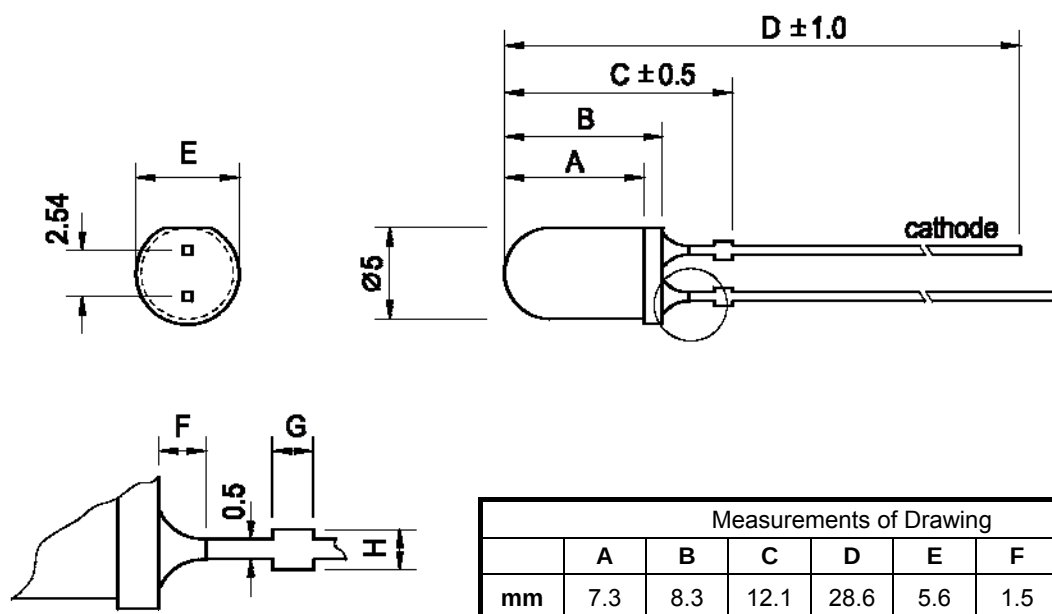

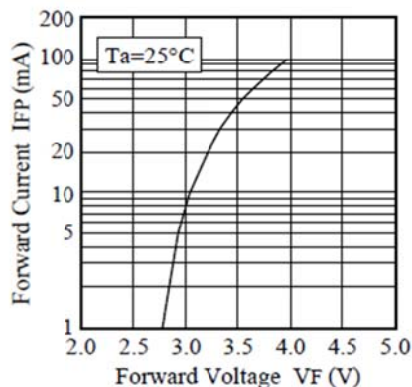

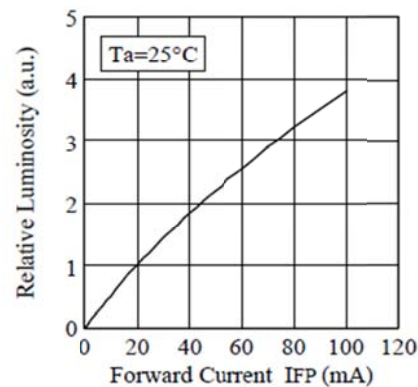

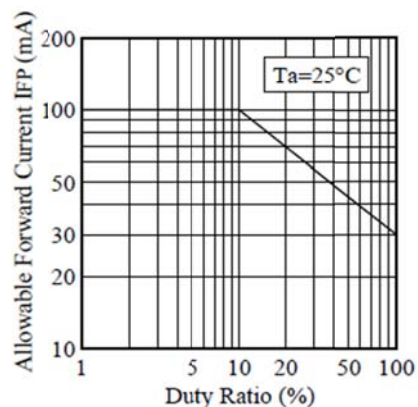
■ Forward Voltage vs.
Forward Current



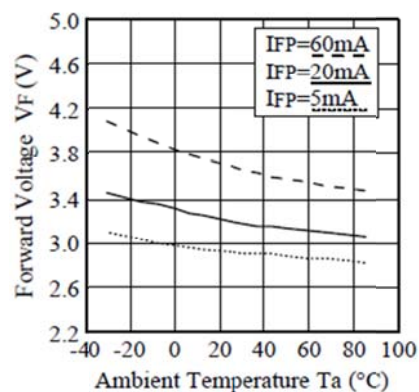
■ Forward Current vs.
Relative Luminosity



