

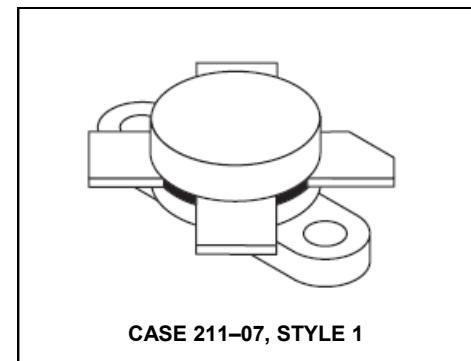

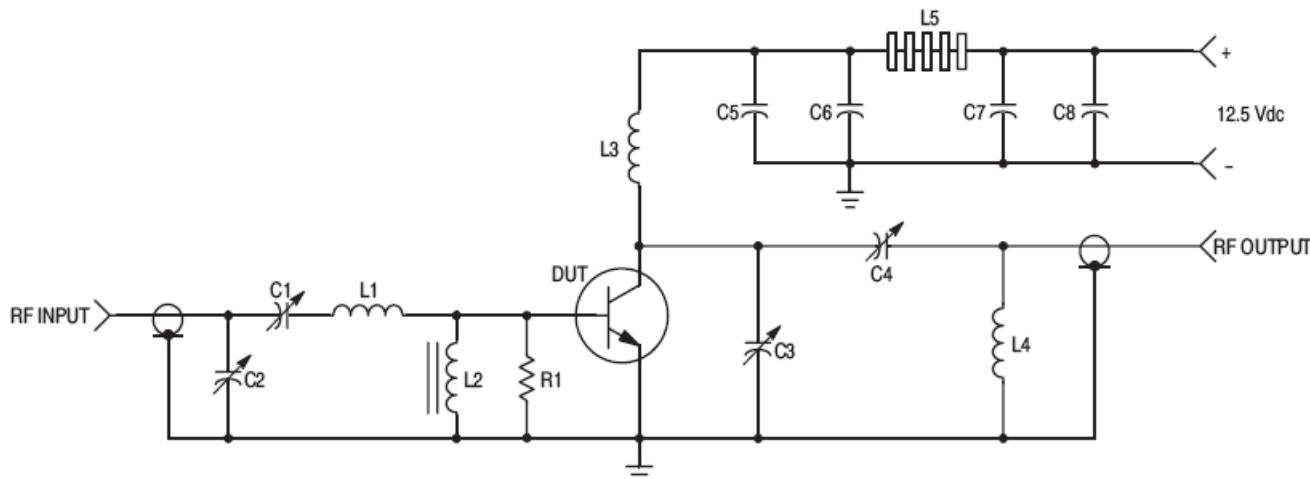

Figure 1. 30 MHz Test Circuit Schematic

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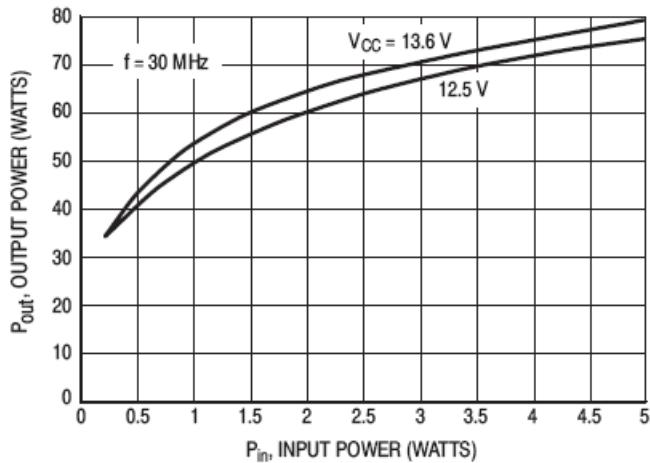


