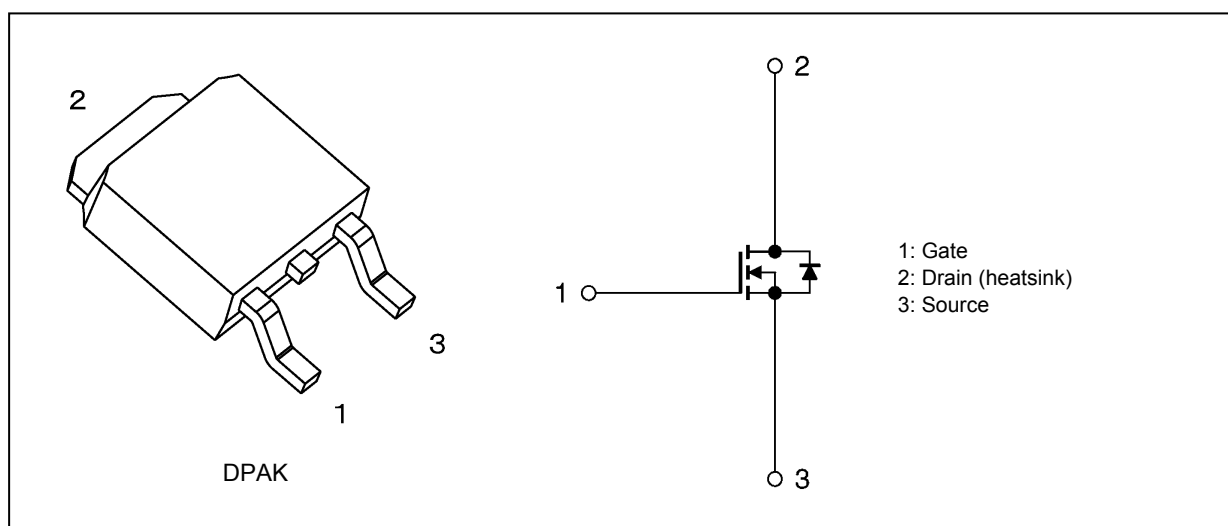

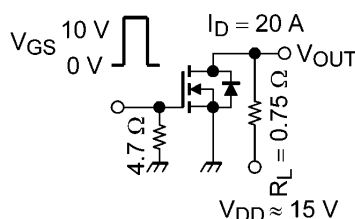

Fig. 6.2.1 Switching Time Test Circuit

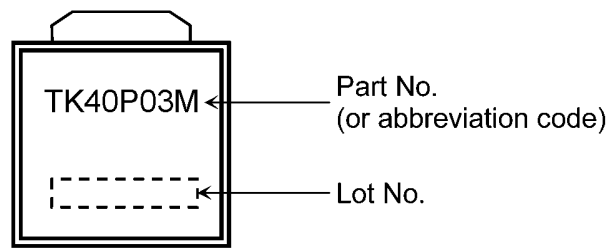

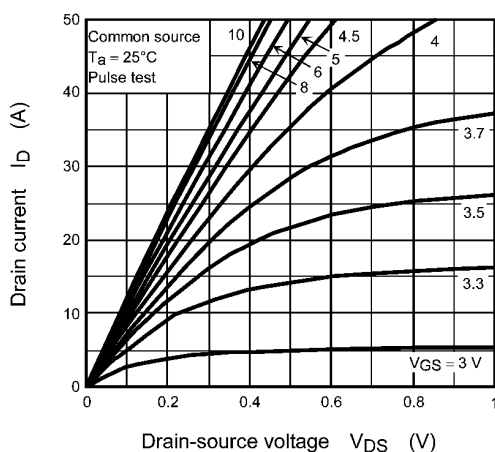


Fig. 8.1 $I_D - V_{DS}$

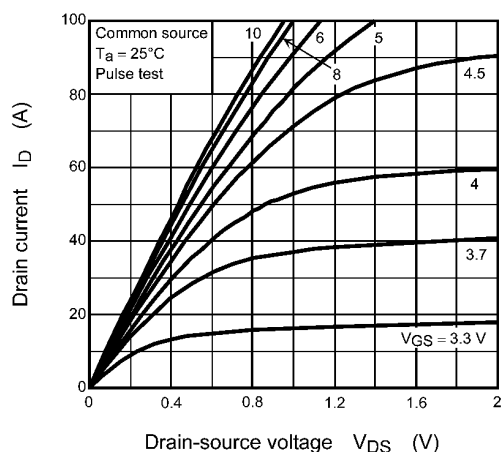


Fig. 8.2 $I_D - V_{DS}$

