

# 74HC74; 74HCT74

Dual D-type flip-flop with set and reset; positive edge-trigger

Rev. 4 — 27 August 2012

## 1. General description

The 74HC74 and 74HCT74 are dual positive edge triggered D-type flip-flop. They have individual data ( $\overline{nD}$ ), clock ( $\overline{nCP}$ ), set ( $\overline{nSD}$ ) and reset ( $\overline{nRD}$ ) inputs, and complementary  $nQ$  and  $\overline{nQ}$  outputs. Data at the  $\overline{nD}$ -input, that meets the set-up and hold time requirements on the LOW-to-HIGH clock transition, is stored in the flip-flop and appears at the  $nQ$  output. Schmitt-trigger action in the clock input, makes the circuit highly tolerant to slower clock rise and fall times. Inputs include clamp diodes that enable the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of  $V_{CC}$ .

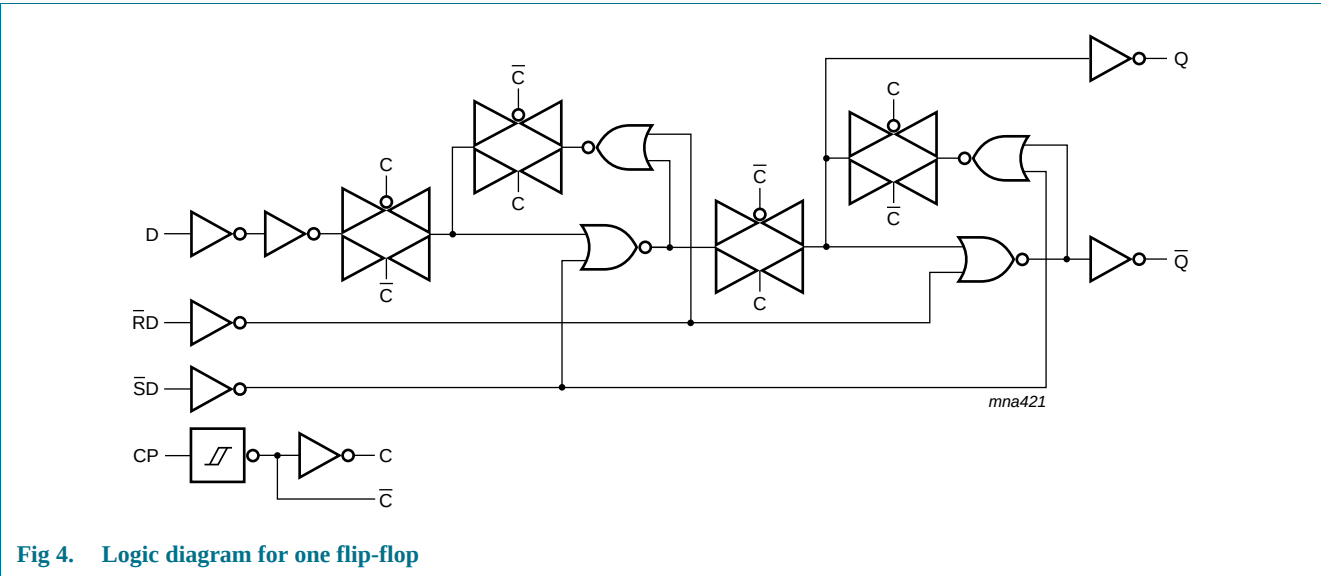

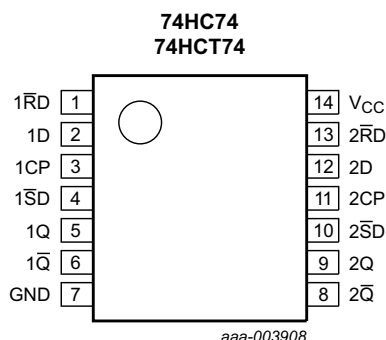
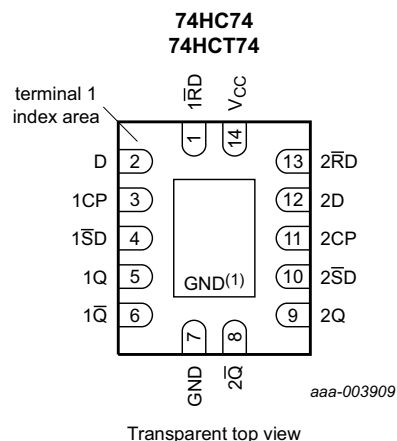


Fig 5. Pin configuration for DIP14, SO14 and (T)SSOP14



- (1) This is not a supply pin. The substrate is attached to this pad using conductive die attach material. There is no electrical or mechanical requirement to solder this pad. However, if it is soldered, the solder land should remain floating or be connected to GND.

