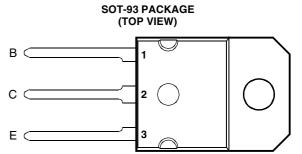

COLLECTOR-EMITTER SATURATION VOLTAGE

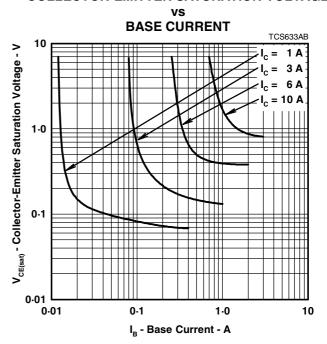

BASE-EMITTER VOLTAGE

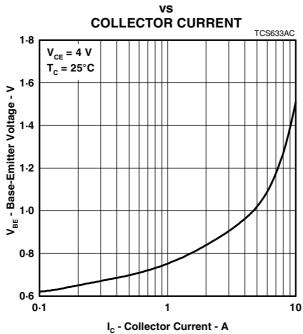
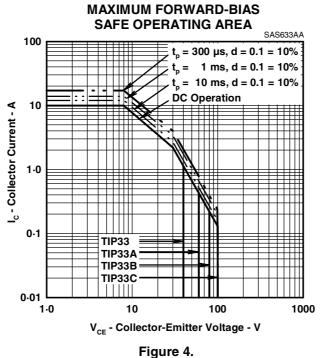

MAXIMUM POWER DISSIPATION

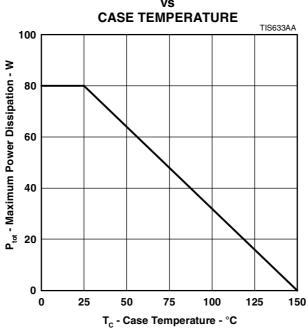


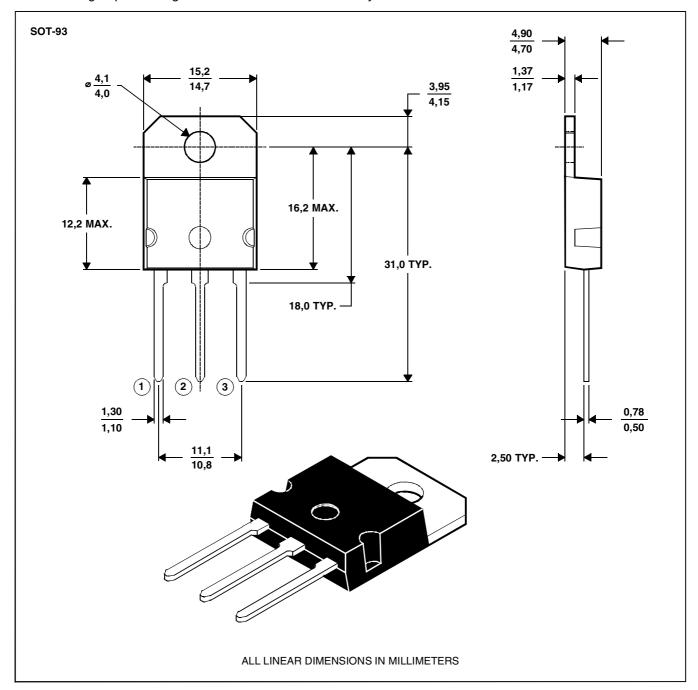

3-pin plastic flange-mount package
