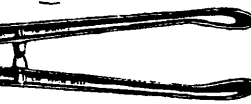

Sizes from 14" to 42"



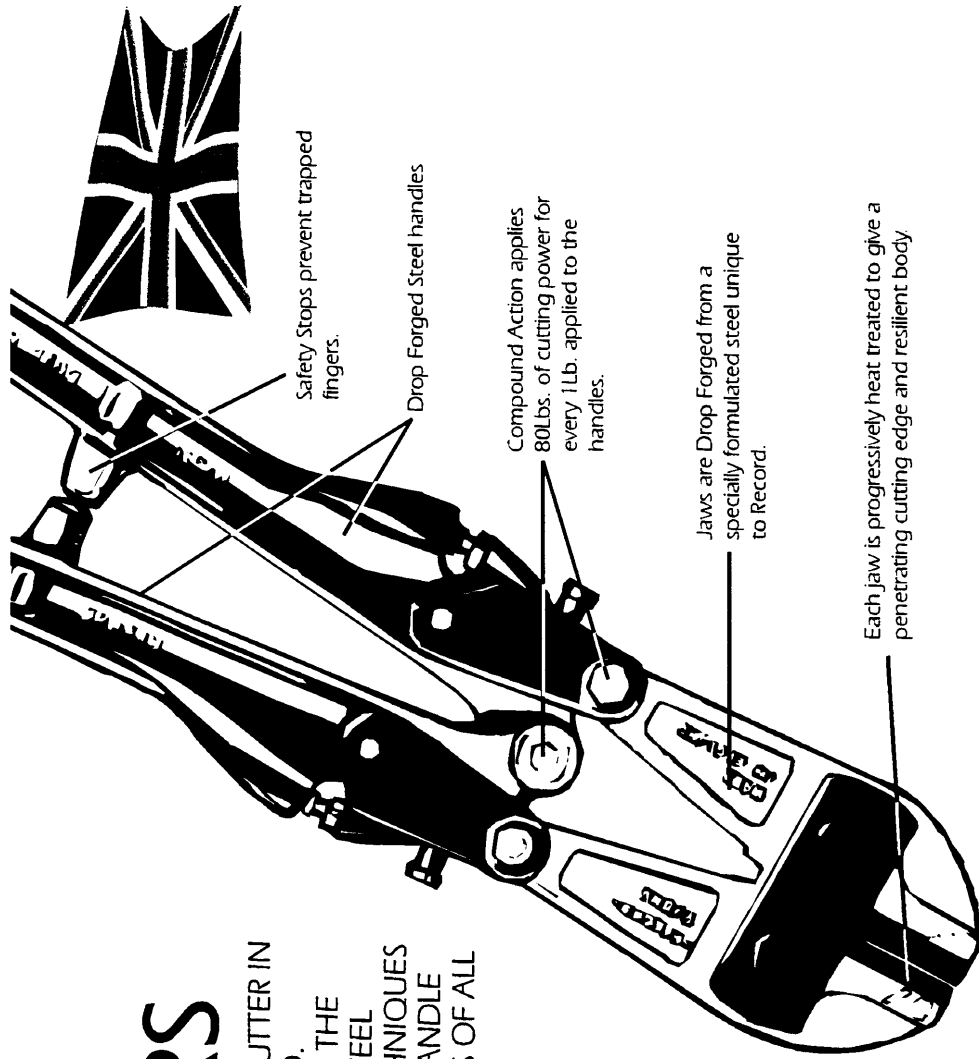
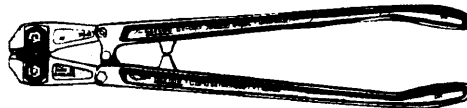
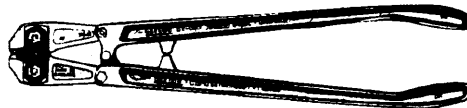
The **Cam Adjusted** cutter (Right) is lightweight, inexpensive and ideal for the farm, garage, home or small workshop.
