## 1. General description

Planar Schottky barrier rectifier with an integrated guard ring for stress protection, encapsulated in a SOD128 small and flat lead Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package.

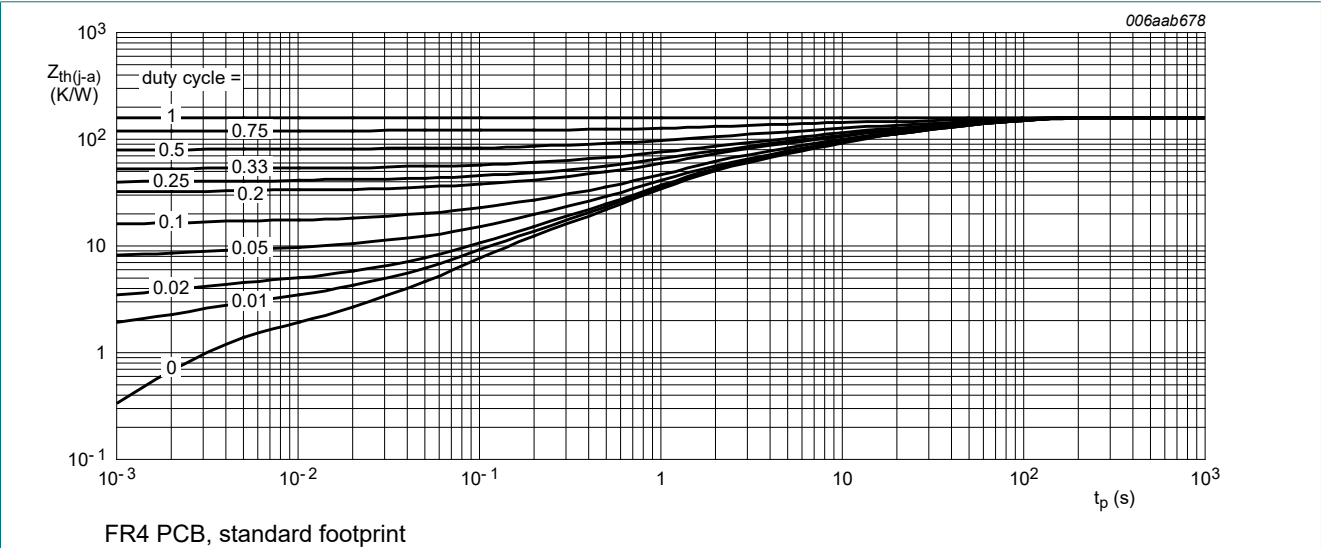


Fig. 1. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

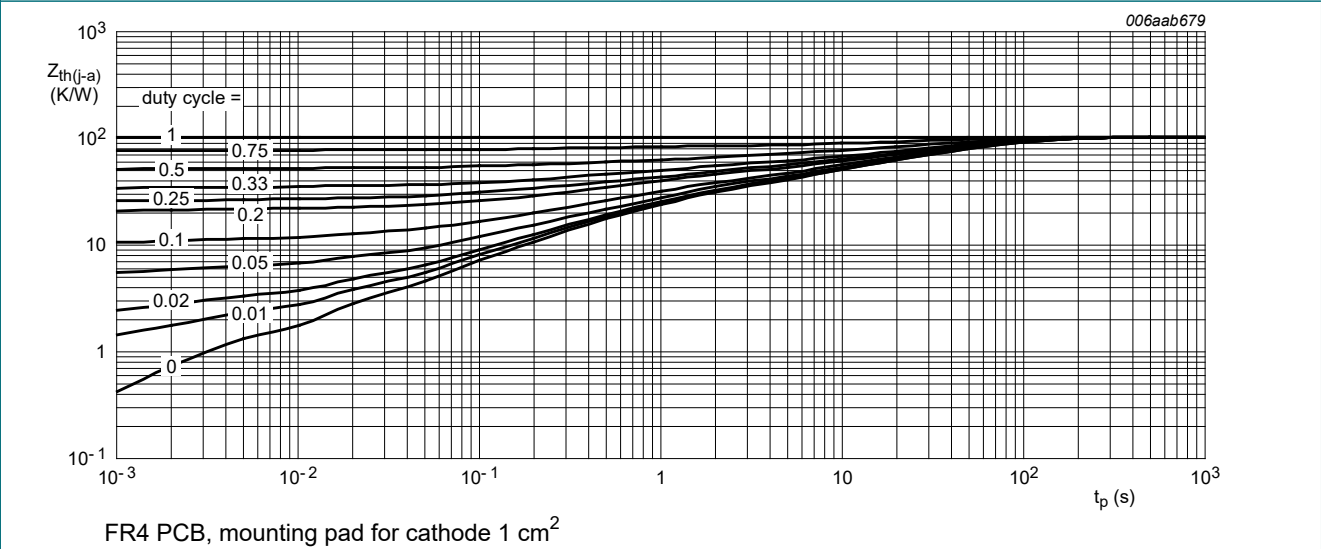
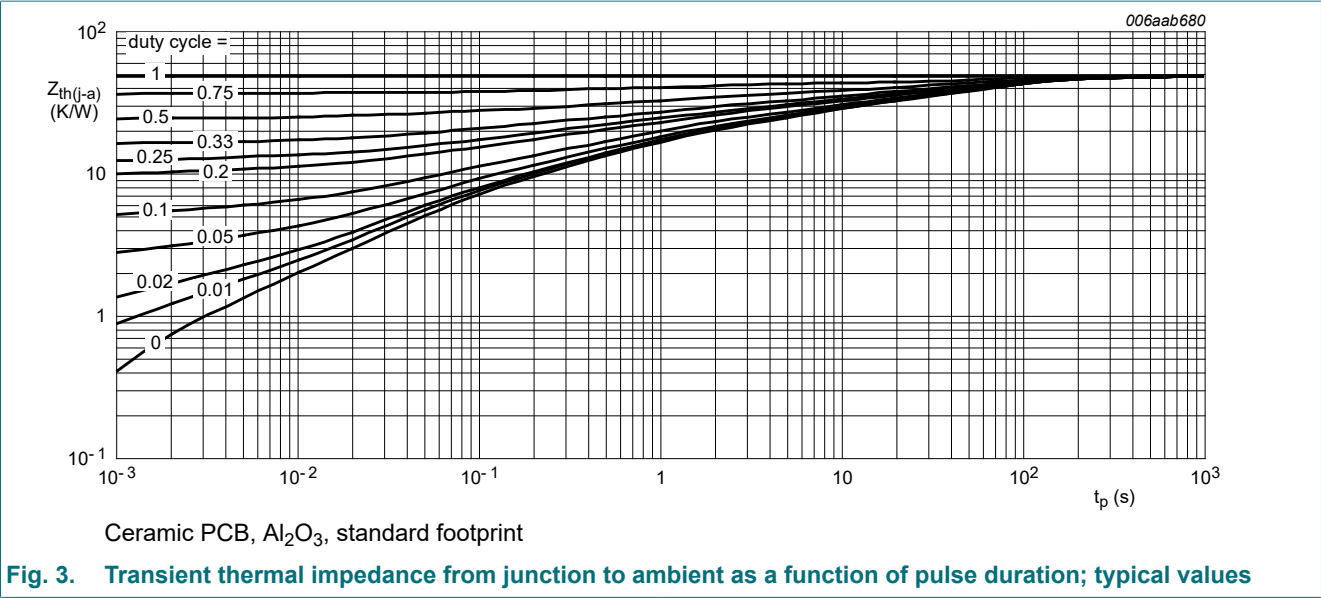


