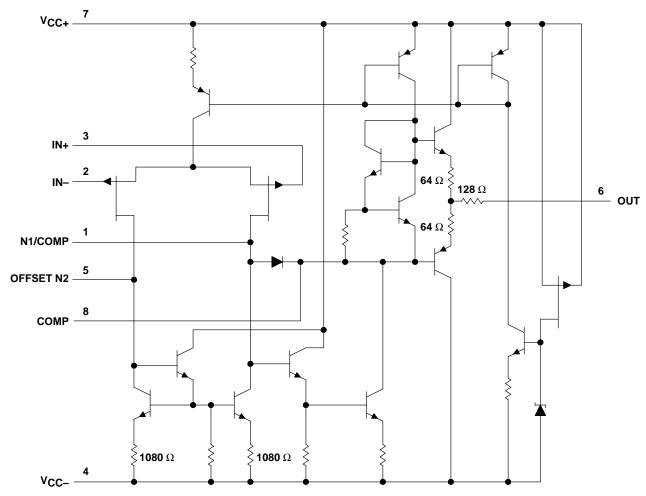

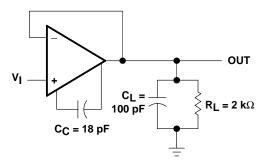


Figure 1. Unity-Gain Amplifier

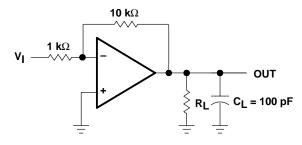


Figure 2. Gain-of-10 Inverting Amplifier

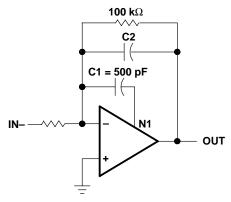


Figure 3. Feed-Forward Compensation

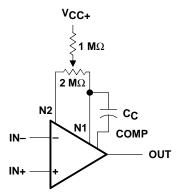
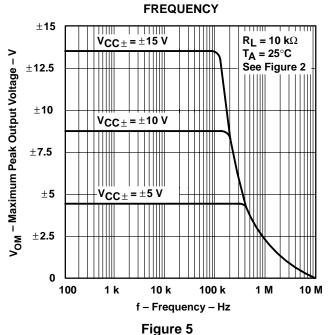


Figure 4. Input Offset Voltage Null Circuit

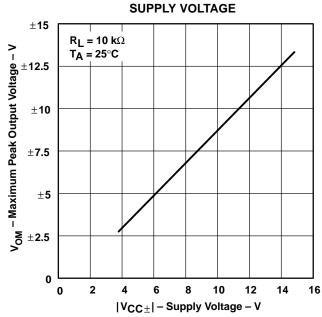

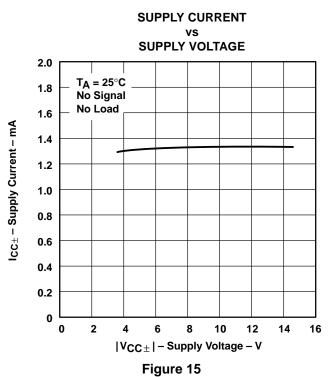
**SUPPLY CURRENT PER AMPLIFIER** 

# DIFFERENTIAL VOLTAGE AMPLIFICATION vs FREQUENCY WITH FEED-FORWARD COMPENSATION



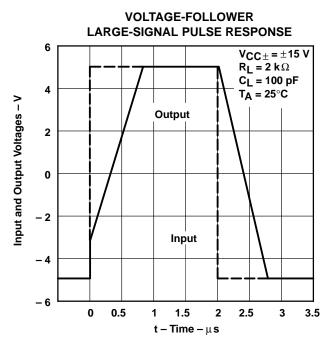

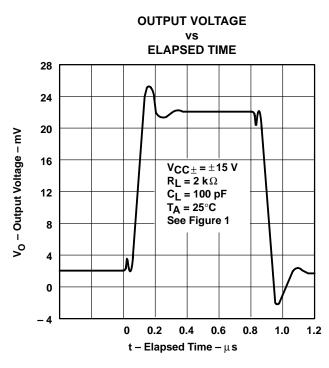
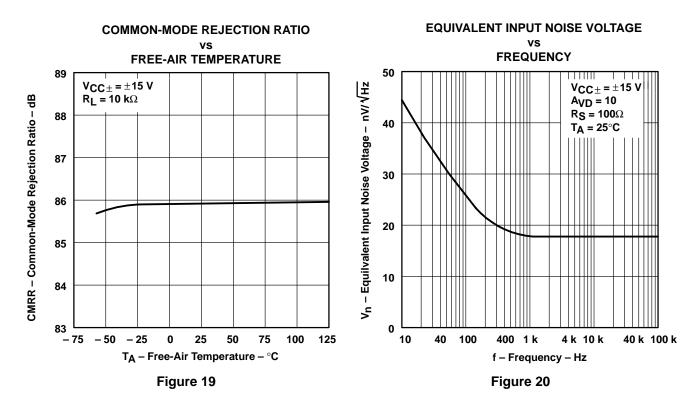

### **TOTAL HARMONIC DISTORTION**

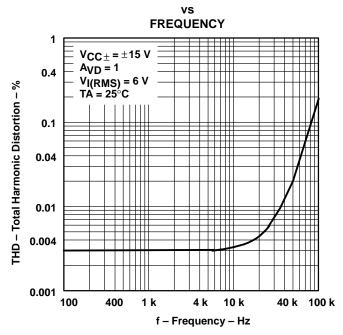

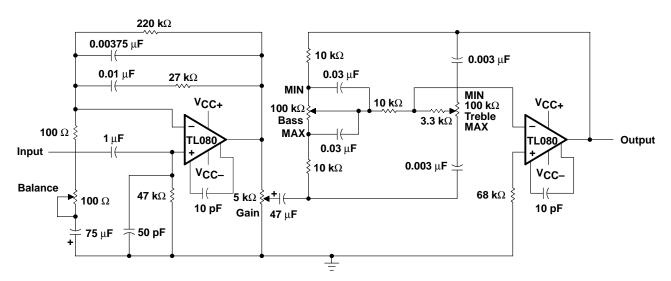


Figure 22. IC Preamplifier

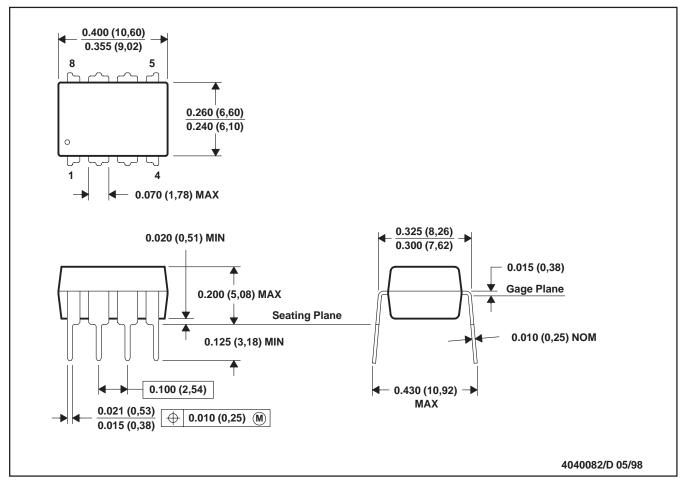
