## 1. General description

The 74HC244; 74HCT244 is an 8-bit buffer/line driver with 3-state outputs. The device can be used as two 4-bit buffers or one 8-bit buffer. The device features two output enables ( $1\text{OE}$  and  $2\text{OE}$ ), each controlling four of the 3-state outputs. A HIGH on  $n\text{OE}$  causes the outputs to assume a high-impedance OFF-state. Inputs include clamp diodes that enable the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of  $V_{CC}$ .

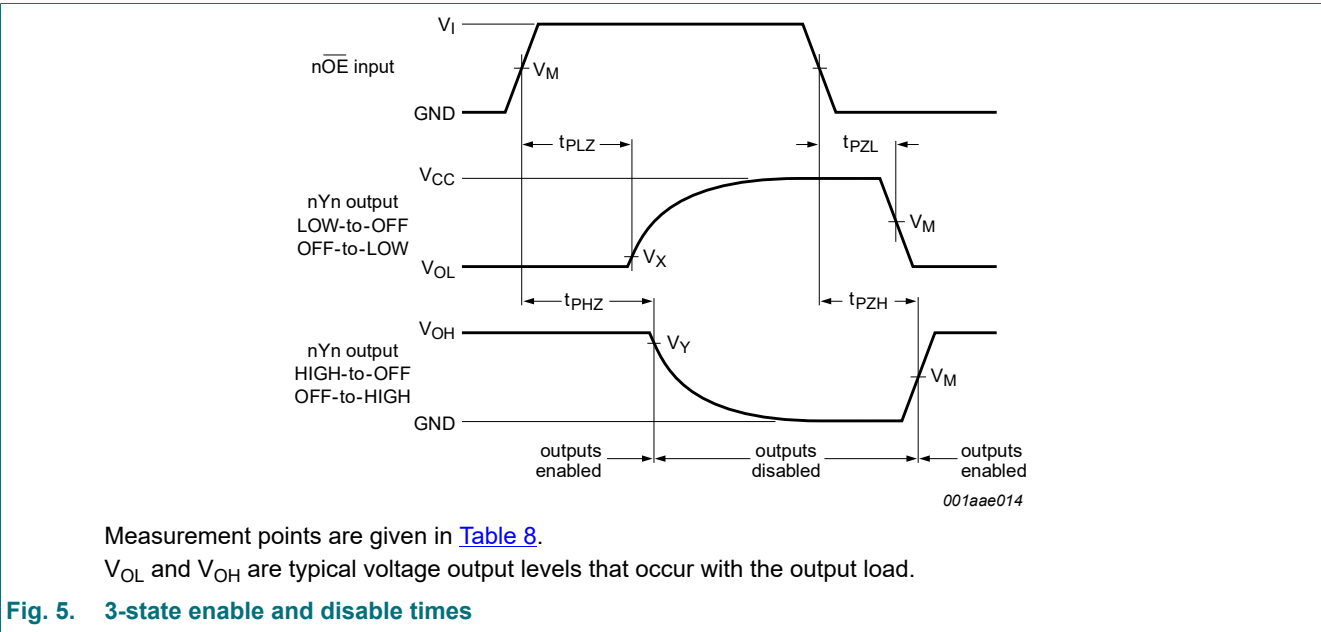
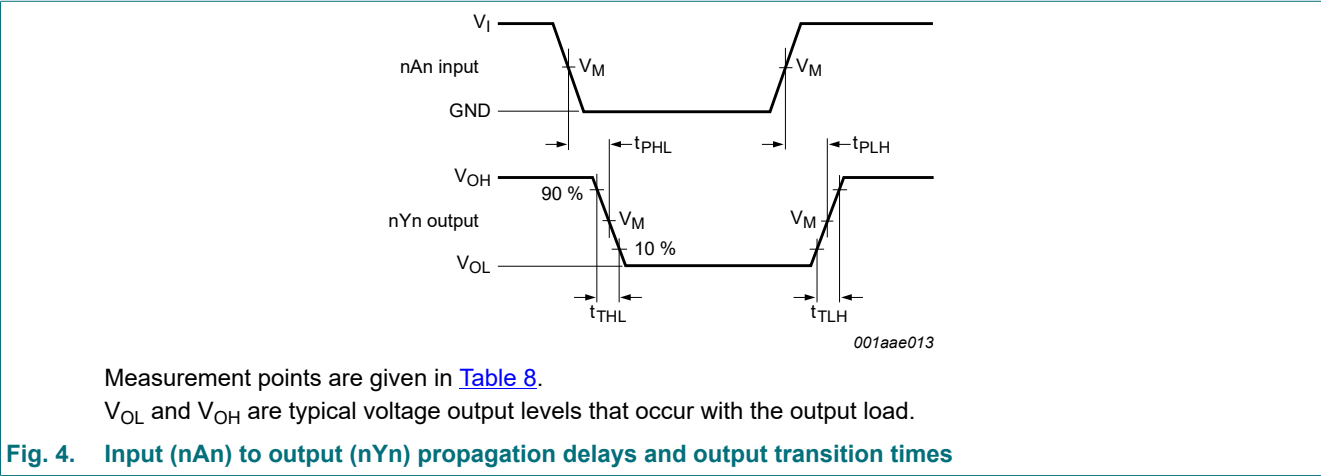

