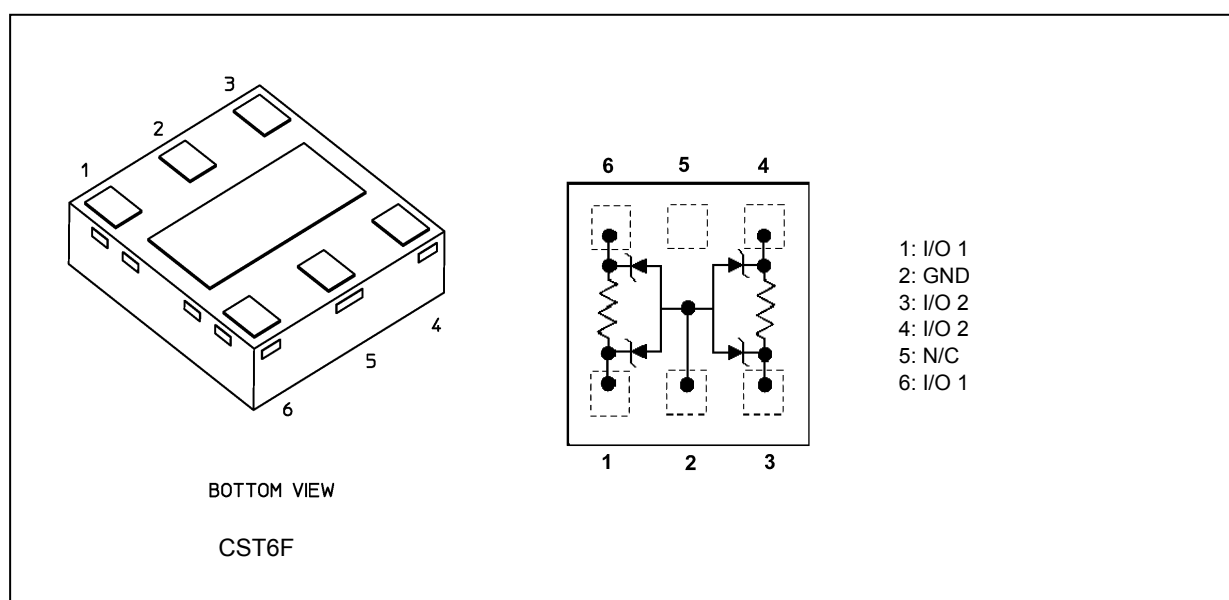

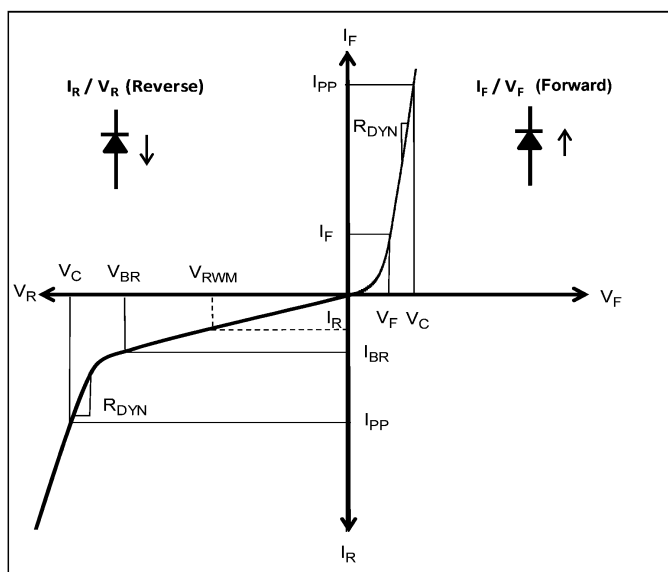


Fig. 5.1 Definitions of Electrical Characteristics

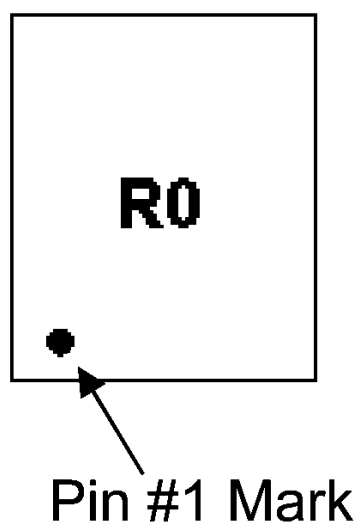


Fig. 7.1 Marking

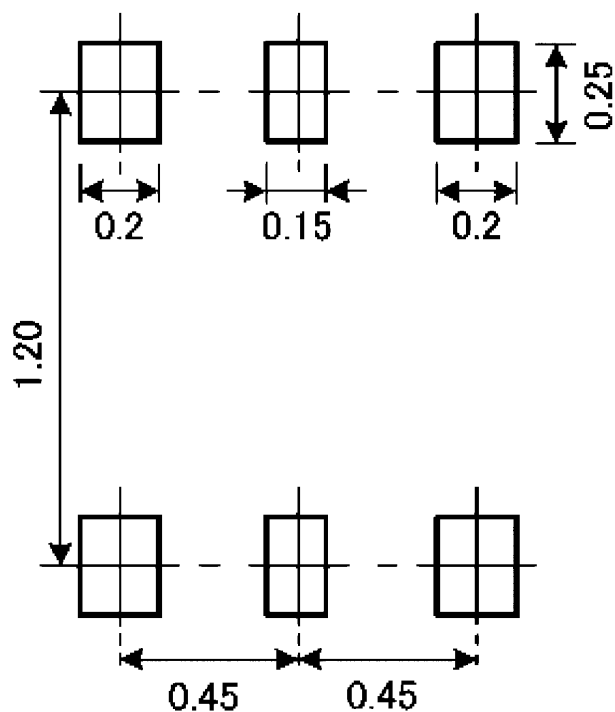


Fig. 8.1 Land Pattern Dimensions (Unit: mm)

