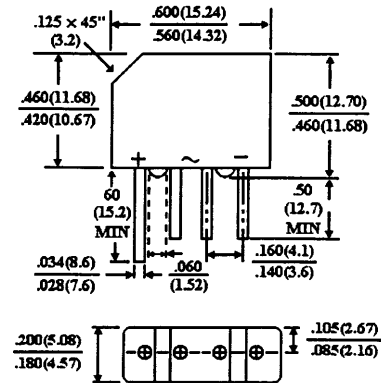

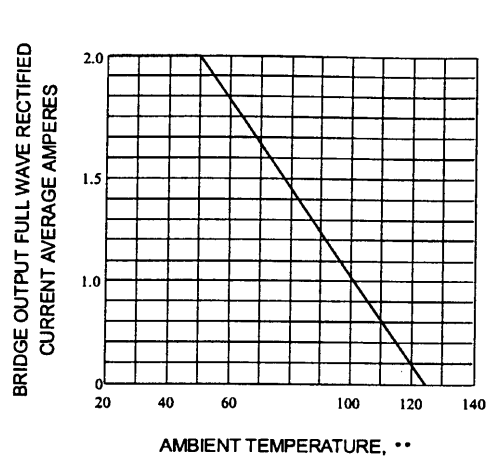


Fig. 1-DERATING CURVE FOR OUTPUT RECTIFIED CURRENT

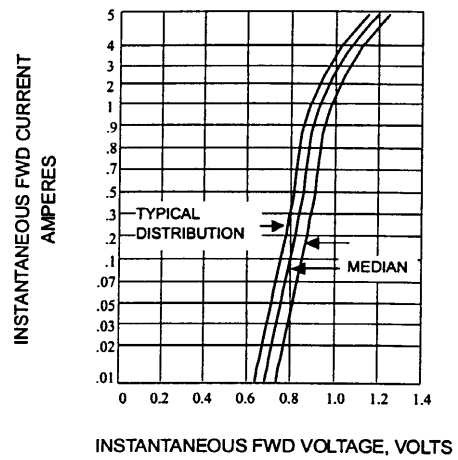


Fig. 2-TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS(25°C)

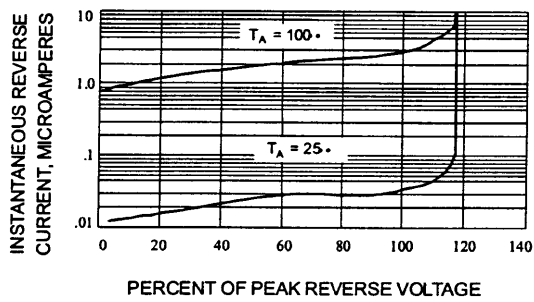


Fig. 3-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

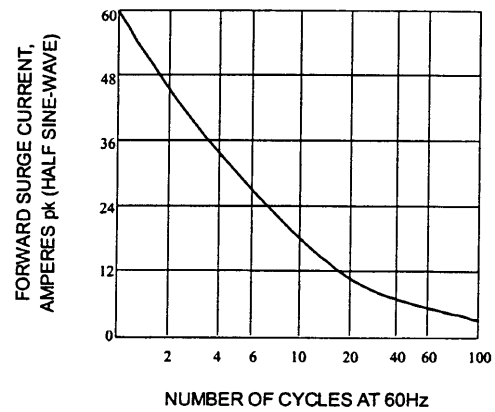


Fig. 4-NON-RECURRENT SURGE RATING
