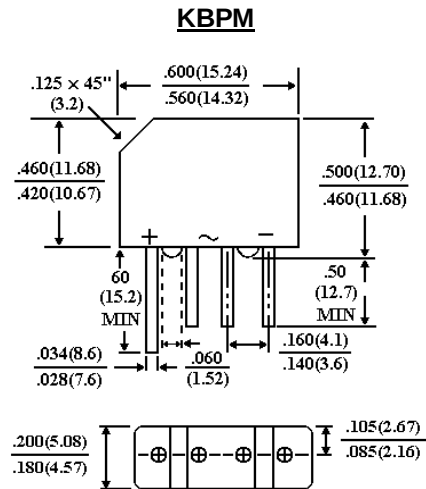

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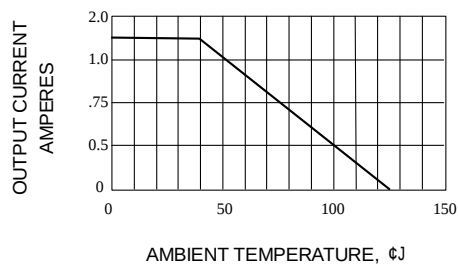


Fig. 1-OUTPUT CURRENT VS AMBIENT TEMPERATURE

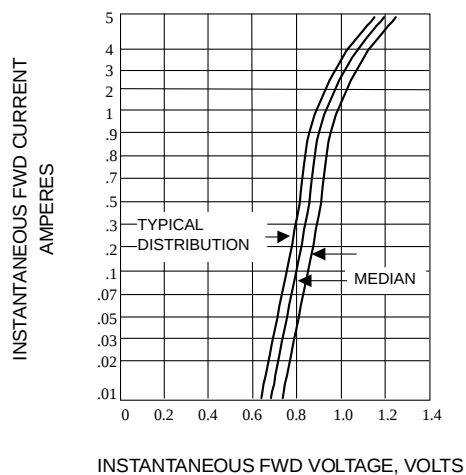


Fig. 2-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS(25 °C)

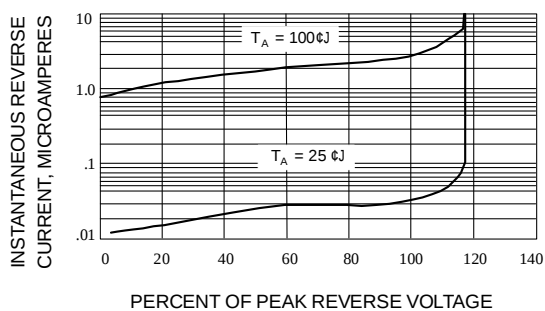


Fig. 3-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

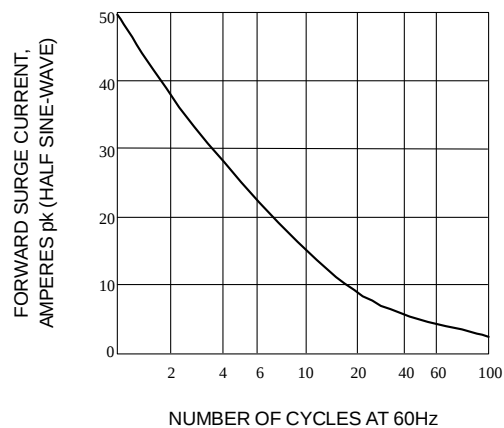


Fig. 4-NON-RECURRENT SURGE RATING
