- Excellent h_{FE} linearity
: $h_{FE}(1) = 100$ to 320 ($V_{CE} = -2$ V, $I_C = -0.5$ A)
: $h_{FE}(2) = 70$ (min) ($V_{CE} = -2$ V, $I_C = -4$ A)
- Low collector saturation voltage
: $V_{CE(sat)} = -1.0$ V (max) ($I_C = -4$ A, $I_B = -0.1$ A)
- High power dissipation
: $P_C = 10$ W ($T_c = 25^\circ\text{C}$), $P_C = 1.0$ W ($T_a = 25^\circ\text{C}$)

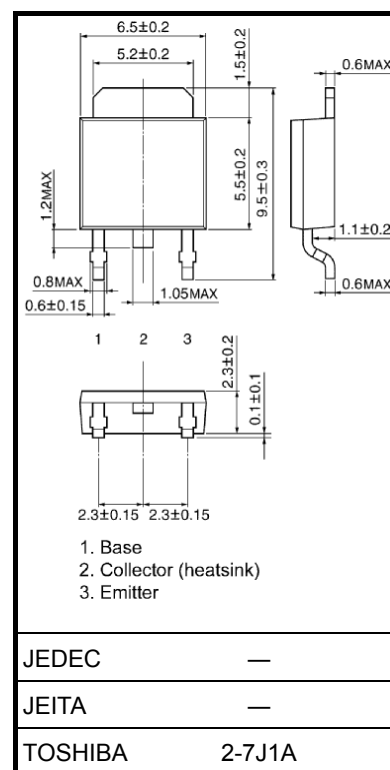
