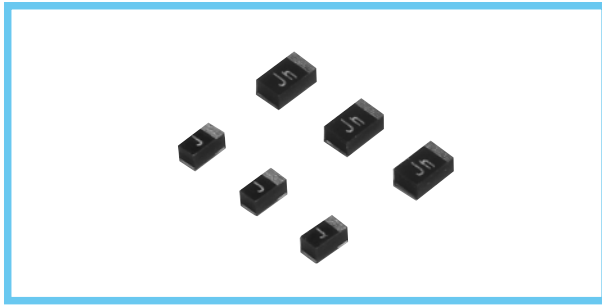

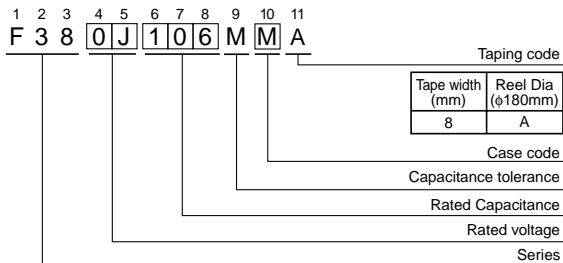

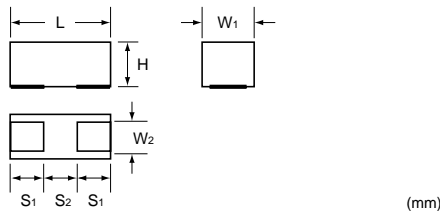

## Type numbering system (Example : 6.3V 10μF)

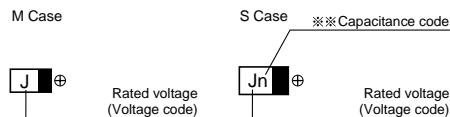
