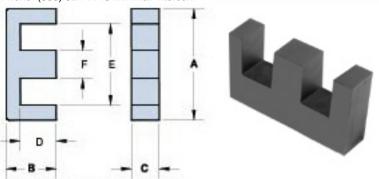

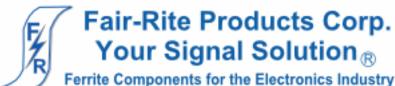

The column H(Oe) gives for each bead the calculated dc bias field in oersted for 1 turn and 1 ampere direct current. 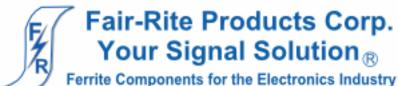

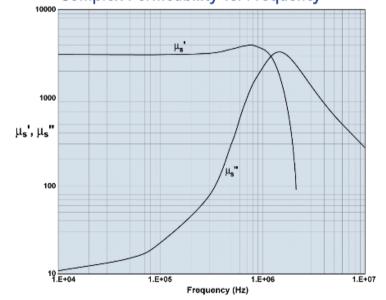

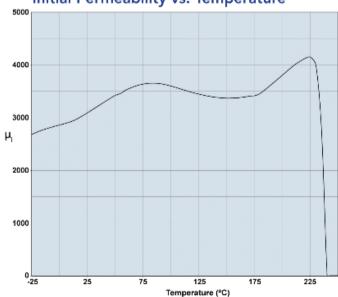

Complex Permeability vs. Frequency

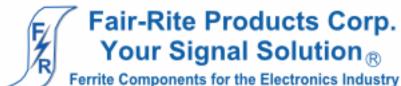

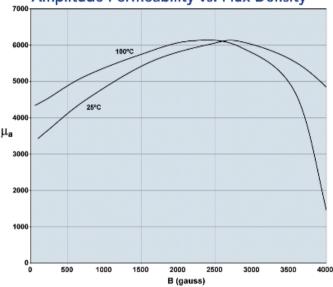




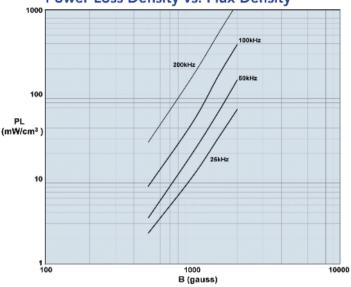


A low loss MnZn ferrite material for power applications up to 200kHz with low temperature variation.

Amplitude Permeability vs. Flux Density



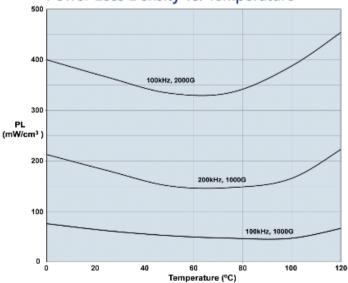
Power Loss Density vs. Flux Density



Measured on an 18/10/6mm toroid using the Clarke

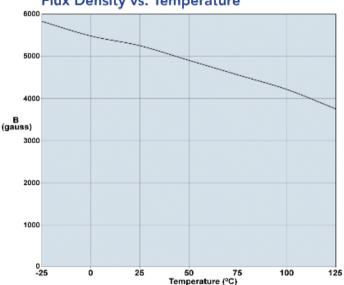
Measured on an 18/10/6mm toroid at 10kHz.
