The PS2566-1, -2 and PS2566L-1, -2 are optically coupled isolators containing GaAs light emitting diodes and an NPN silicon darlington connected phototransistor.

PS2566-1, -2 are in a plastic DIP (Dual In-line Package) and PS2566L-1, -2 are lead bending type (Gull-wing) for surface mount.

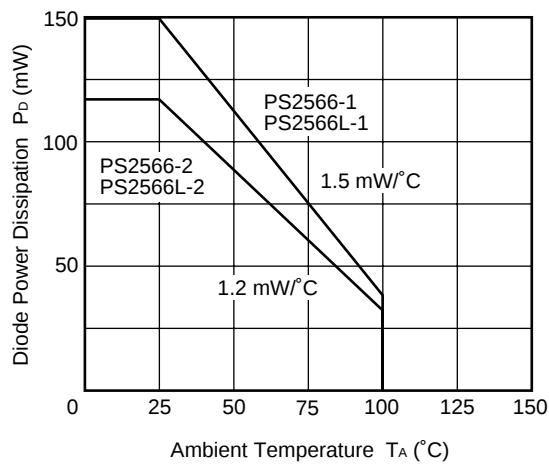


*2 Test circuit for switching time

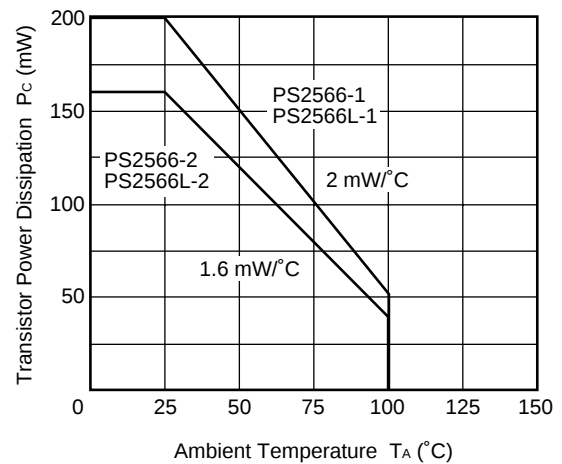

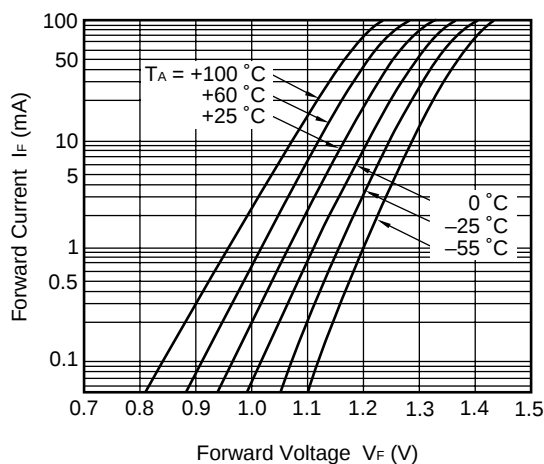
DIODE POWER DISSIPATION vs.
AMBIENT TEMPERATURE



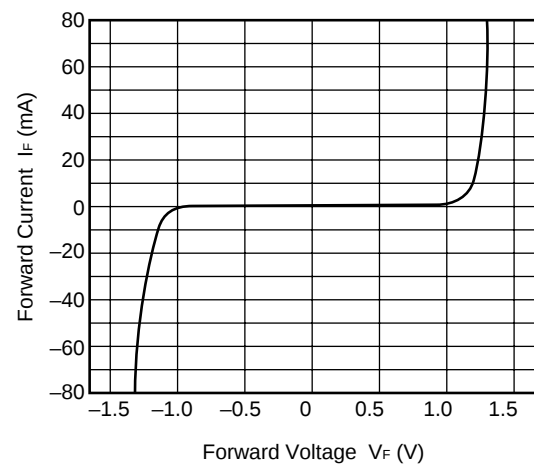
TRANSISTOR POWER DISSIPATION
vs. AMBIENT TEMPERATURE