Figure 2. Output Power versus Input Power

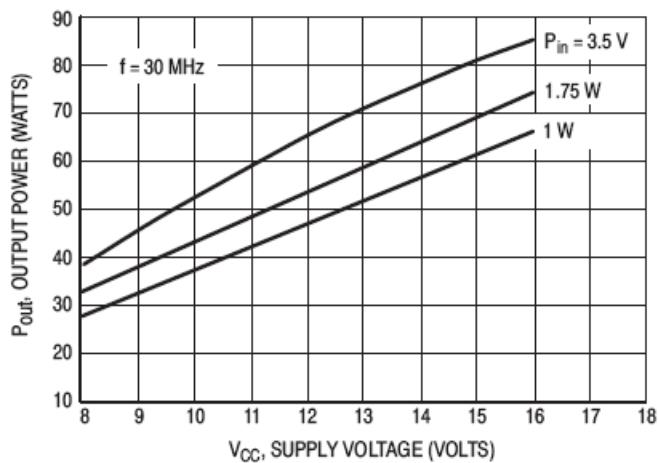
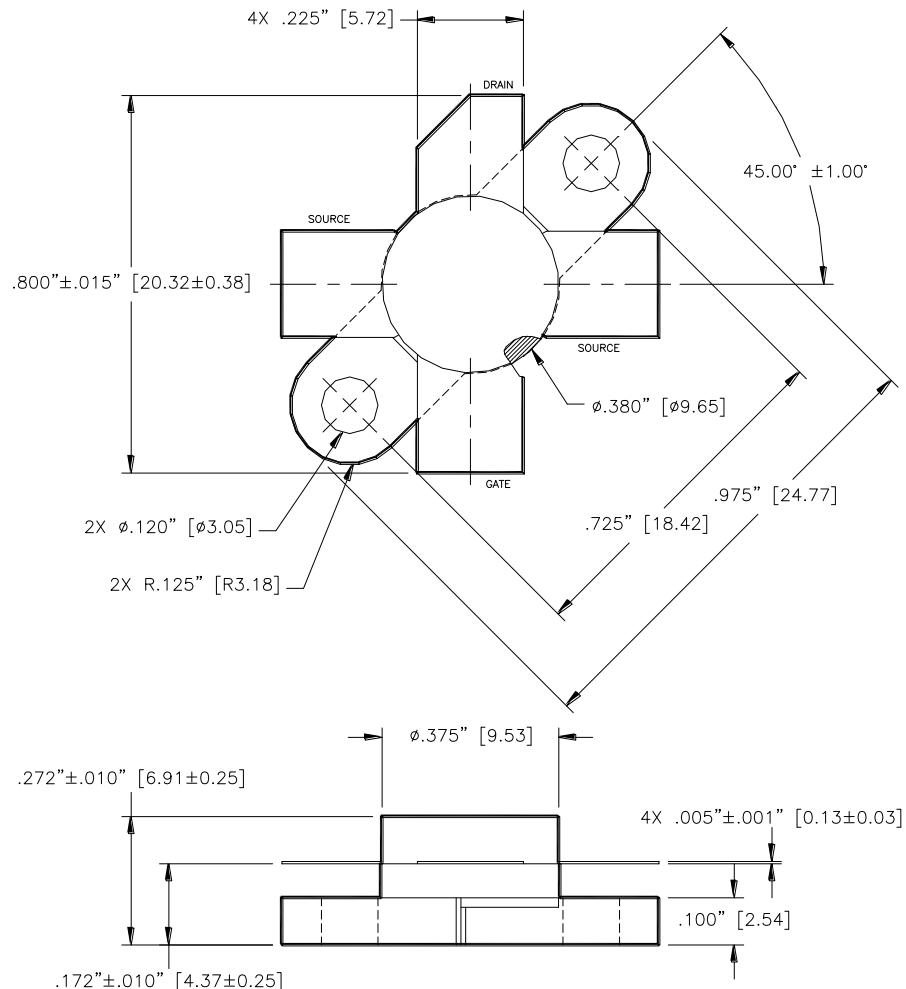


Figure 3. Output Power versus Supply Voltage