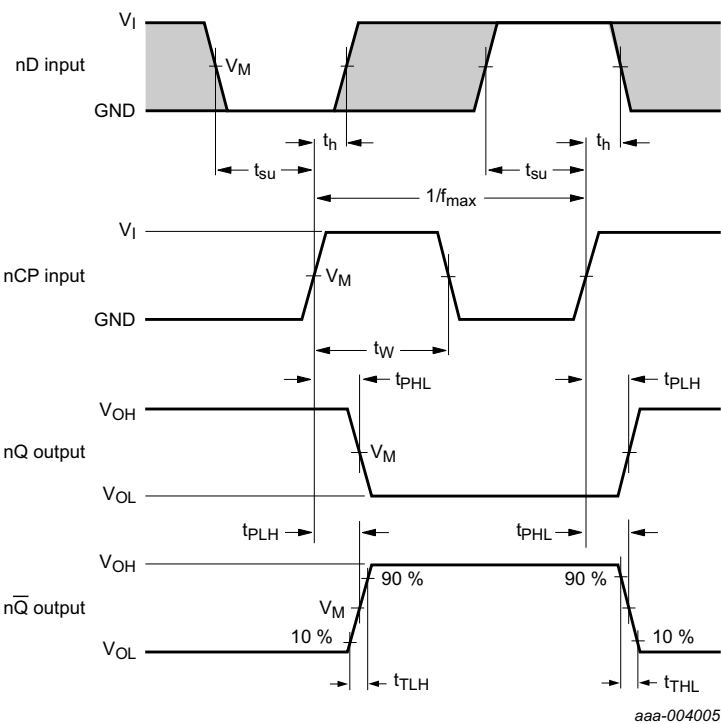

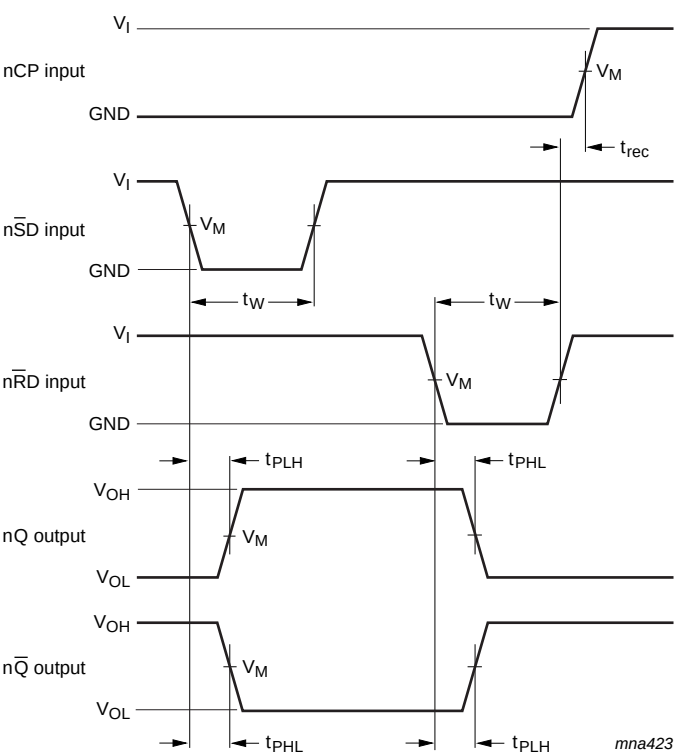

**Fig 7. Input to output propagation delay, output