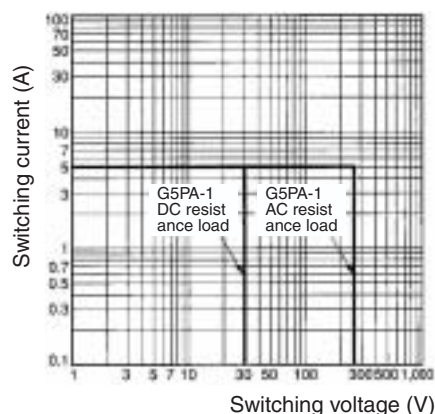

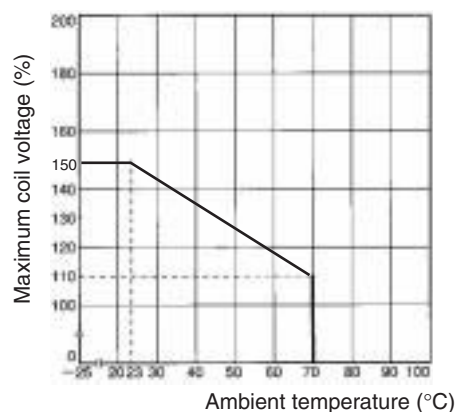

■ Maximum Switching Power



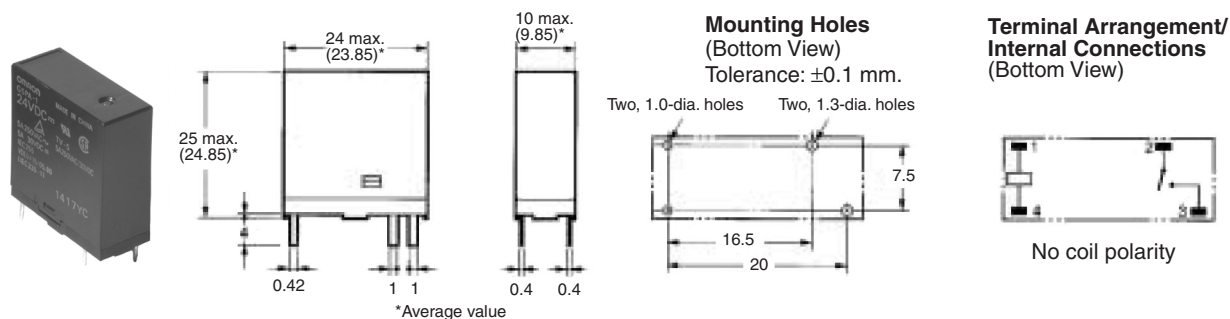
■ Ambient Temperatures vs. Maximum Coil Voltage