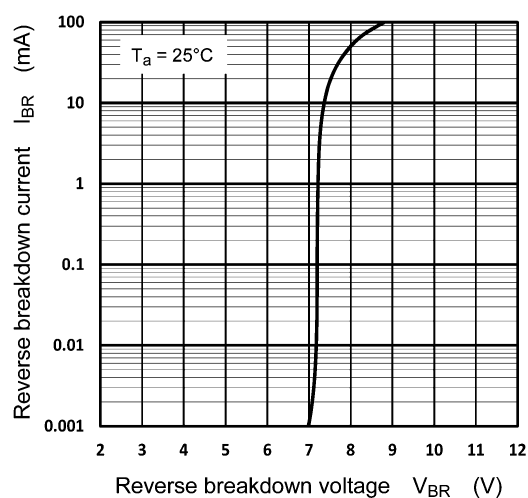


Fig. 9.1 $I_{BR} - V_{BR}$

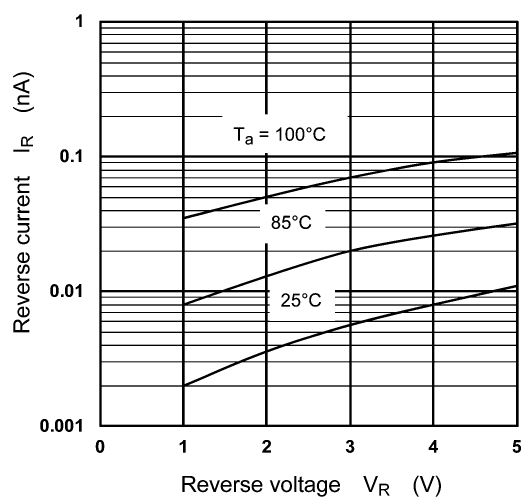


Fig. 9.2 $I_R - V_R$

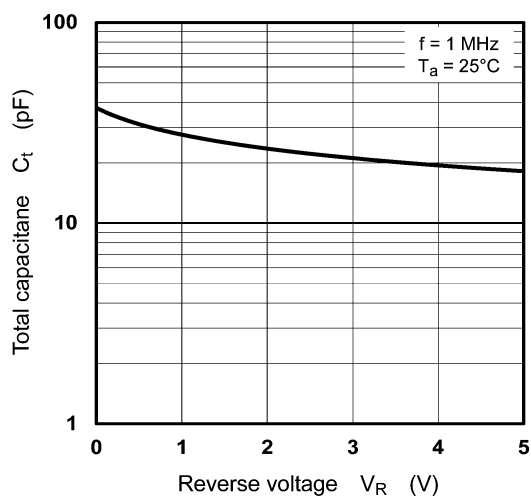


Fig. 9.3 $C_t - V_R$

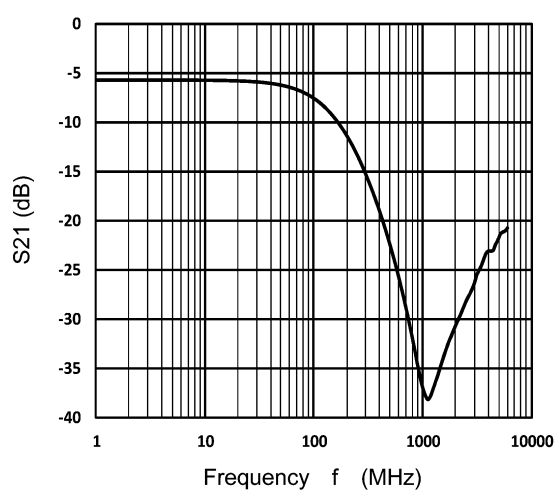
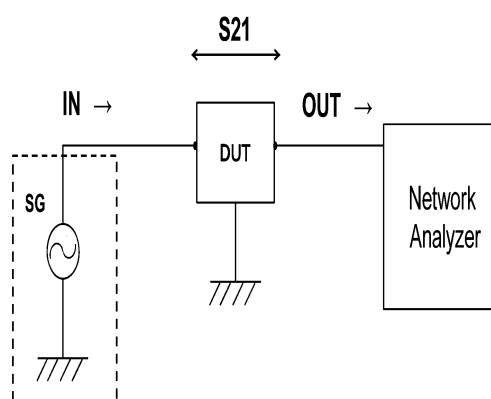