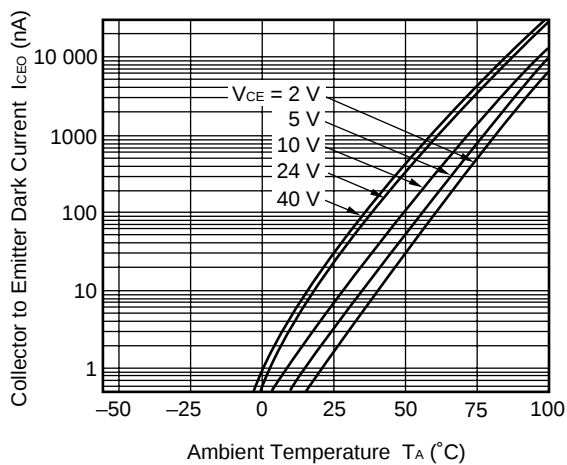
FORWARD CURRENT vs.
FORWARD VOLTAGE



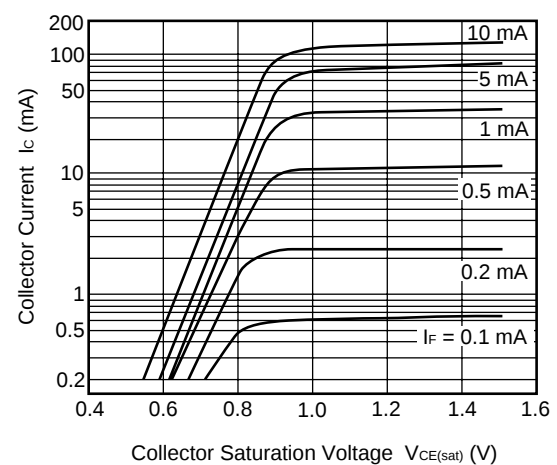
FORWARD CURRENT vs.
FORWARD VOLTAGE



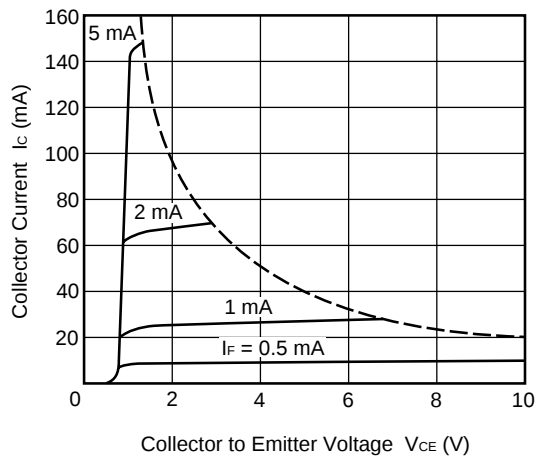
COLLECTOR TO EMITTER DARK
CURRENT vs. AMBIENT TEMPERATURE



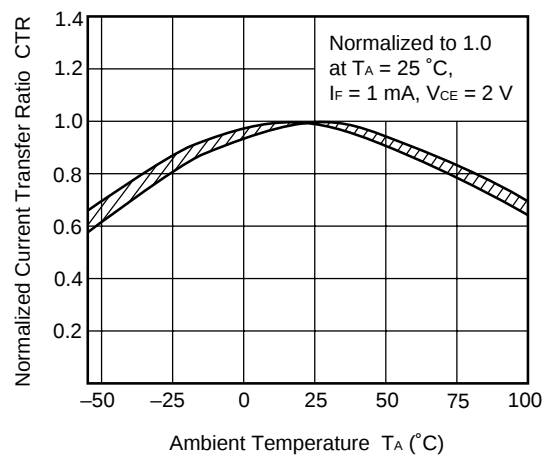
COLLECTOR CURRENT vs.
COLLECTOR SATURATION VOLTAGE



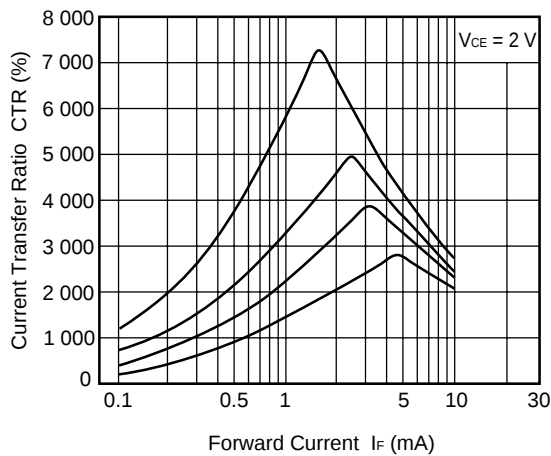
COLLECTOR CURRENT vs.
COLLECTOR TO EMITTER VOLTAGE