Fig. 2. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values

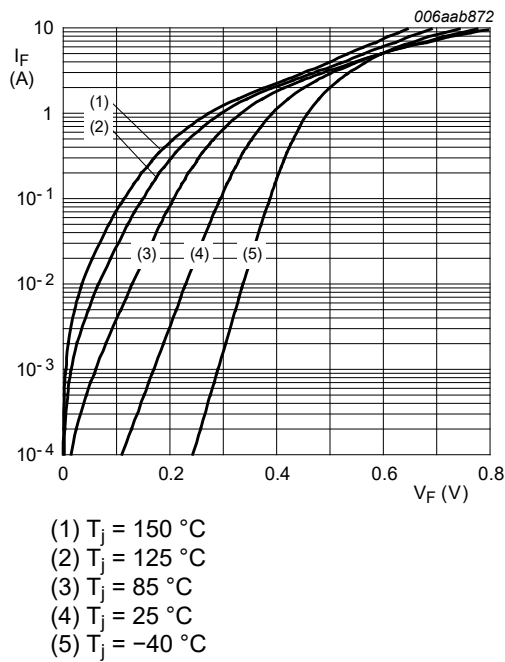


Fig. 4. Forward current as a function of forward voltage; typical values

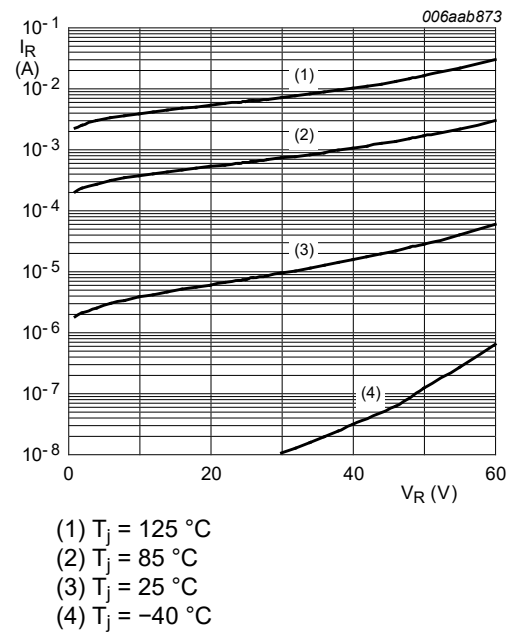


Fig. 5. Reverse current as a function of reverse voltage; typical values

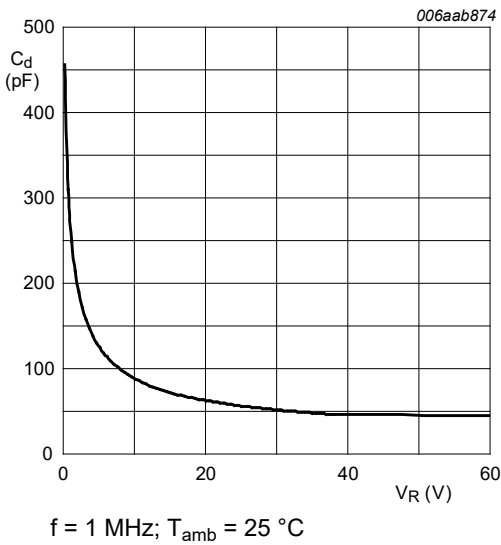


