CATV Tuning

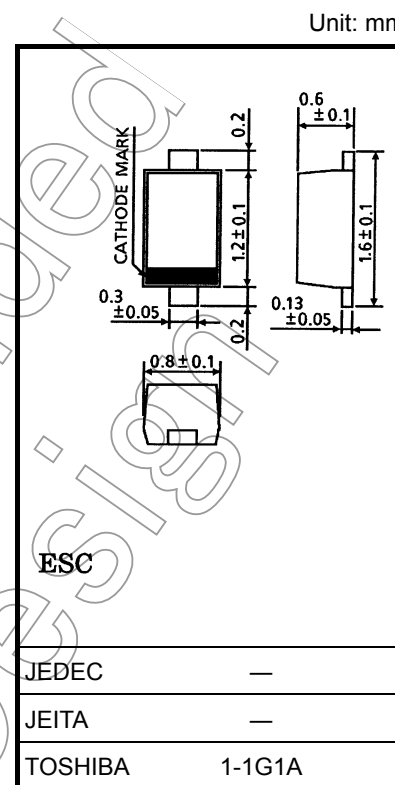
- High capacitance ratio: $C_2 \text{ V}/C_{25 \text{ V}} = 17.5$ (typ.)
- Low series resistance: $r_s = 1.05 \Omega$ (typ.)
- Useful for small size tuner.

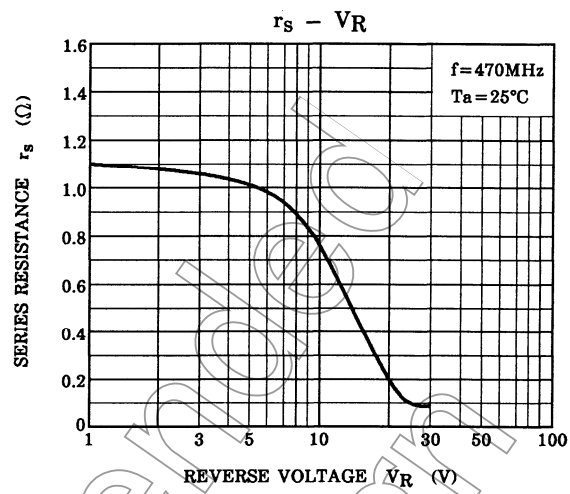
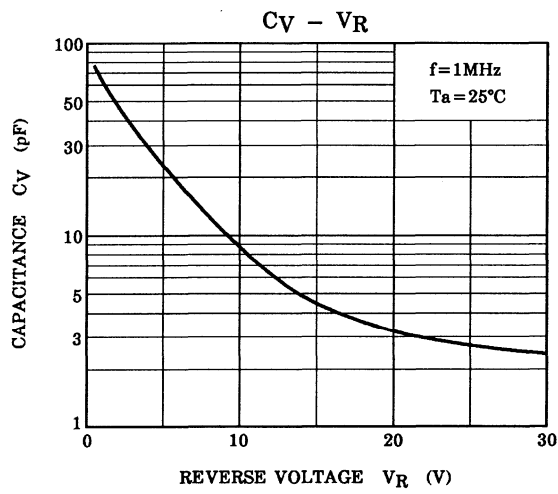