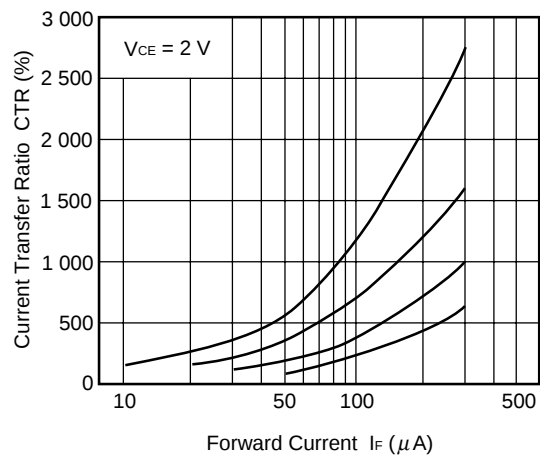
NORMALIZED CURRENT TRANSFER
RATIO vs. AMBIENT TEMPERATURE



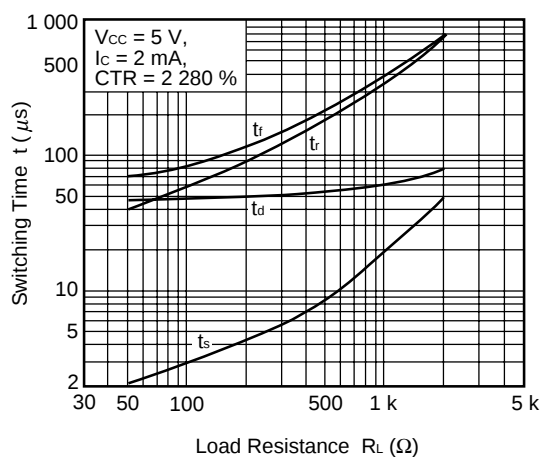
CURRENT TRANSFER RATIO vs.
FORWARD CURRENT



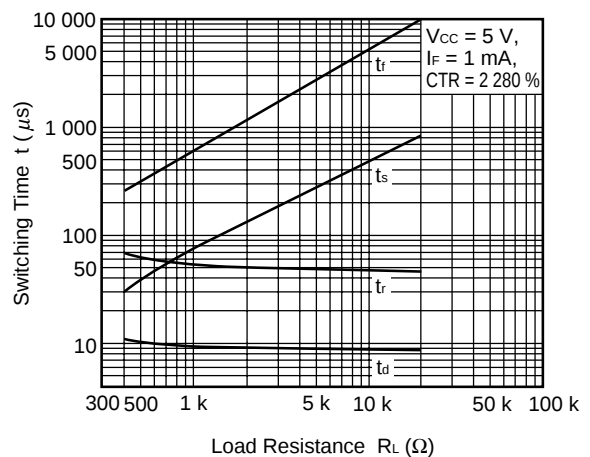
CURRENT TRANSFER RATIO vs.