transition time, clock input pulse width and maximum frequency**

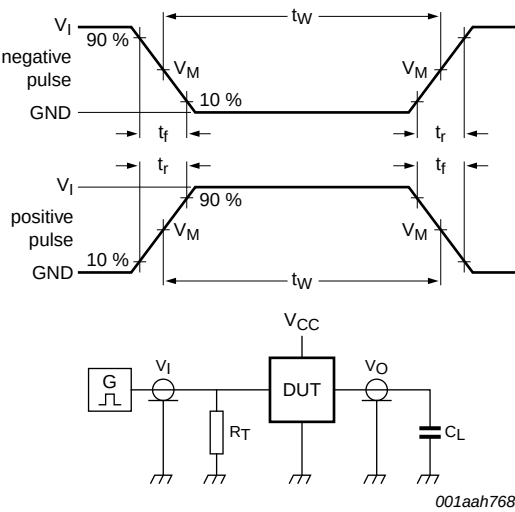

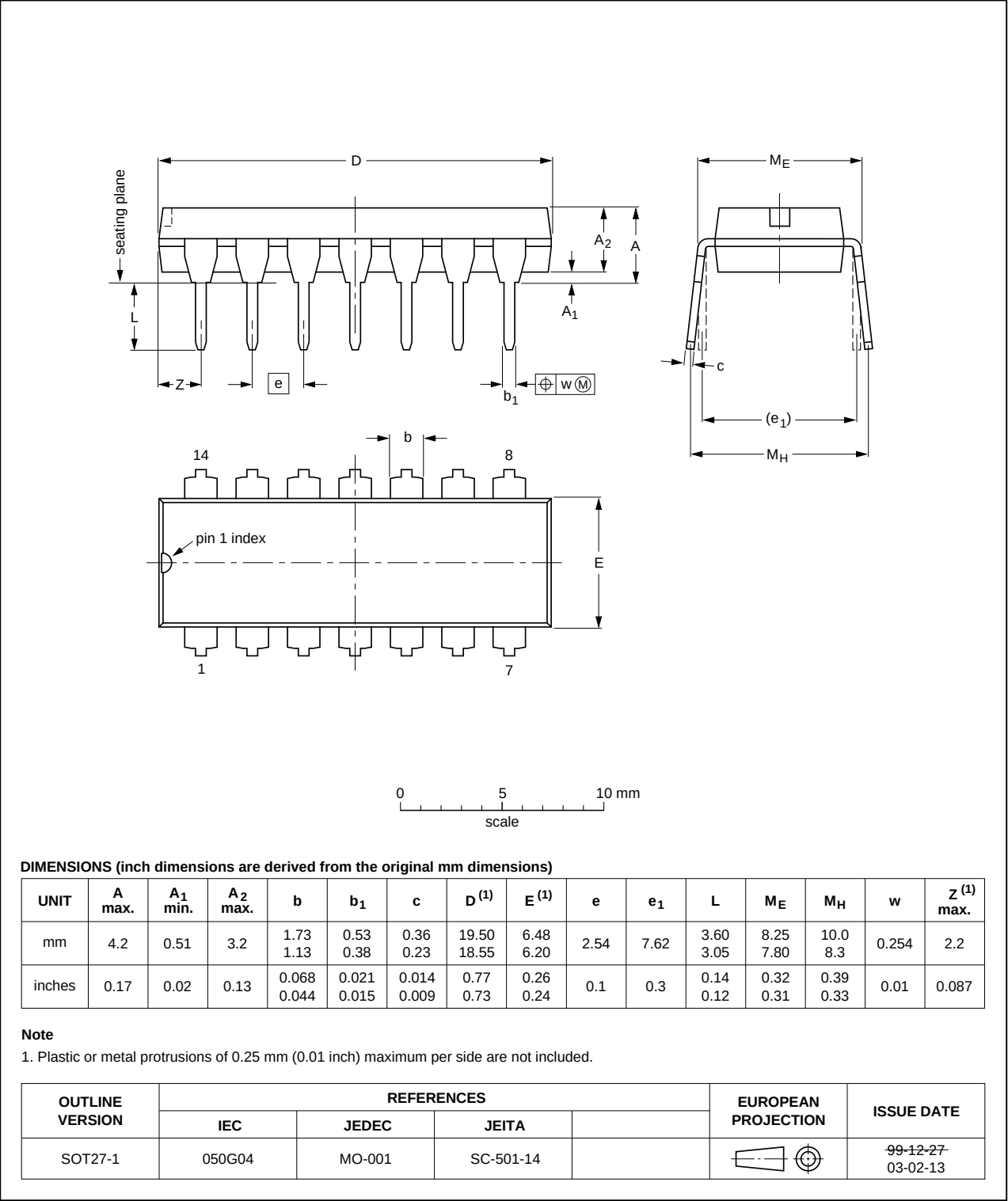


