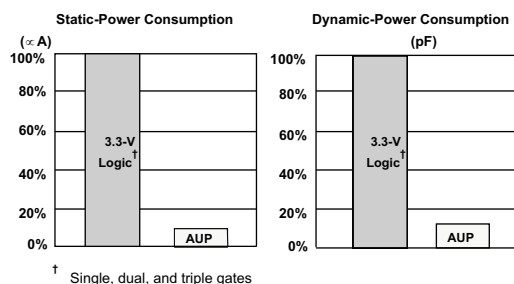

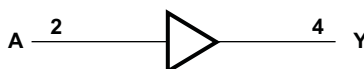

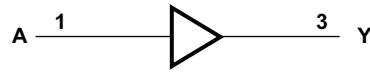

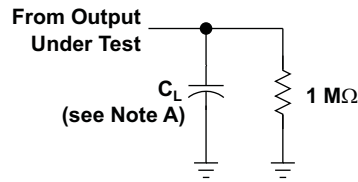

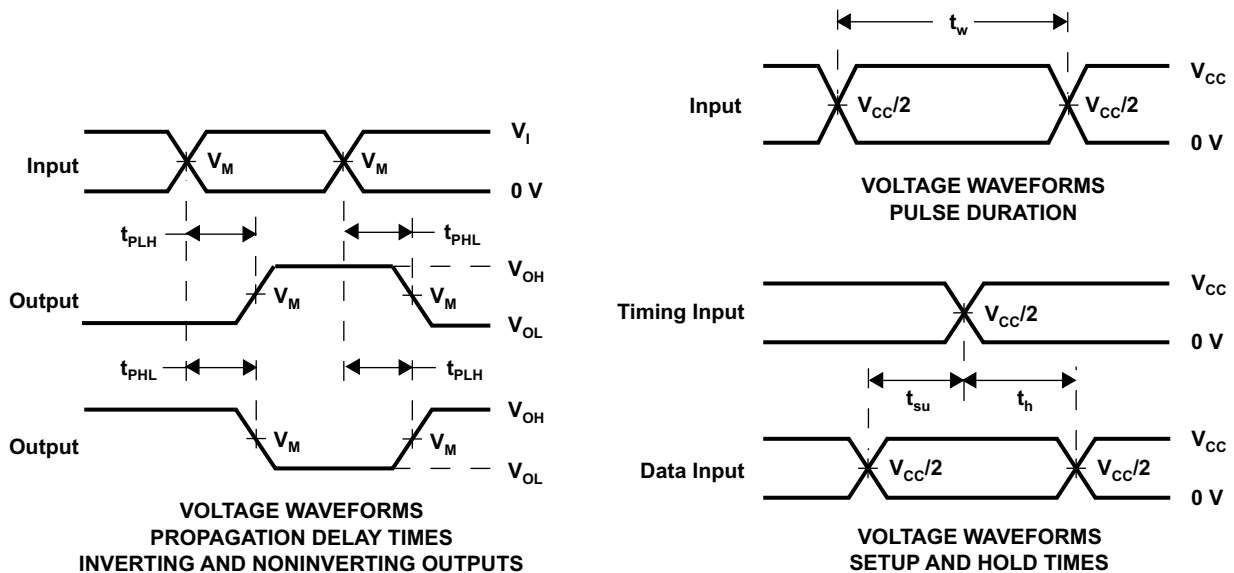

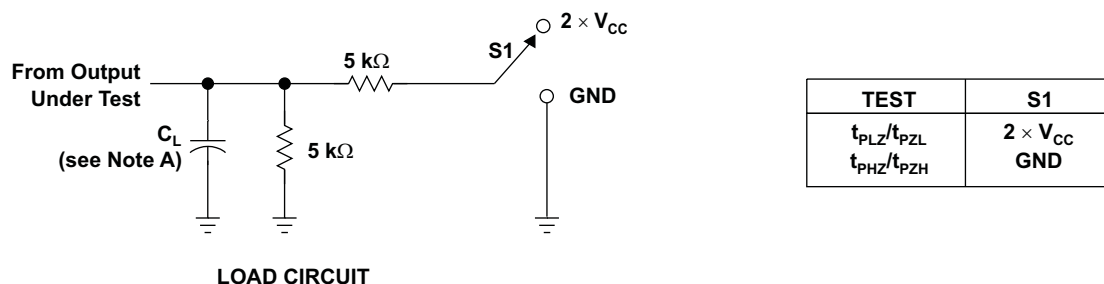