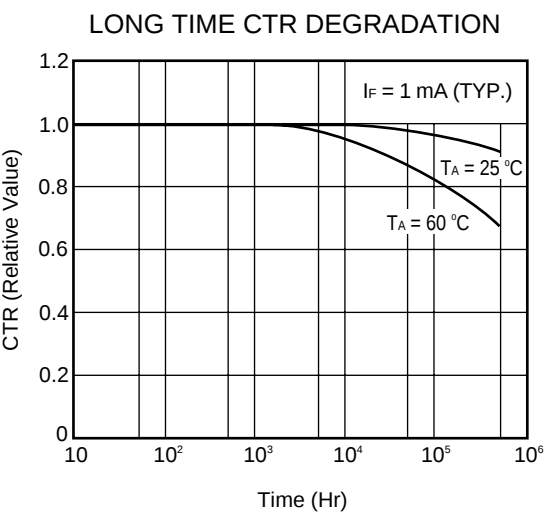
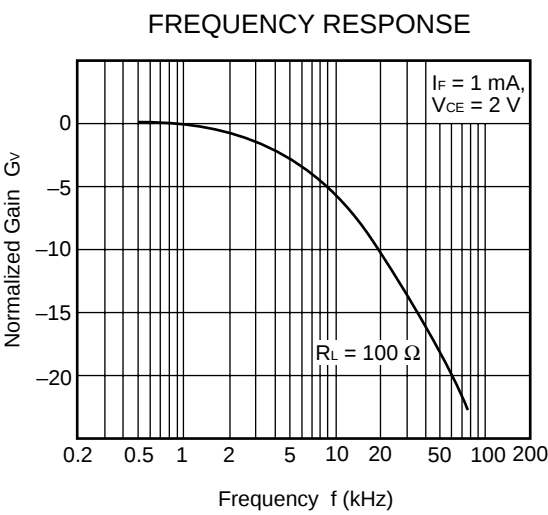