Fig 10. Package outline SOT27-1 (DIP14)

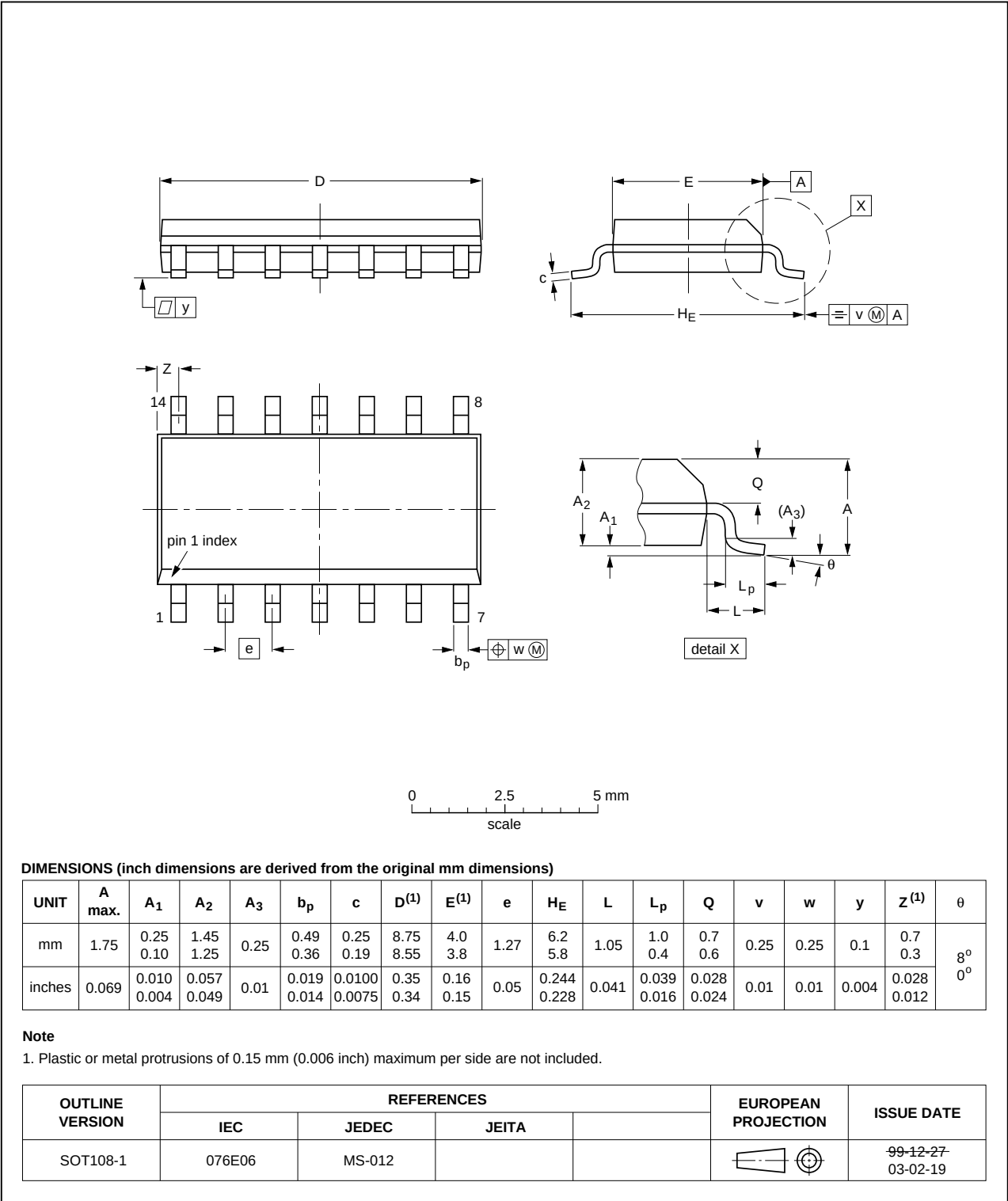


Fig 11. Package outline SOT108-1 (SO14)