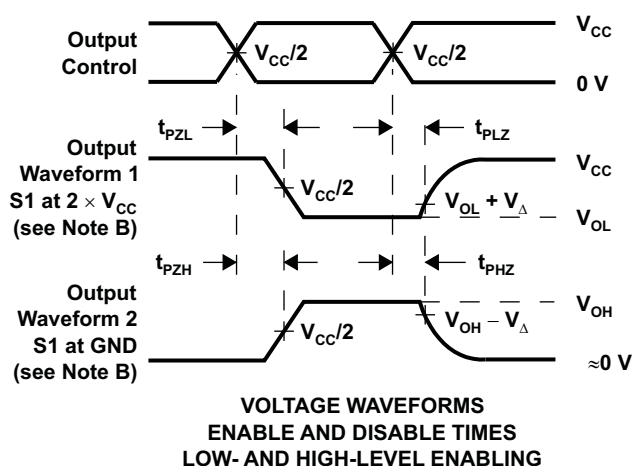

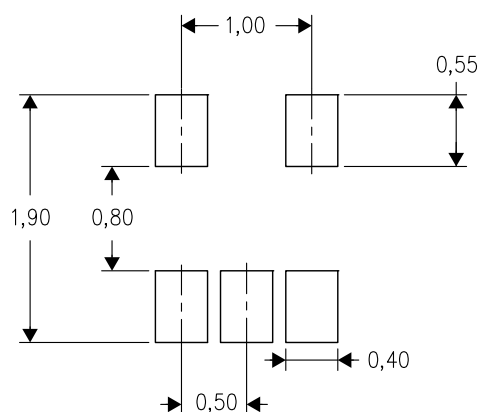

Non-Soldermask Defined Pad