Fig. 6. Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values

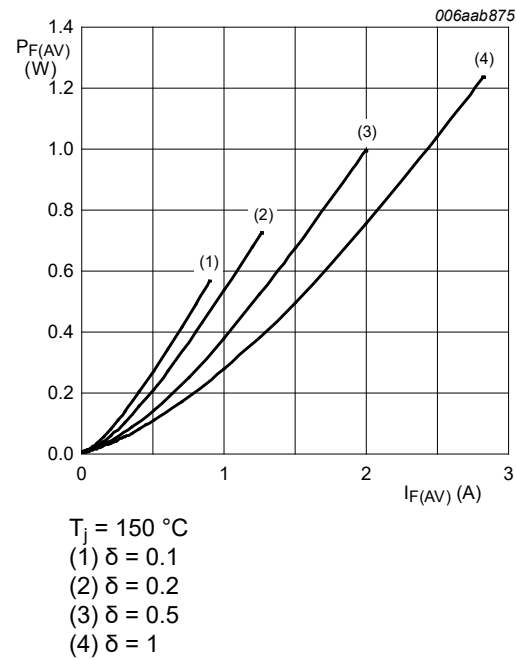
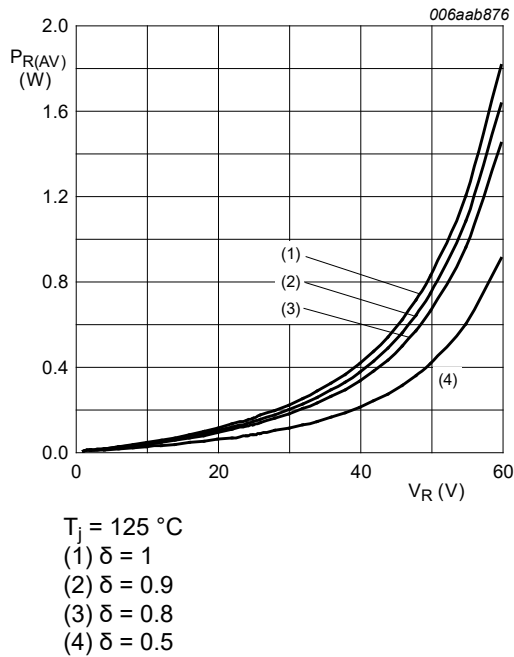
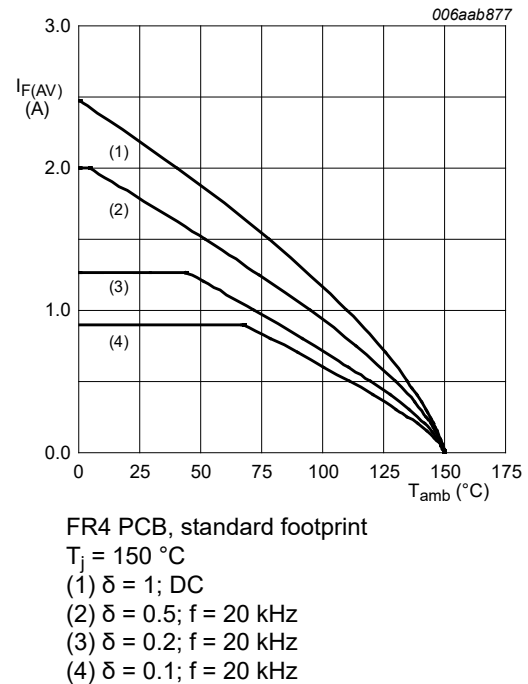


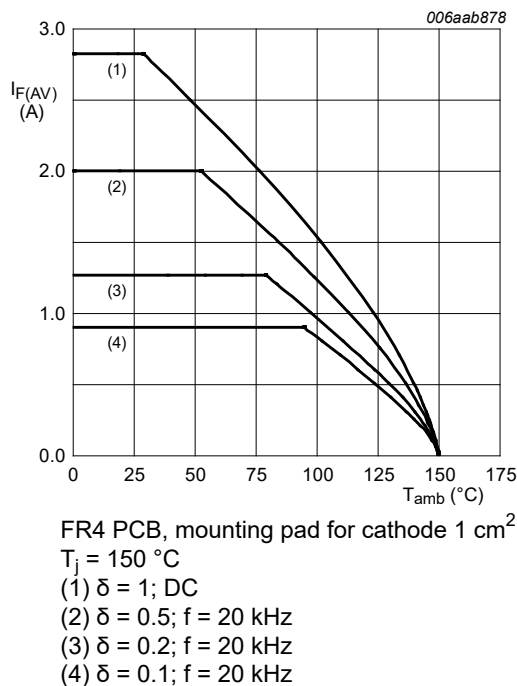
Fig. 7. Average forward power dissipation as a function of average forward current; typical values