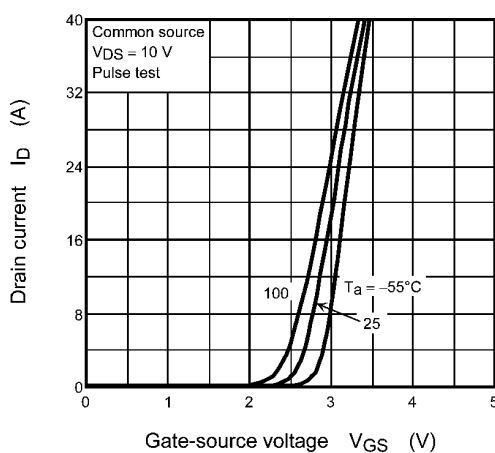


Fig. 8.3 $I_D - V_{GS}$

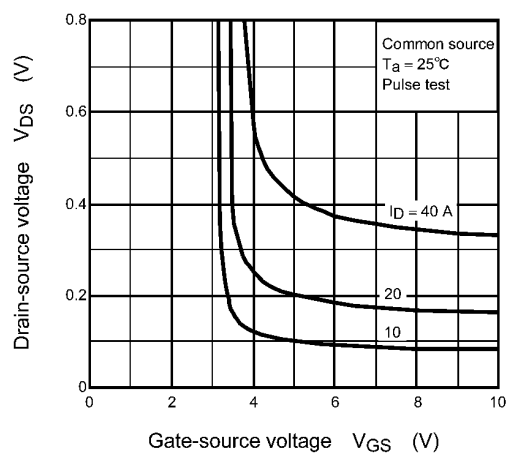


Fig. 8.4 $V_{DS} - V_{GS}$

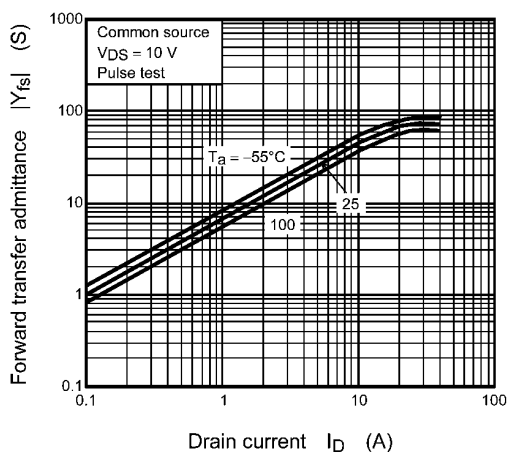


Fig. 8.5 $|Y_{fs}| - I_D$

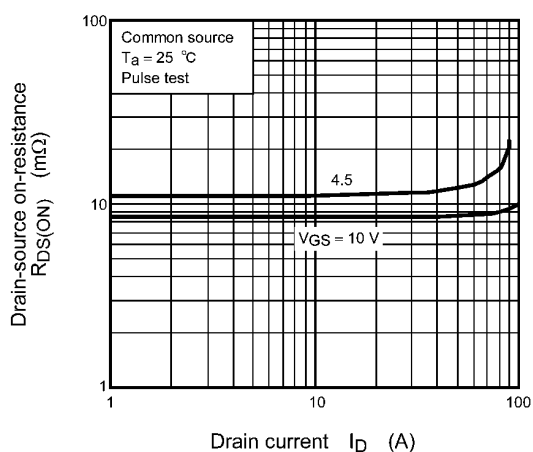


Fig. 8.6 $R_{DS(ON)} - I_D$