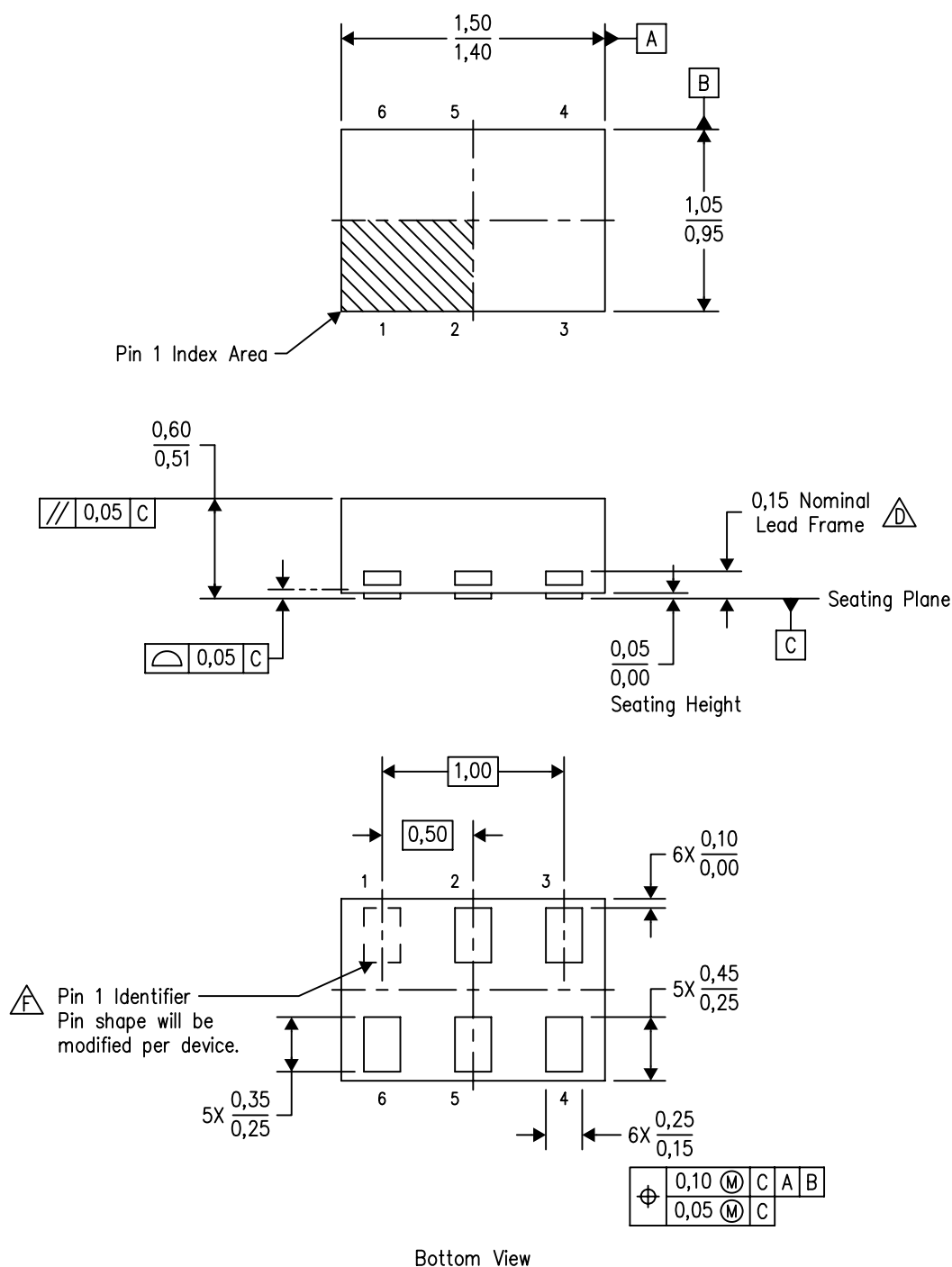

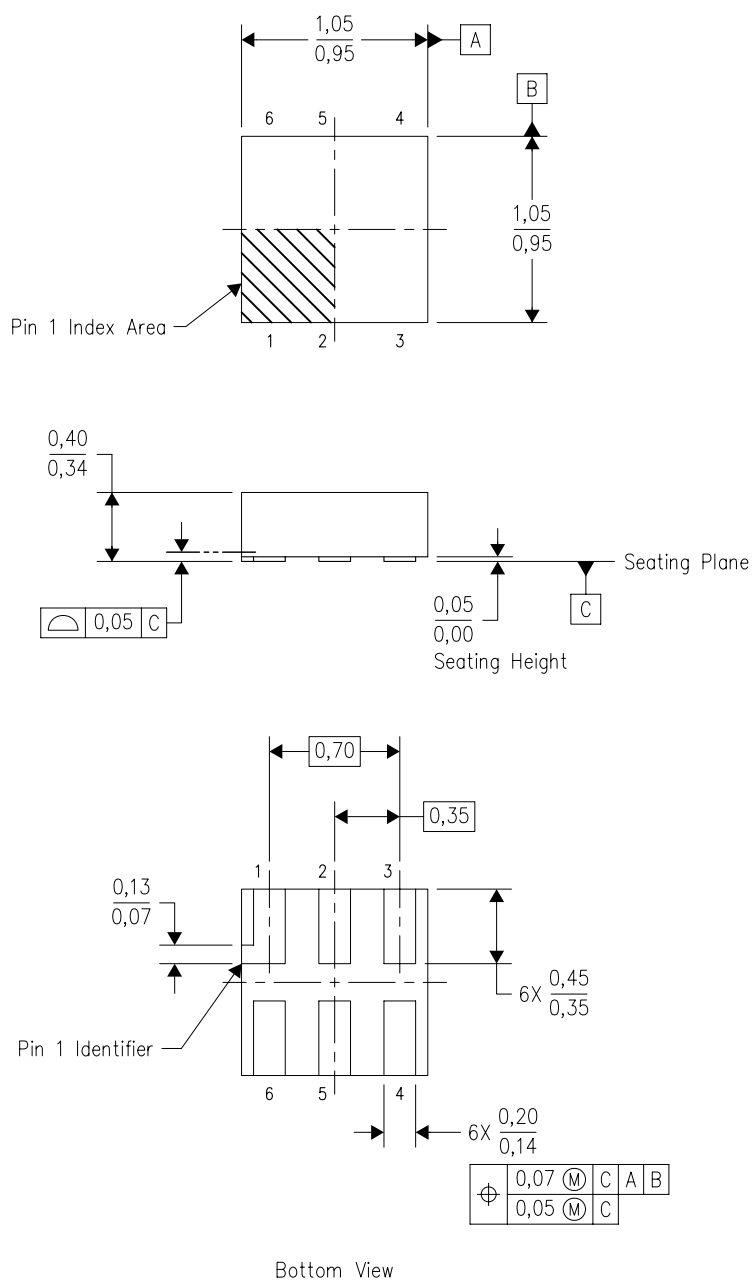

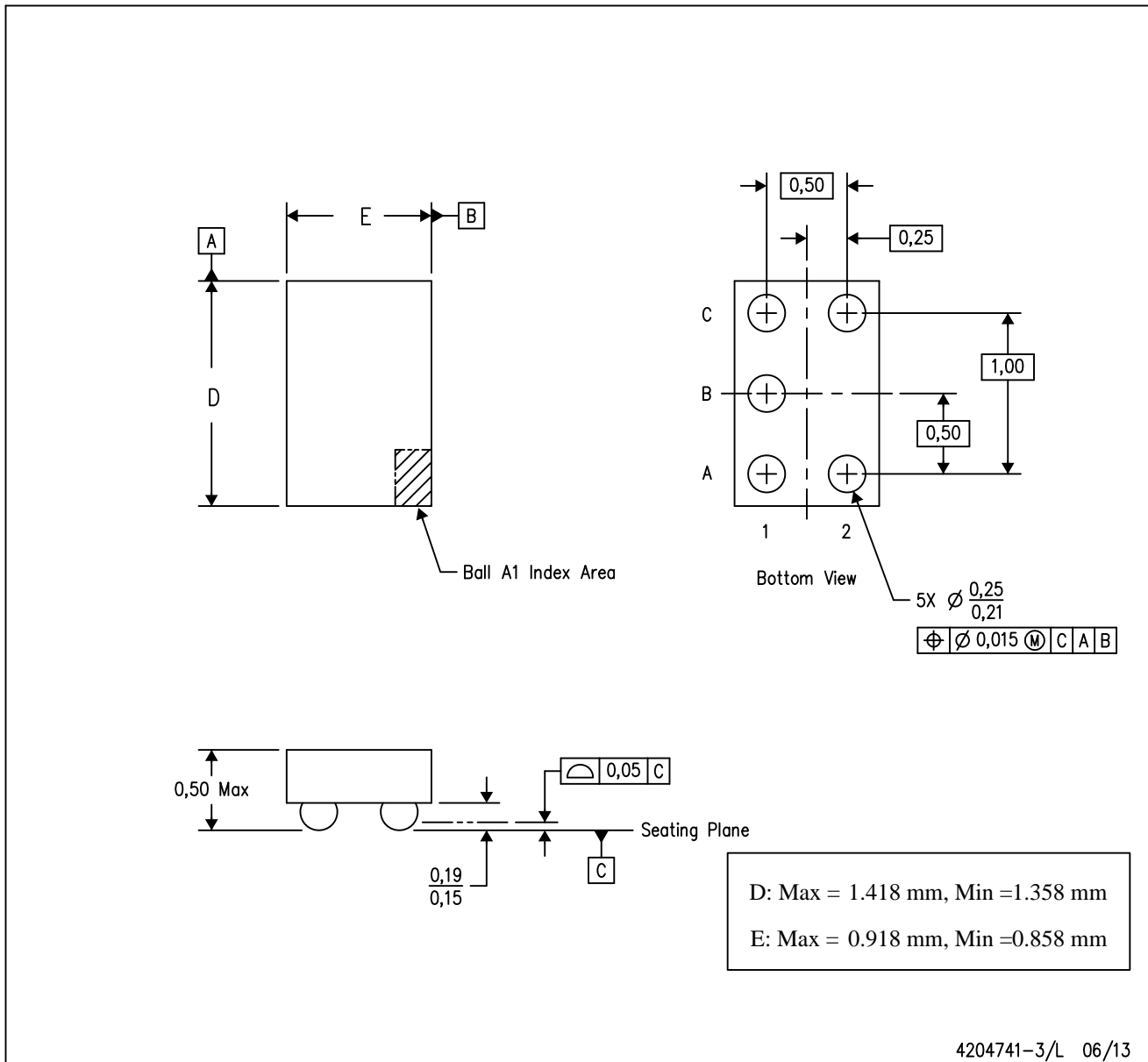
