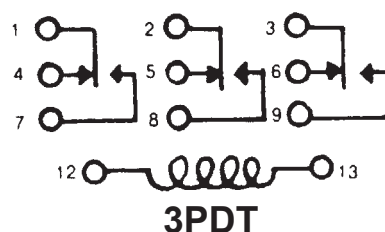

Wiring Diagrams



Double Pole - Double Throw Relays.
 Points 12 and 13 are for the power supply for the relay.
 When energized, the relay contacts move from points 4 to 7, and 6 to 9.



Triple Pole, Double Throw Relays.
 Points 12 and 13 are for the Power Supply for the relay.
 When energized, the relay contacts move from points 4 to 7, 5 to 8, and 6 to 9.

Guardian part numbers look like this:

1220 - 2C - 120A

The first number is the model number, the middle letter/number combination refers to Double Pole - Double Throw vs. Triple Pole - Double Throw, and the third number is the power supply required for the Relay.
