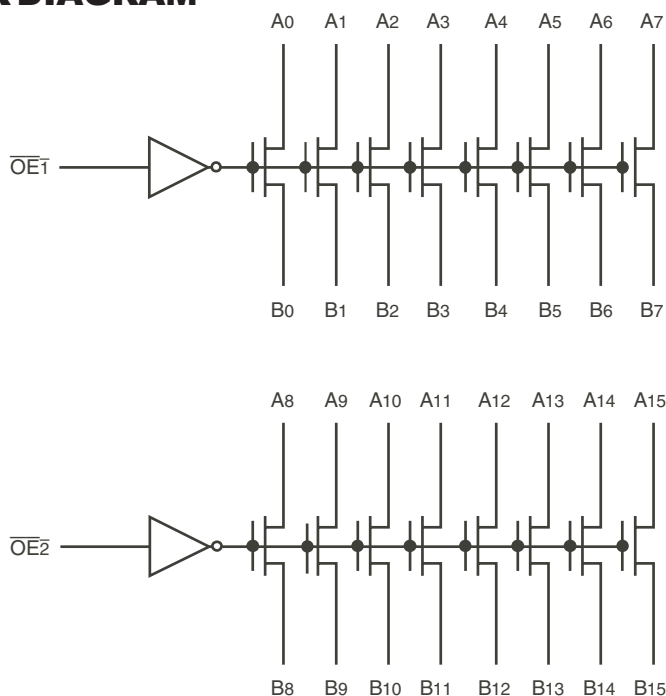
### DESCRIPTION:

The QS32XVH2245 HotSwitch is a high bandwidth, 16-bit bus switch. The QS32XVH2245, with 25Ω ON resistance and 1.35ns propagation delay, is ideal for line matching and low noise environments. The switches can be turned ON under the control of the LVTTTL-compatible Output Enable ( $\overline{OE}$ ) signal for bidirectional data flow with no added delay or ground bounce. In the ON state, the switches can pass signals up to 5V. In the OFF state, the switches offer very high impedance at the terminals.

The combination of small propagation delay, high OFF impedance, and over-voltage tolerance makes the QS32XVH2245 ideal for hot-swapping applications.

The QS32XVH2245 is characterized for operation from -40°C to +85°C.

