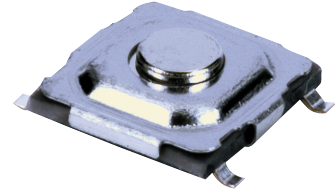

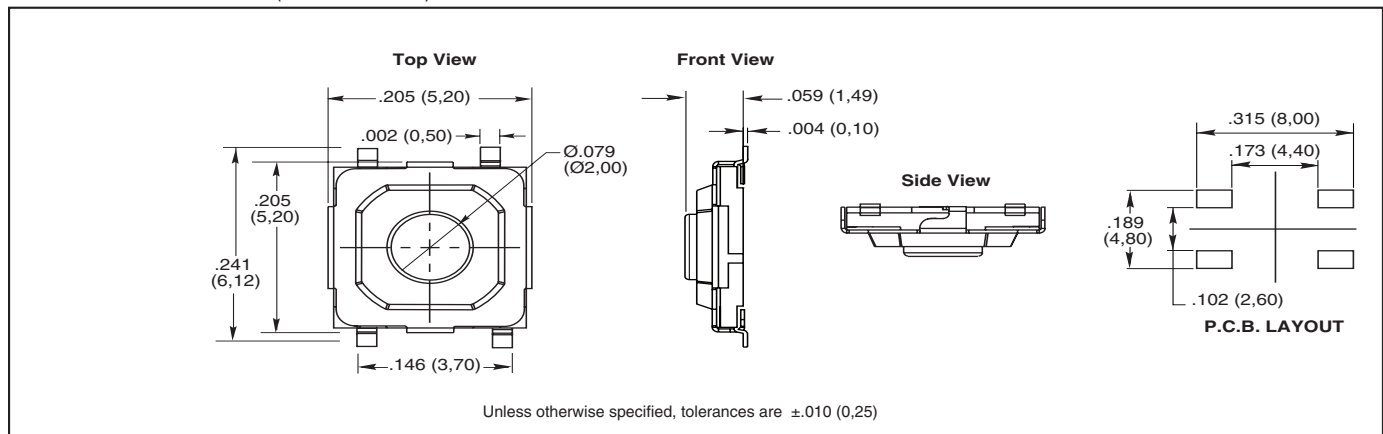

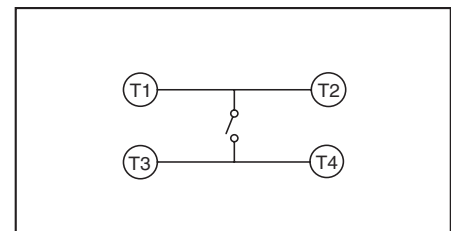

Soldering Process

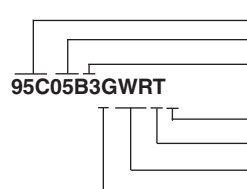
Hand Soldering: Use a soldering iron of 30 watts, controlled at 350°C for 5 seconds maximum while applying solder.

Reflow Soldering: Peak temperature 260°C (500°F).