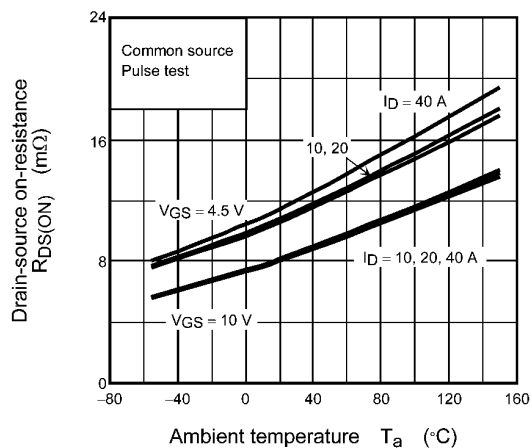


Fig. 8.7 $R_{DS(ON)} - T_a$

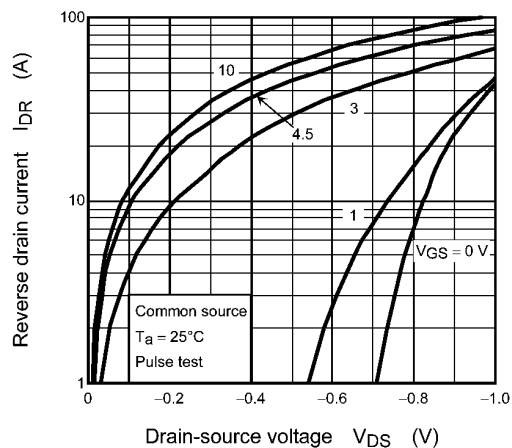


Fig. 8.8 $I_{DR} - V_{DS}$

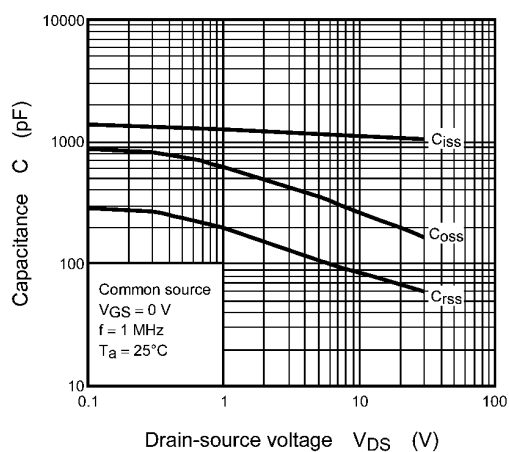


Fig. 8.9 Capacitance - V_{DS}

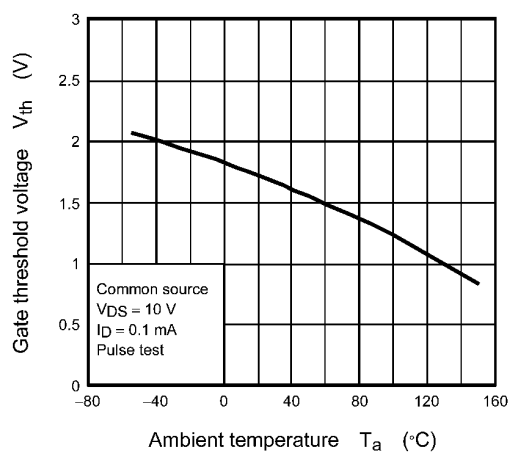
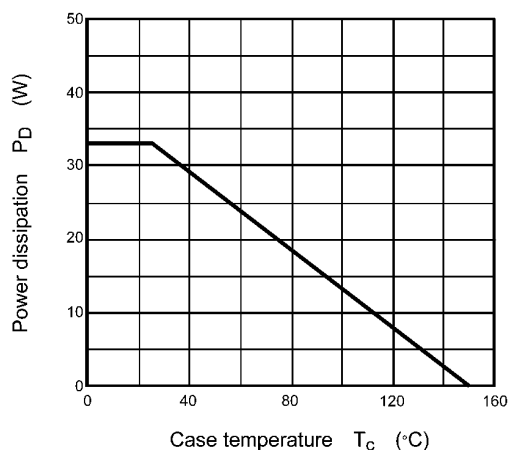