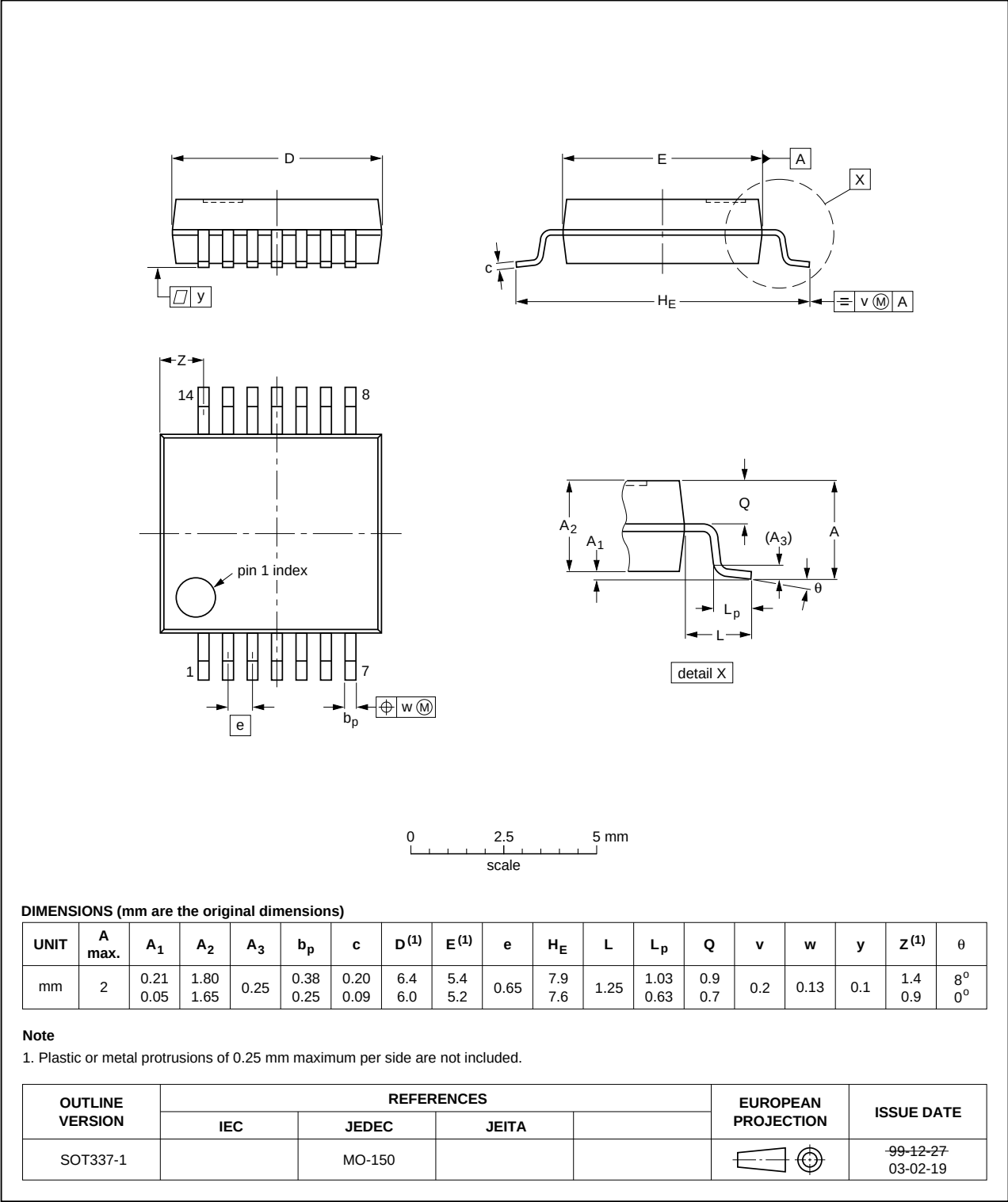


Fig 12. Package outline SOT337-1 (SSOP14)

