Design

- Compatible with standard 16, 22, and 30 mm push buttons
- Made of rugged polycarbonate
- Permanently install the base under the button, then lock the removable cover in place to prevent actuation of the button
- Accepts lock shackles up to 9/32-inches or 7mm in diameter.

Material

- Base and cover: polycarbonate
- Latch: stainless steel
- Cover color: transparent with red tint
- Base color: clear

Temperature Range

The following temperature range is generally acceptable for polycarbonate. This range should not be used as a specification. The product should be tested under specific operating conditions. -20° C to 80° C (4° F to 176° F).

This product should be tested under specific operating conditions. If a temperature is specified, the chemical may have a more severe effect if above the specified temperature.

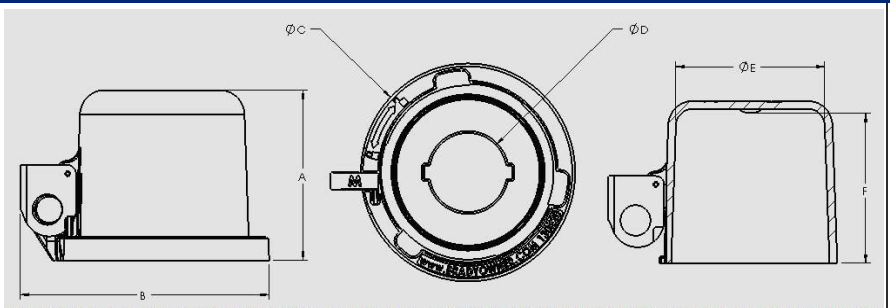
