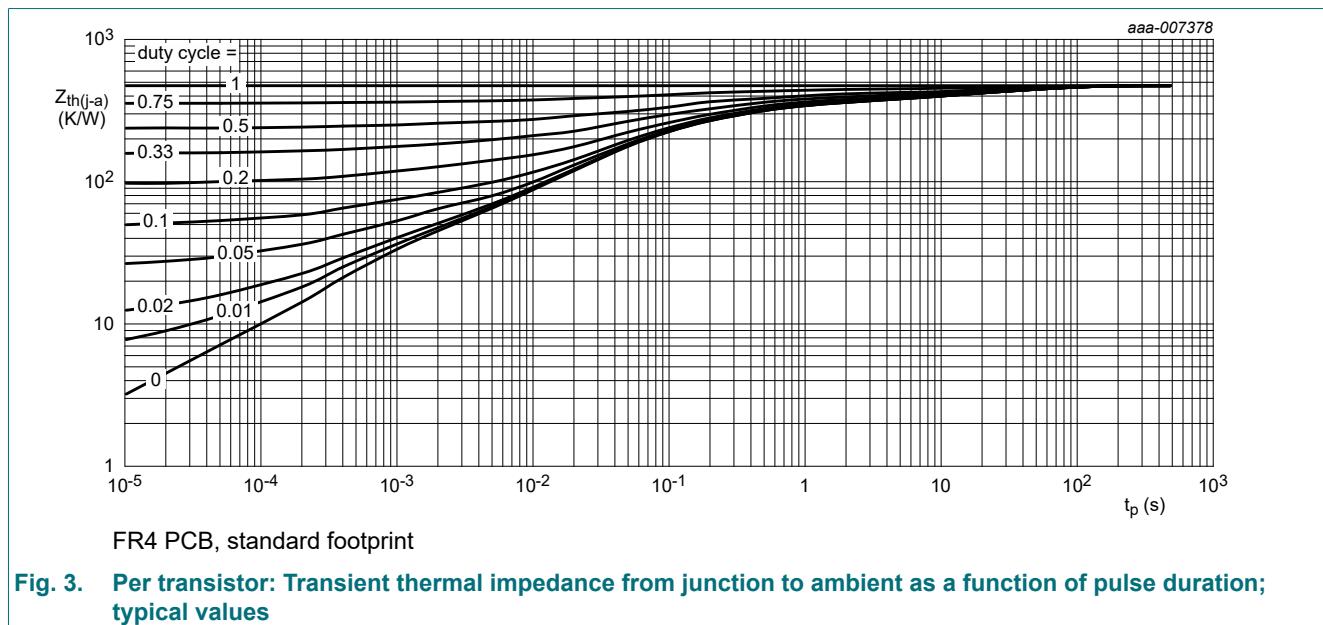
**Fig. 2. Per device: Power derating curve**

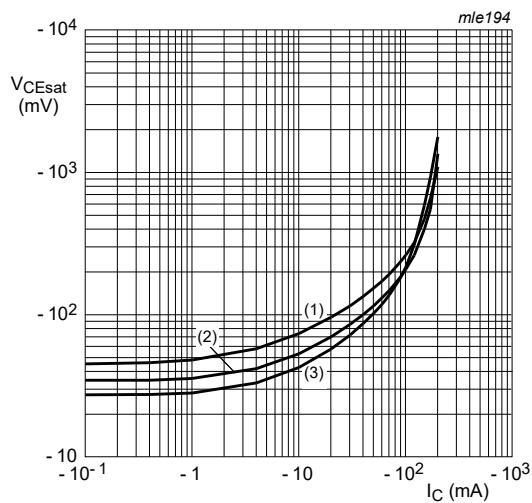

**Fig. 6. Base-emitter voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**



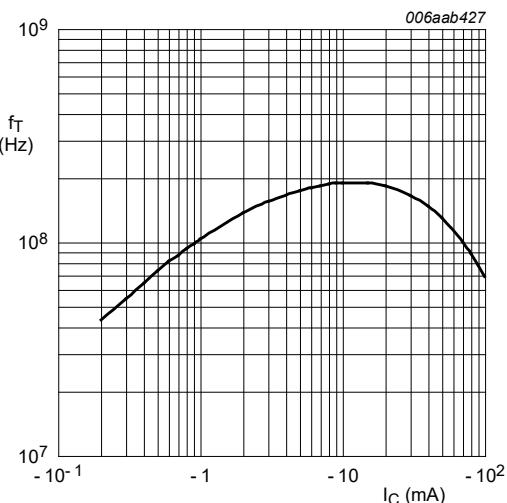

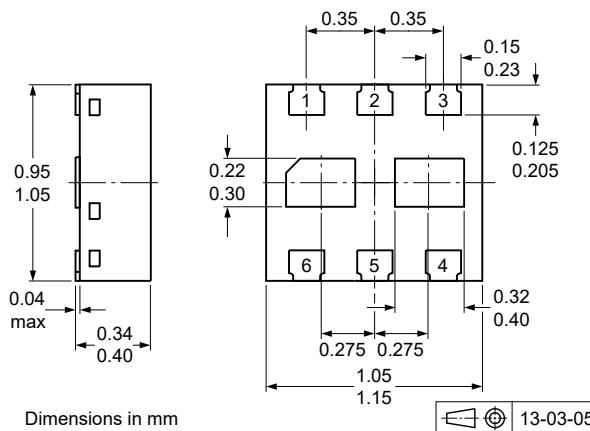
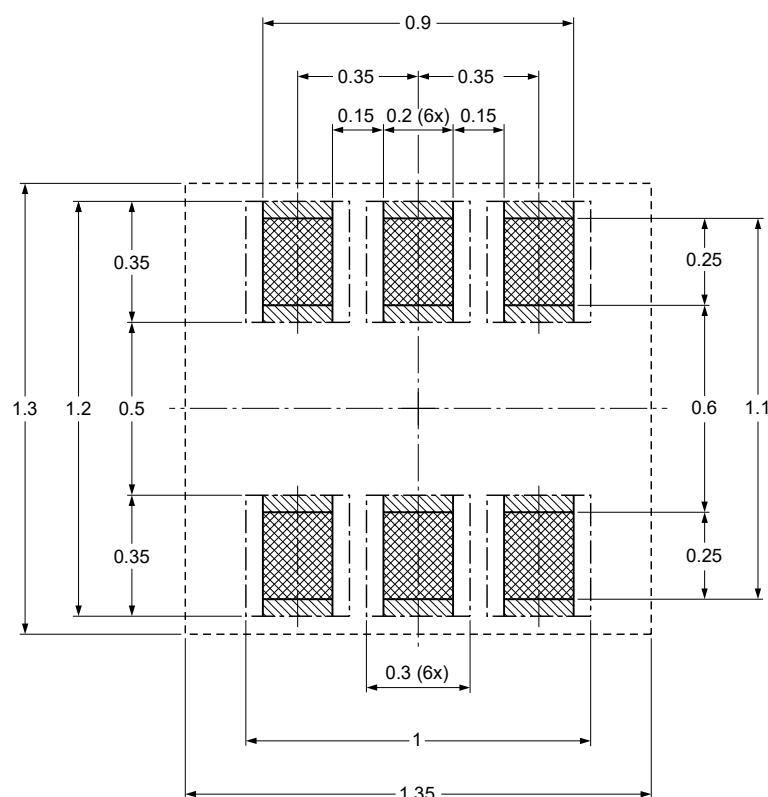


Fig. 10. Package outline DFN1010B-6 (SOT1216)