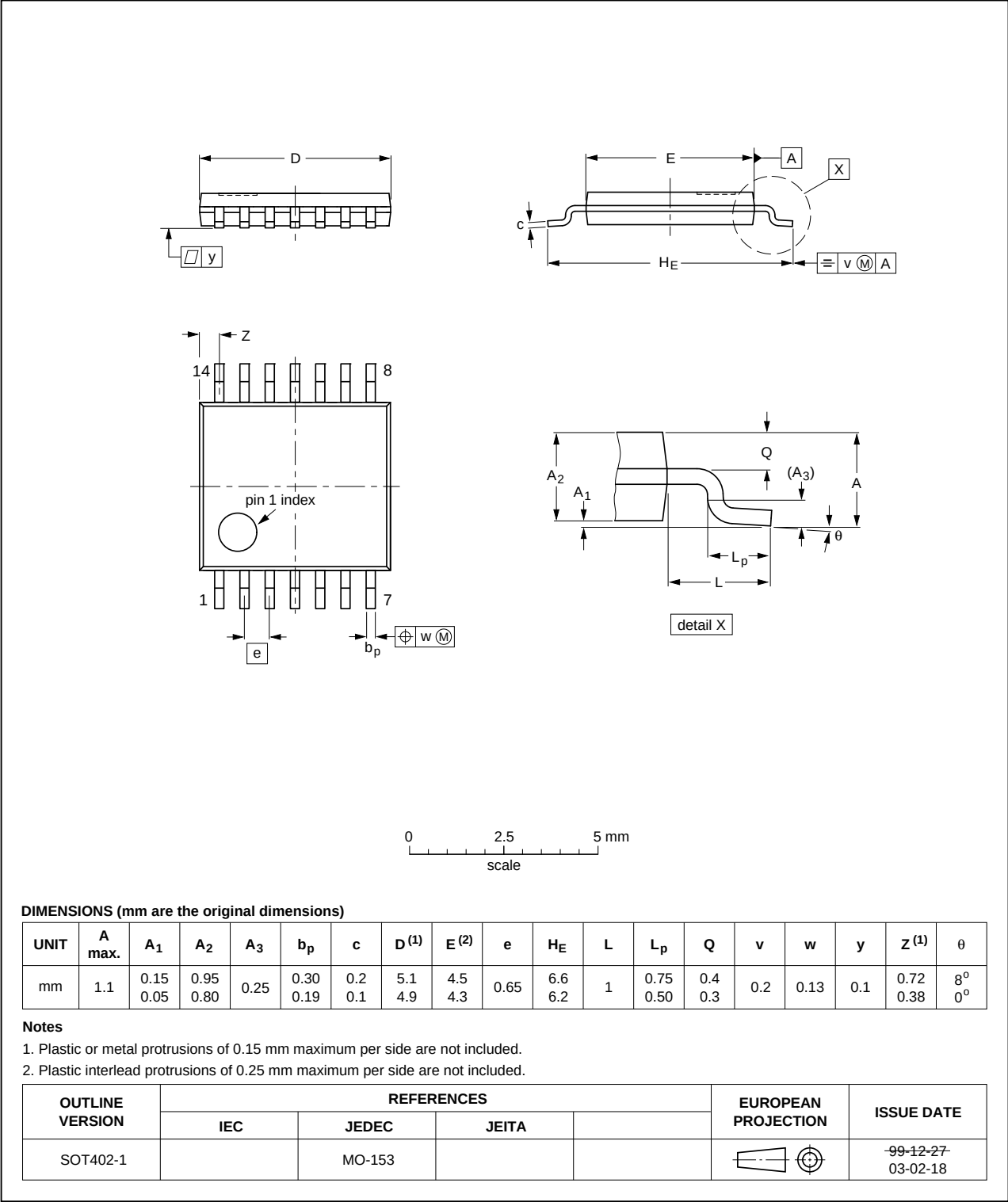


Fig 13. Package outline SOT402-1 (TSSOP14)