SWITCHING TIME vs.
LOAD RESISTANCE



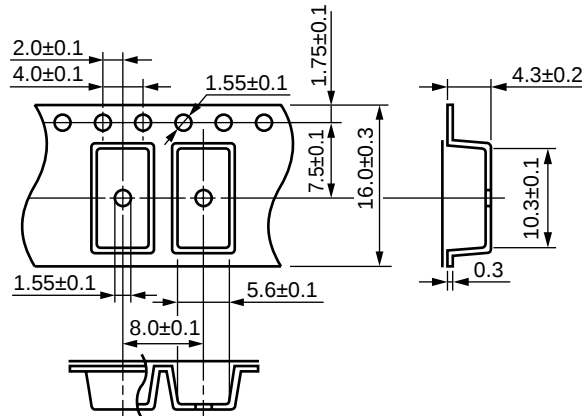
SWITCHING TIME vs.
LOAD RESISTANCE



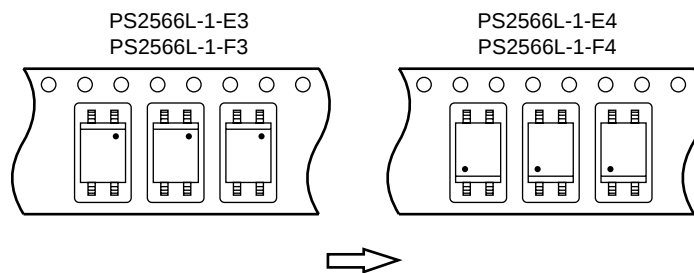

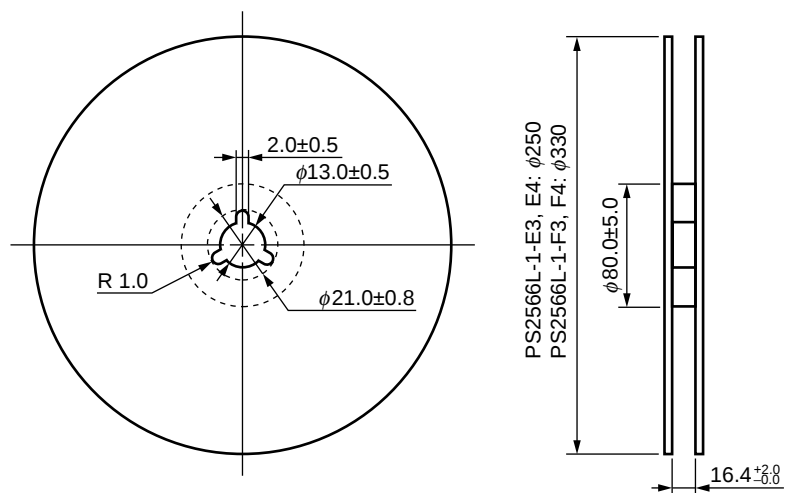

Taping Direction

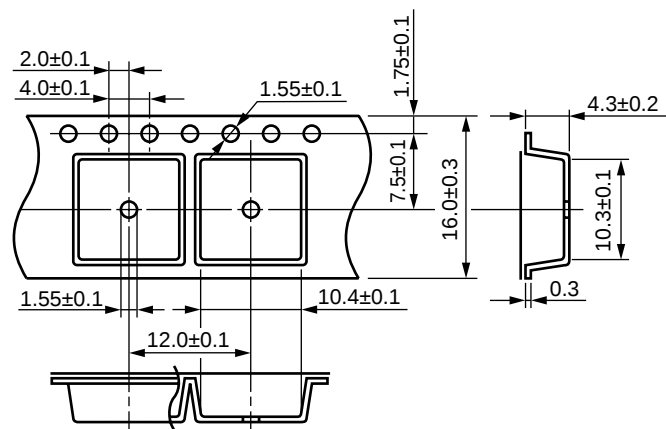

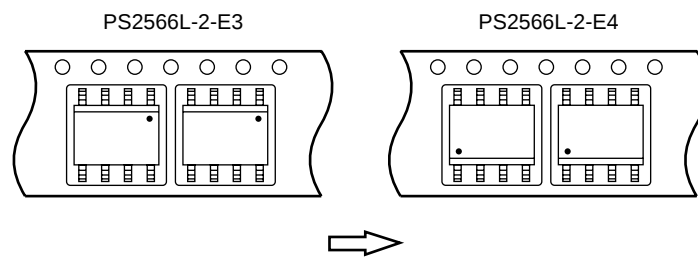

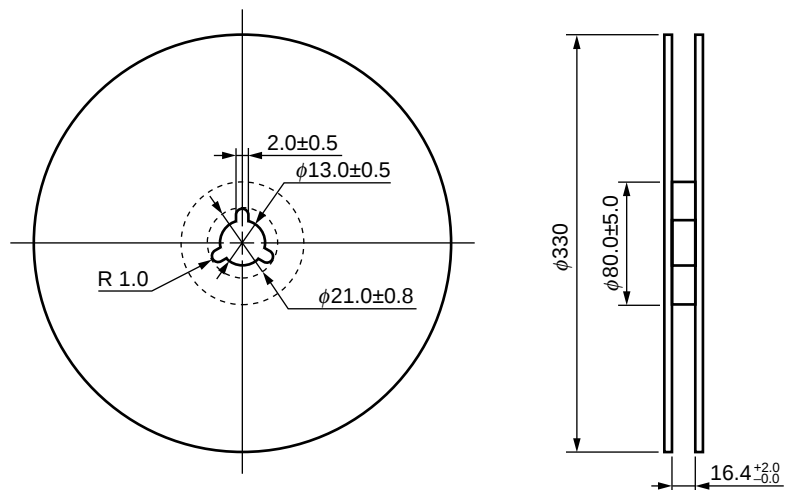

★ **RECOMMENDED SOLDERING CONDITIONS**

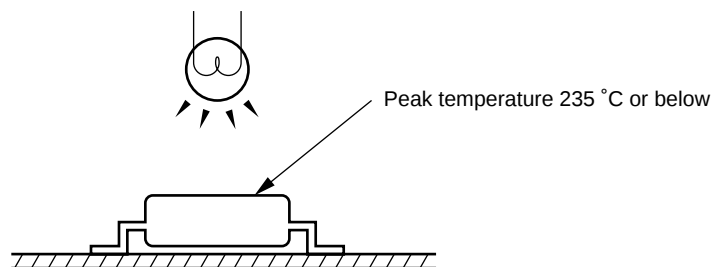
(1) Infrared reflow soldering

- Peak reflow temperature 235 °C (package surface temperature)
- Time of temperature higher than 210 °C 30 seconds or less
- Number of reflows Three
- Flux Rosin flux containing small amount of chlorine (The flux with a maximum chlorine content of 0.2 Wt % is recommended.)

Recommended Temperature Profile of Infrared Reflow



Caution Please avoid to removed the residual flux by water after the first reflow processes.



(2) Dip soldering

- Temperature 260 °C or below (molten solder temperature)
- Time 10 seconds or less
- Number of times One
- Flux Rosin flux containing small amount of chlorine (The flux with a maximum chlorine content of 0.2 Wt % is recommended.)