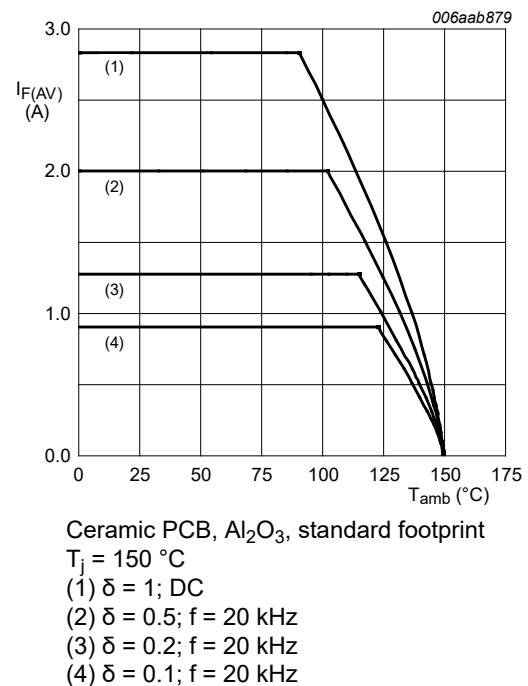
**Fig. 8.** Average reverse power dissipation as a function of reverse voltage; typical values



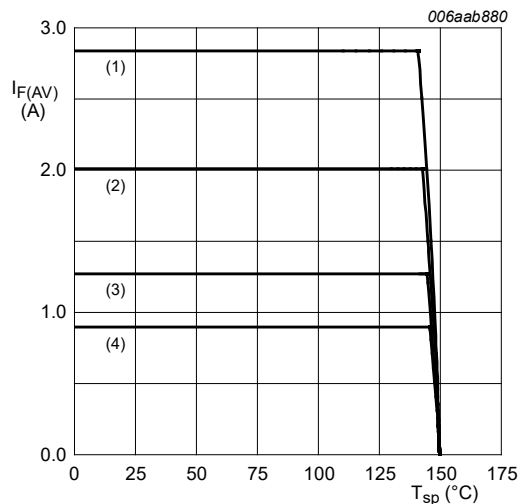
**Fig. 9.** Average forward current as a function of ambient temperature; typical values

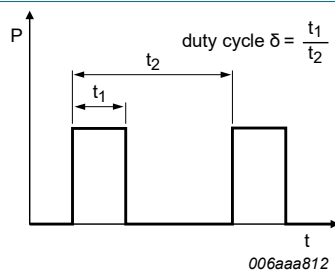


Fig. 13. Duty cycle definition

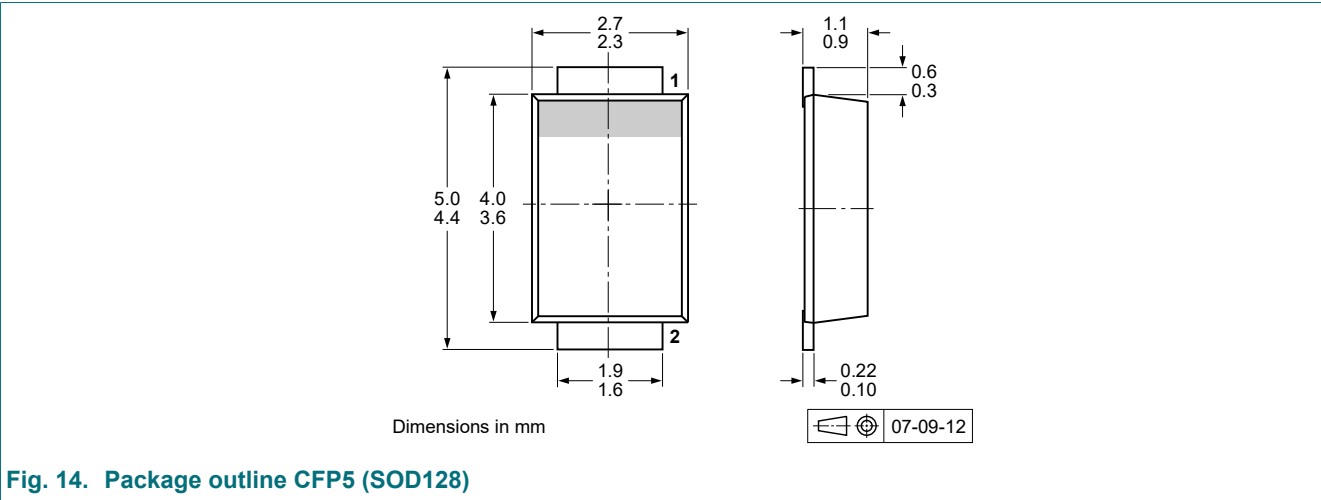
The current ratings for the typical waveforms are calculated according to the equations:

$$I_{F(AV)} = I_M \times \delta \text{ with } I_M \text{ defined as peak current}$$

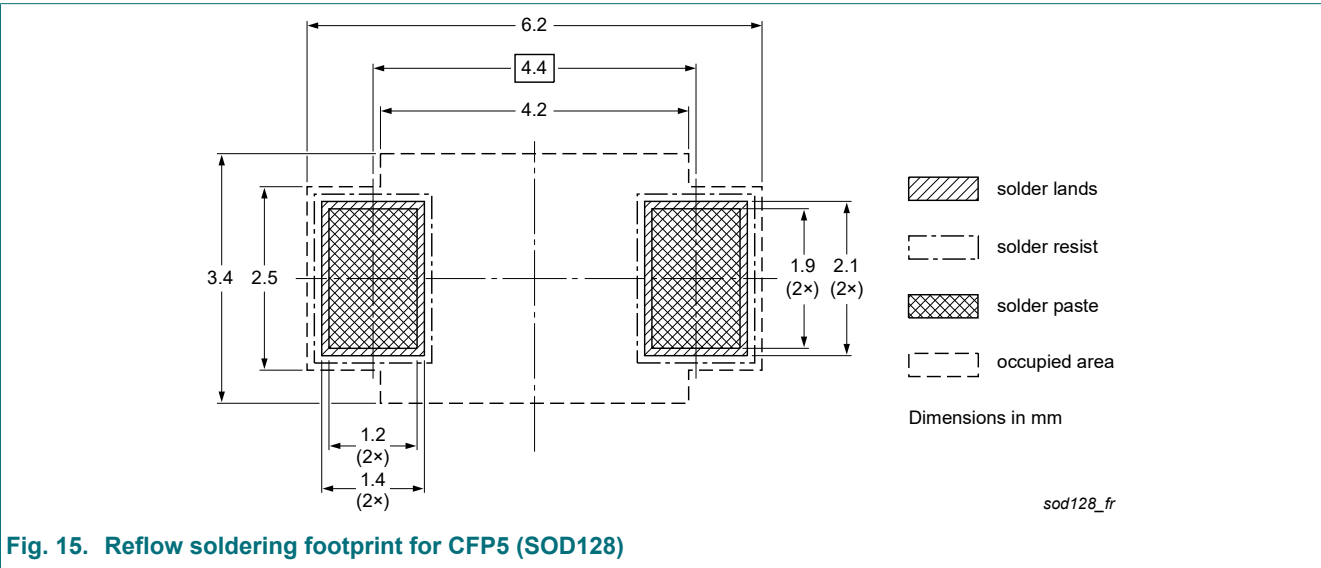