Fig. 8.10 $V_{th} - T_a$

(Guaranteed Maximum)**

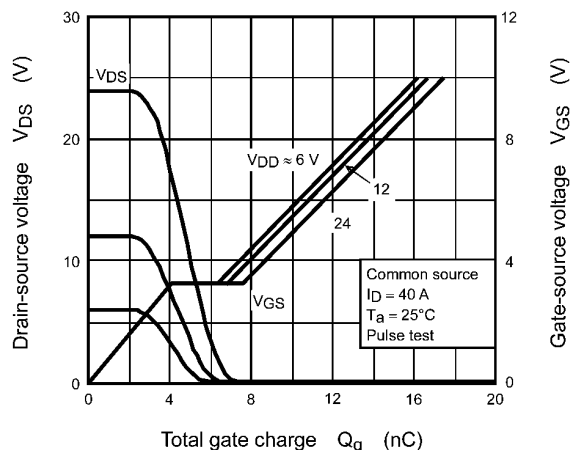


Fig. 8.12 Dynamic Input/Output Characteristics

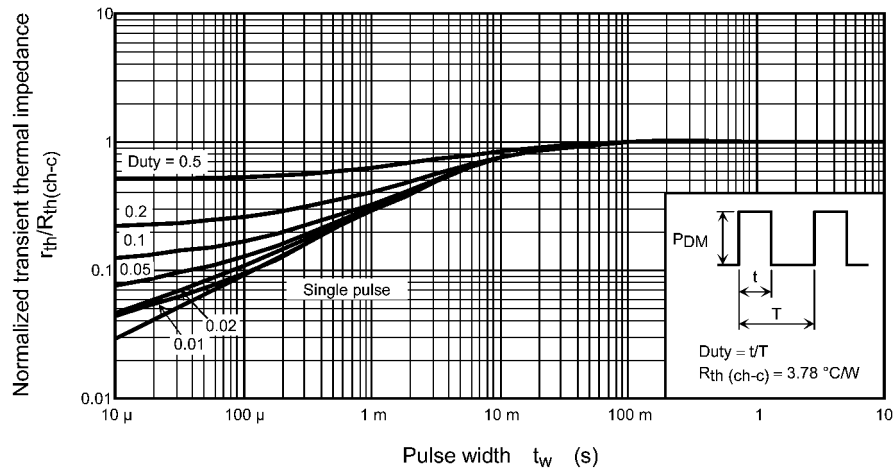


Fig. 8.13 $r_{th}/R_{th(ch-c)} - t_w$
(Guaranteed Maximum)

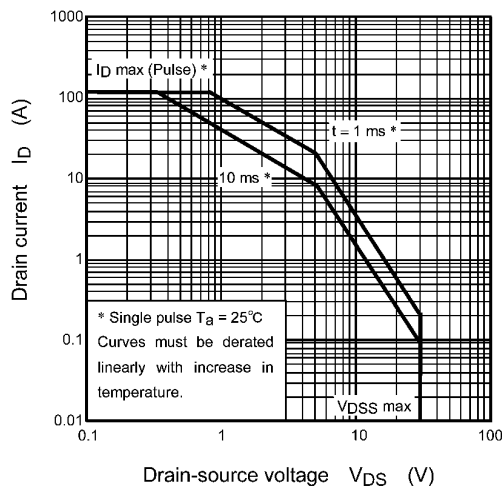


Fig. 8.14 Safe Operating Area
(Guaranteed Maximum)

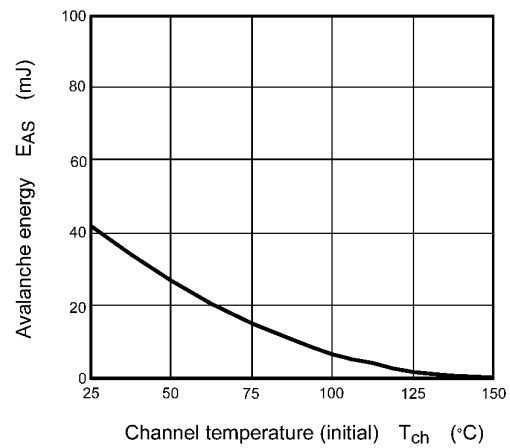


Fig. 8.15 $E_{AS} - T_{ch}$
(Guaranteed Maximum)