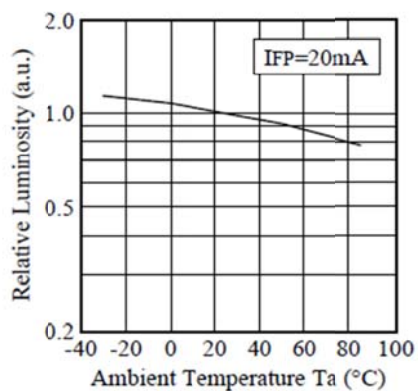
■ Duty Ratio vs.
Allowable Forward Current



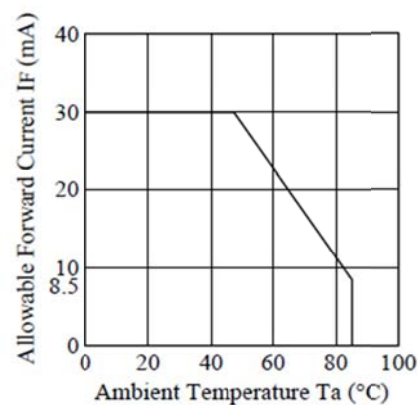
■ Ambient Temperature vs.

Relative Luminosity



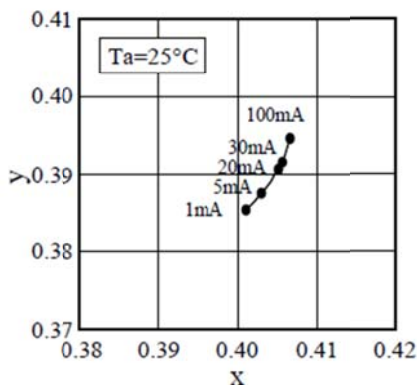

Allowable Forward Current



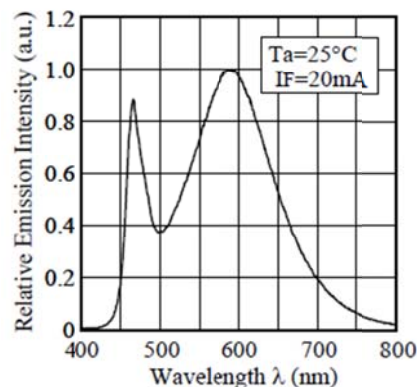

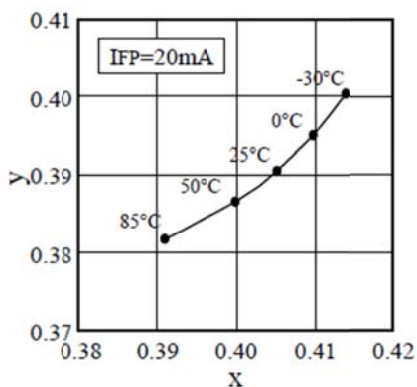
■ Forward Current vs. Chromaticity Coordinate



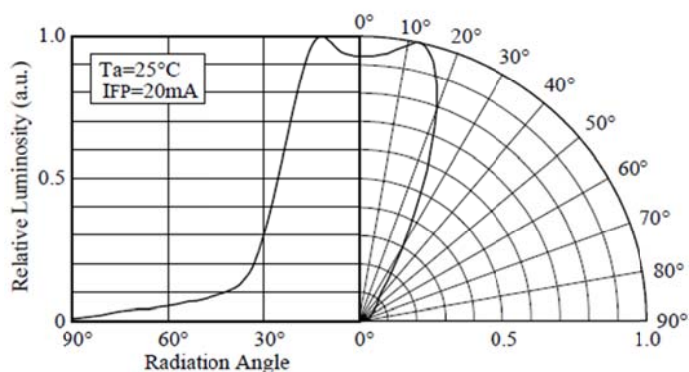
■ Spectrum