$$I_{RMS} = I_{F(AV)} \text{ at DC}$$

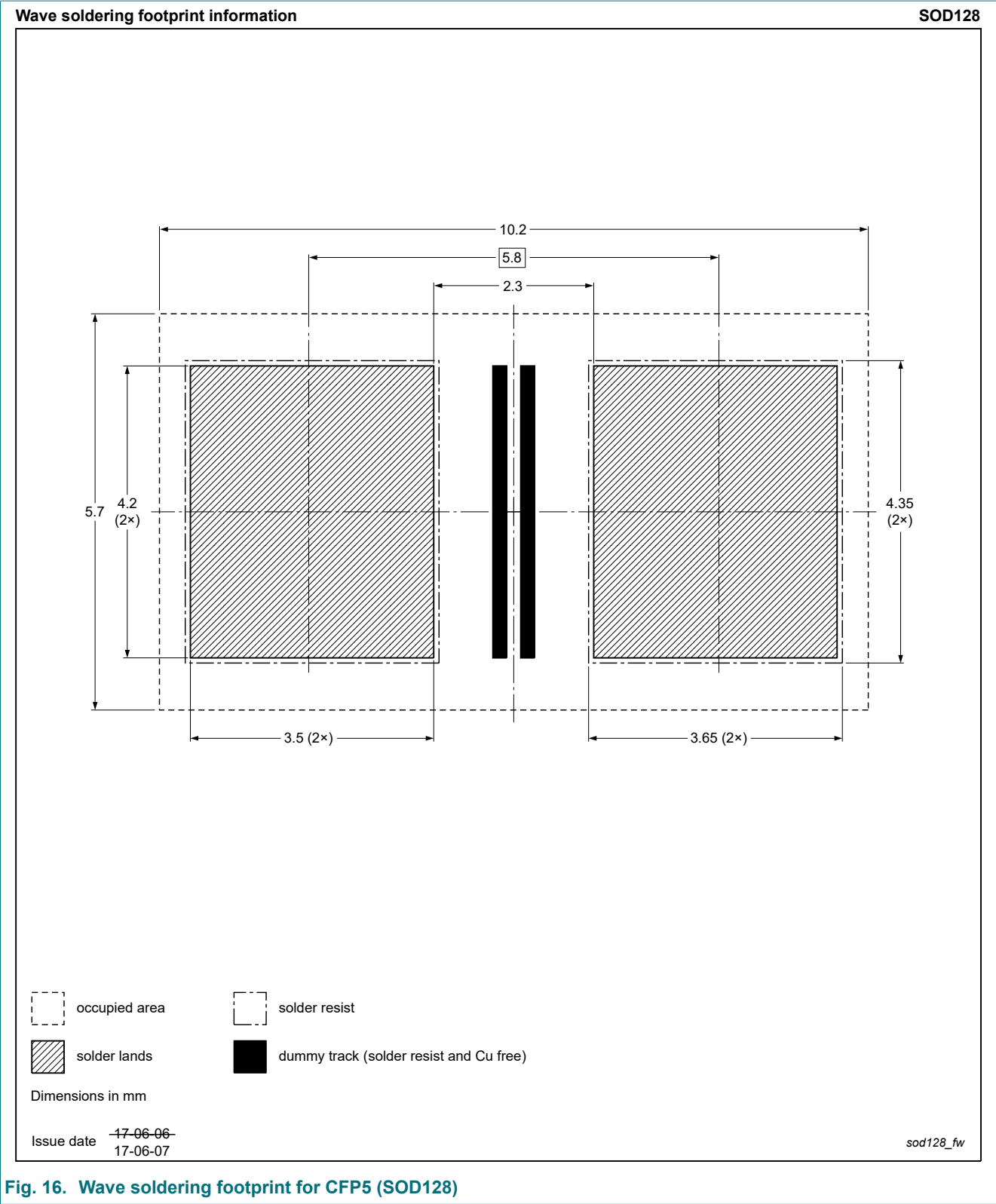


Fig. 16. Wave soldering footprint for CFP5 (SOD128)