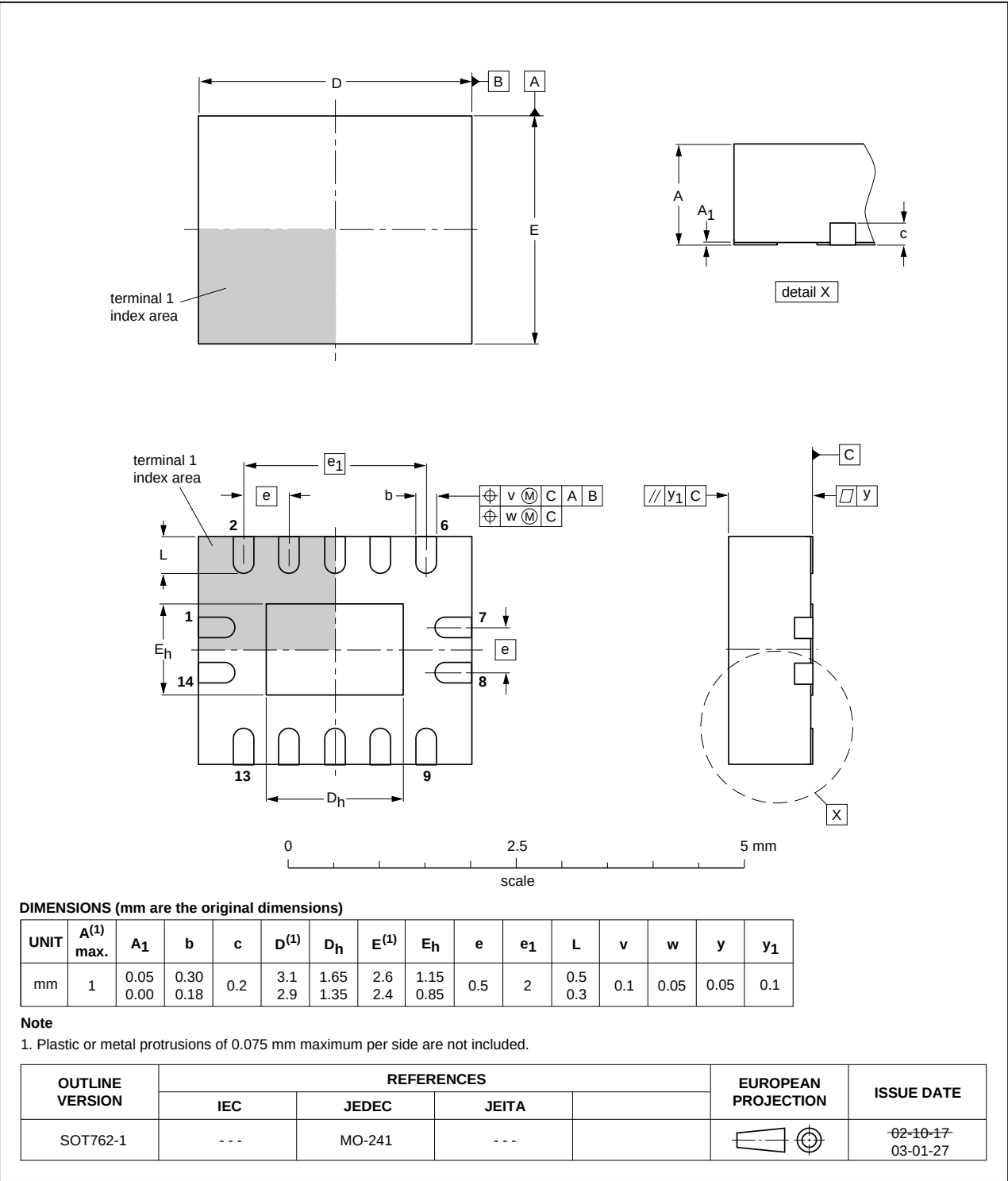


Fig 14. Package outline SOT762-1 (DHVQFN14)
