TRANSPORT OF UXL or NP BATTERIES BY ROAD or SEAFREIGHT IN ACCORDANCE WITH IMDG CODE

UXL and NP batteries are classified as:

"BATTERIES, WET, NON-SPILLABLE, electric storage, CLASS 8, UN No. 2800, Packaging group III, Stowage Category A, Special Provision A67"

Special provision A67 indicates that these batteries are capable of withstanding the vibration, attitude and pressure differential tests described in the IMDG Code without leakage of battery fluid. Relevant tests have been conducted and certificated by iltspur Packaging Limited under Ministry of Technology (D.G.I.O) Authority Ref No. 30260.

Nonspillable battery classification tests in accordance with ICAO Technical Instructions have also been successfully documented by both PIRA and other internationally recognised laboratories establishing that S67 applies to these batteries.

Copy certificates are generally considered as confidential between the test laboratory and their client and cannot therefore be circulated without express permission of the laboratory upon receipt of the appropriate fee, however it is usual practice for his statement to be considered as acceptable by all.