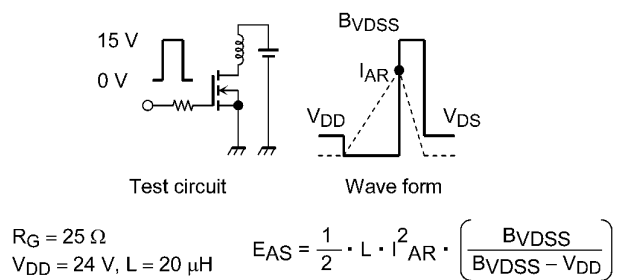
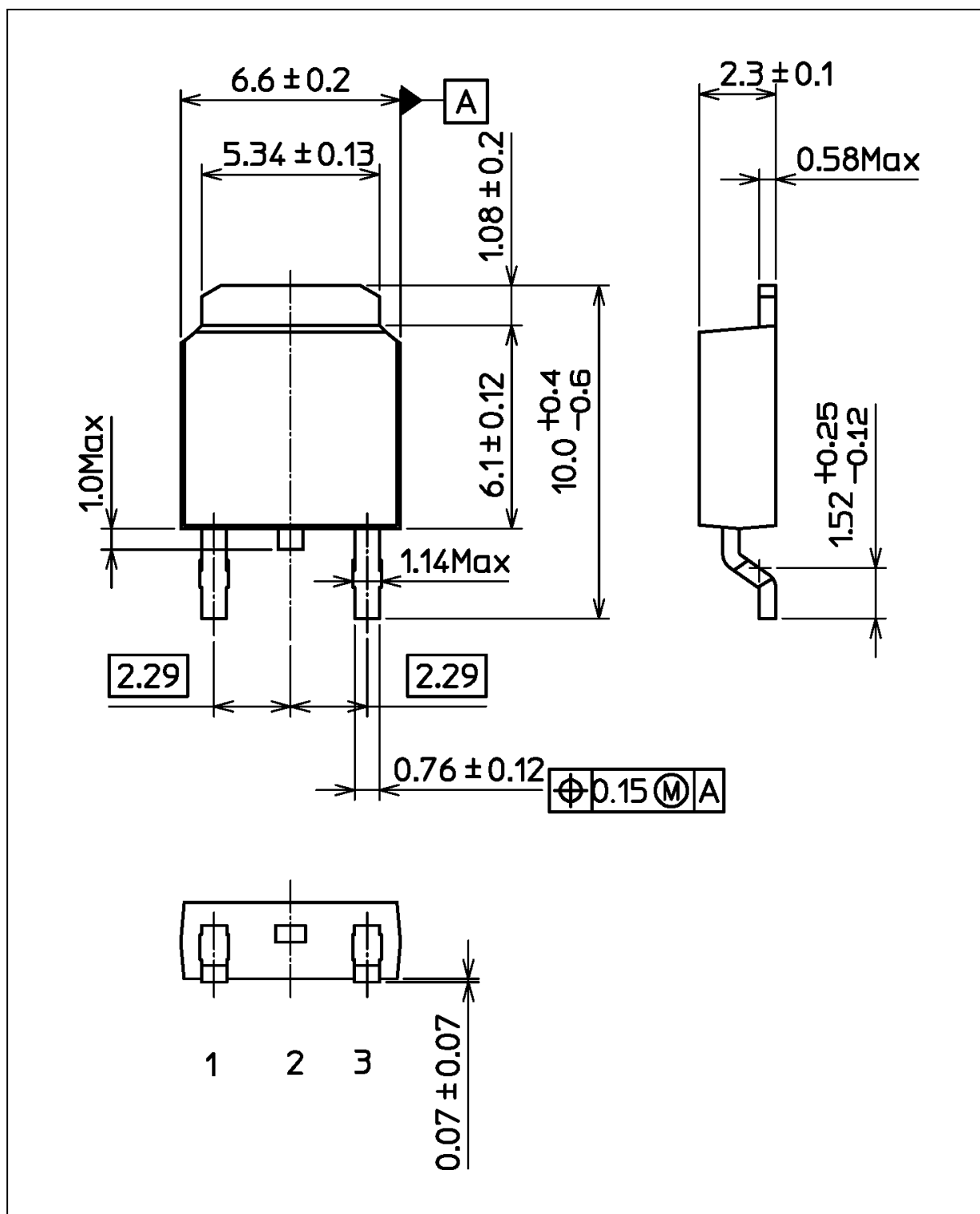


Fig. 8.16 Test Circuit/Waveform