Fig. 10.1 S_{21} - f

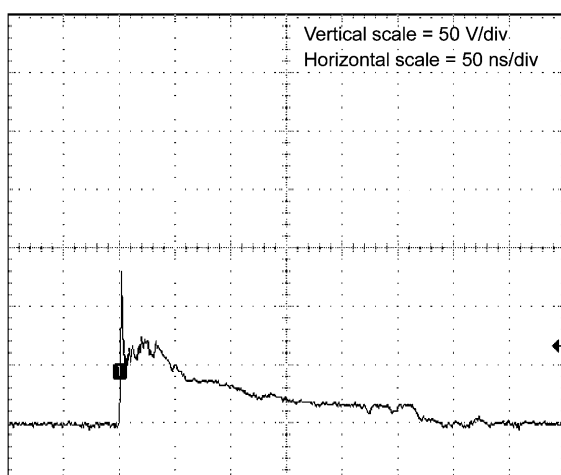


Fig. 11.1 +8 kV

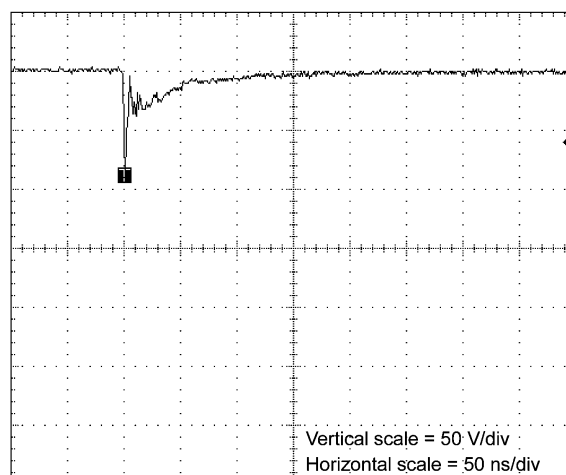