### FUNCTIONAL BLOCK DIAGRAM

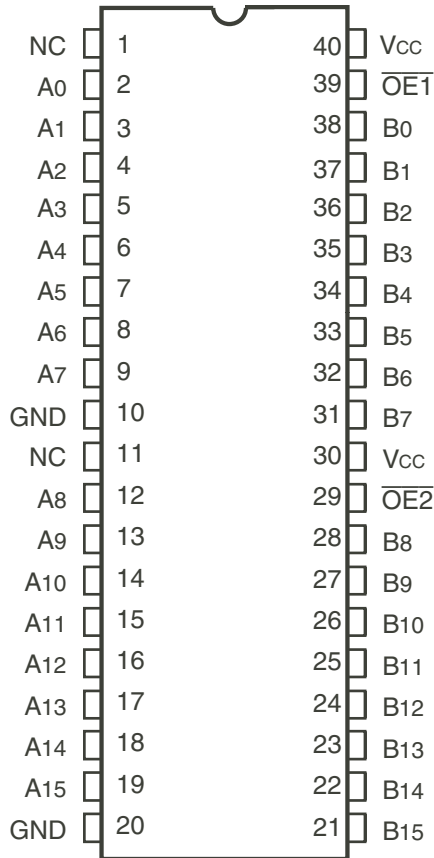

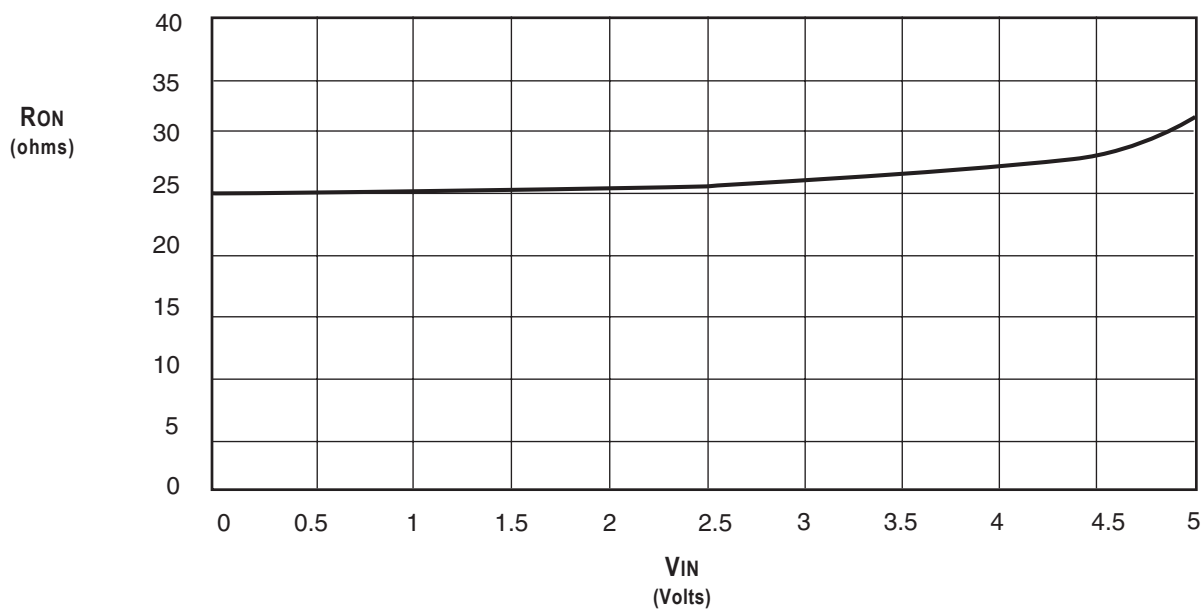

## TYPICAL ON RESISTANCE vs $V_{IN}$ AT $V_{CC} = 3.3\text{V}$



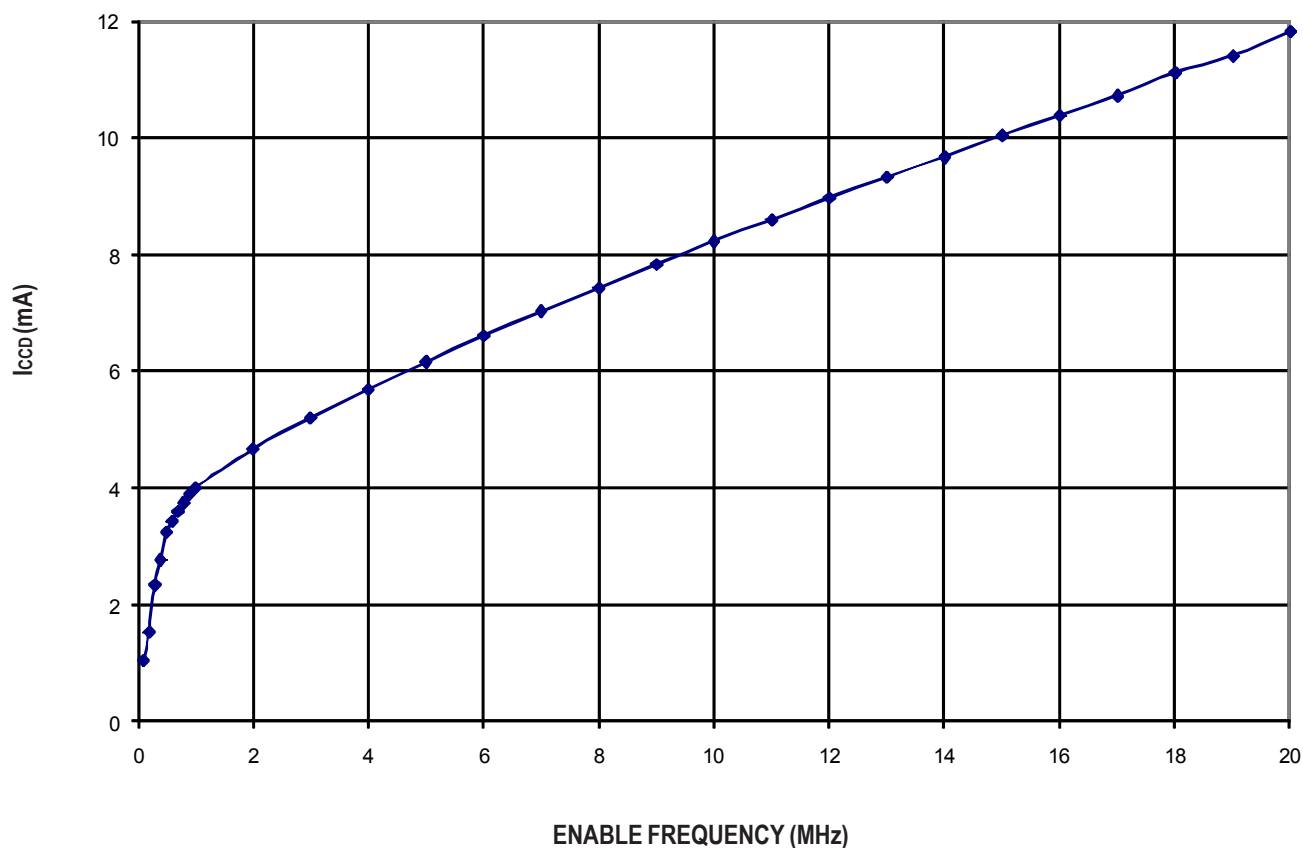

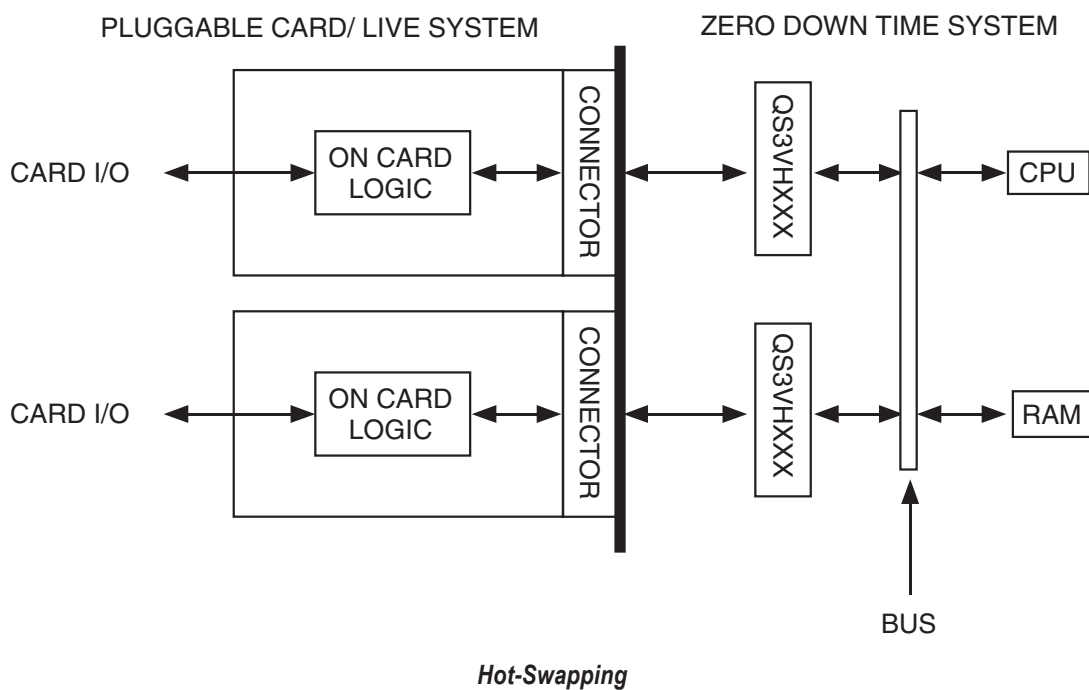
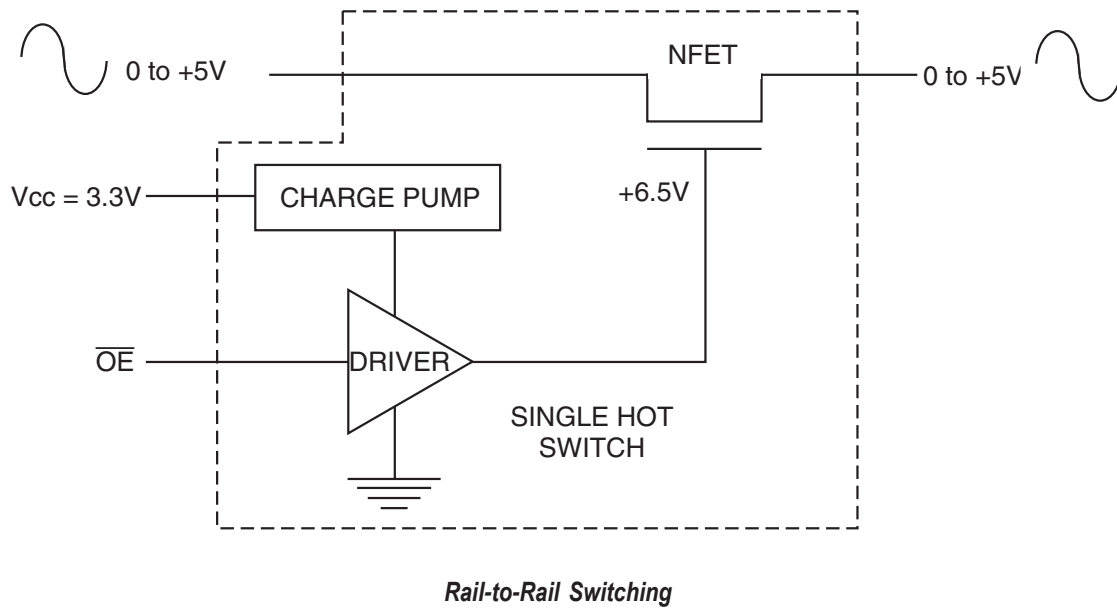