Fig. 11.2 -8 kV

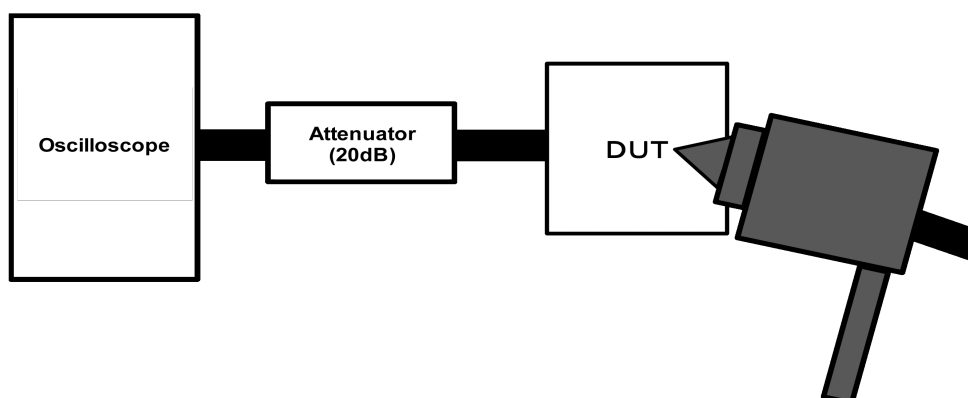
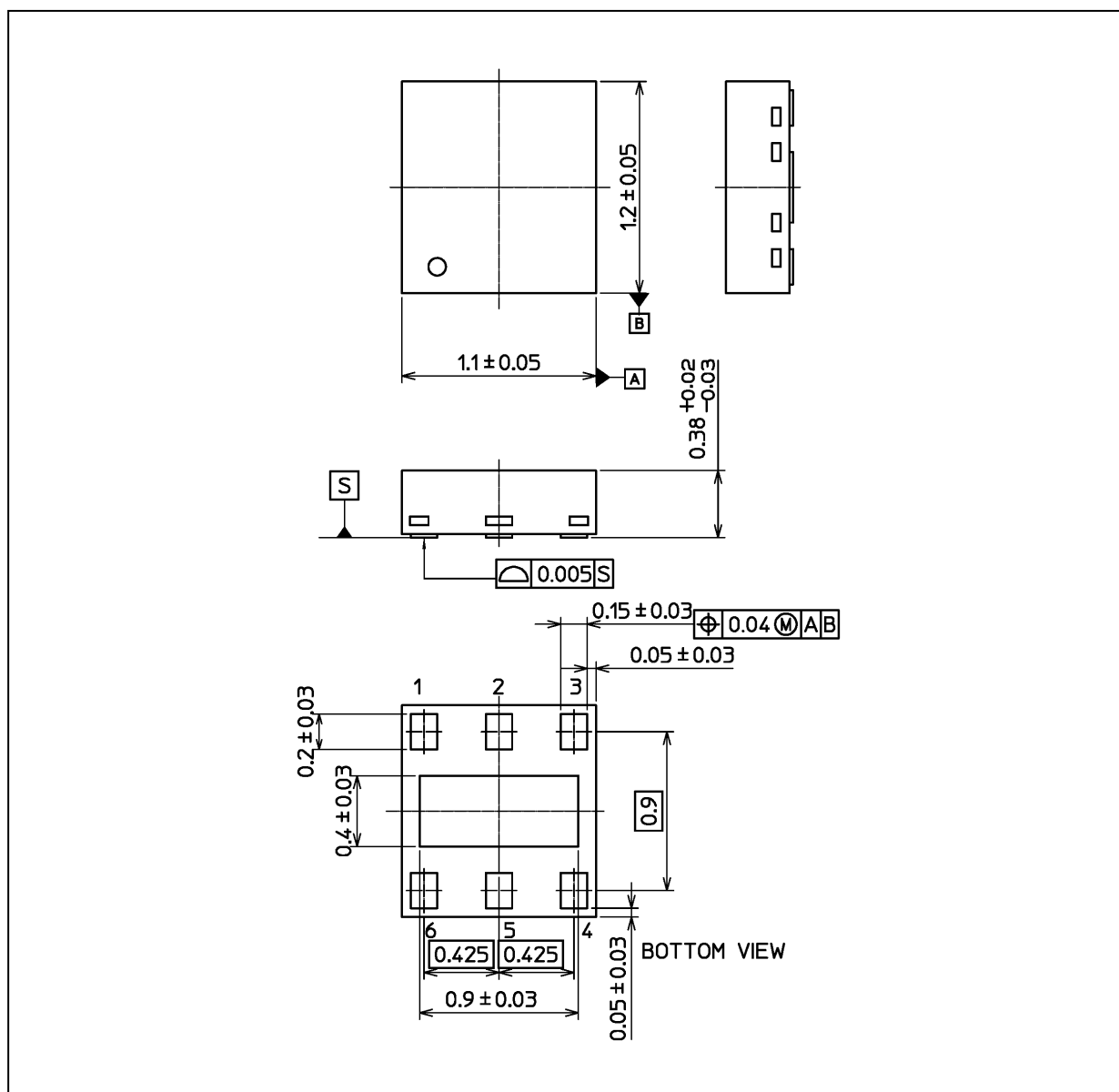


Fig. 11.3 IEC61000-4-2 (Contact)