- The bus switch contributes no propagation delay other than the RC delay of the ON resistance of the switch and the load capacitance. The time constant for the switch alone is of the order of 1.35ns at C<sub>L</sub> = 50pF. Since this time constant is much smaller than the rise and fall times of typical driving signals, it adds very little propagation delay to the system. Propagation delay of the bus switch, when used in a system, is determined by the driving circuit on the driving side of the switch and its interaction with the load on the driven side.
- Minimums are guaranteed but not production tested.
- Maximum toggle frequency for O<sub>Ex</sub> control input (pass voltage > V<sub>CC</sub>, V<sub>IN</sub> = 5V, R<sub>LOAD</sub> ≥ 1MΩ, no C<sub>LOAD</sub>).

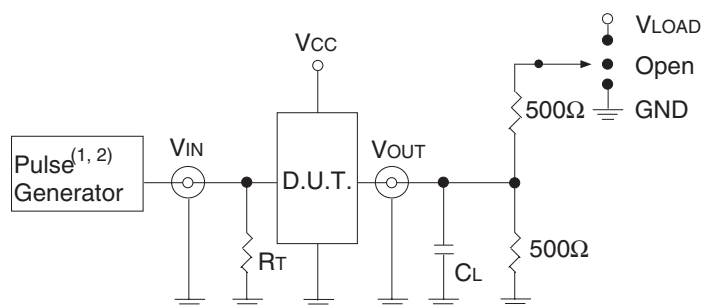

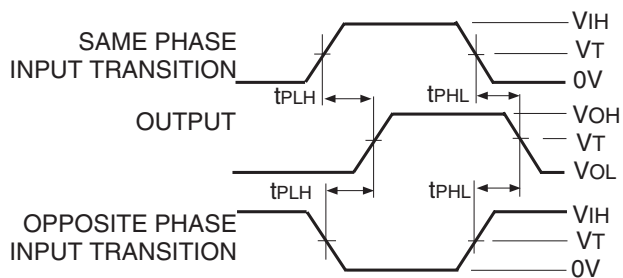

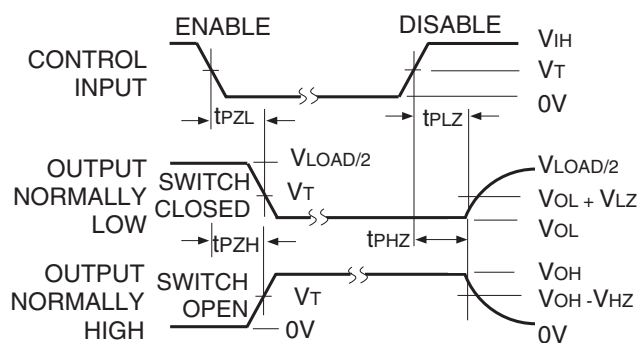