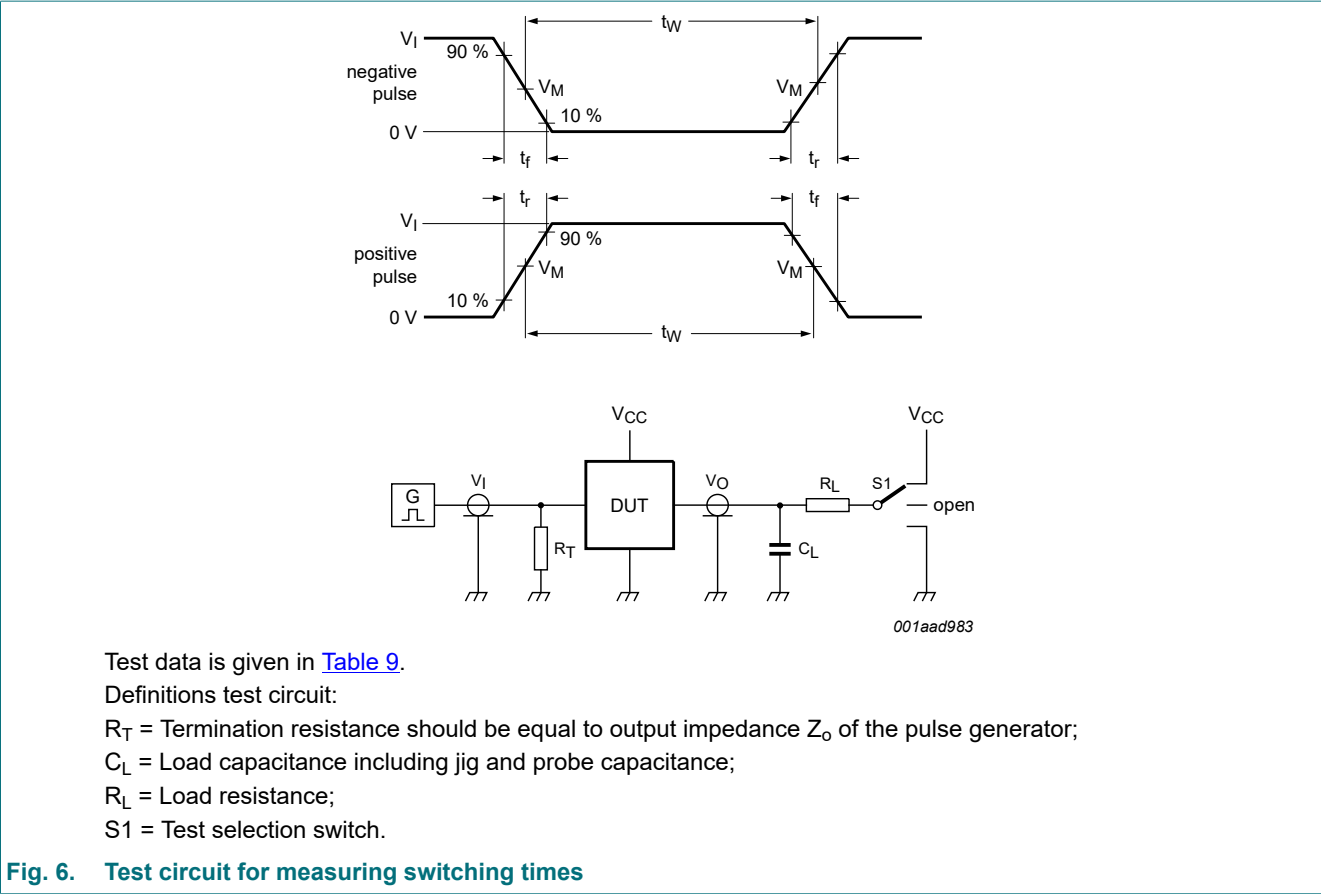

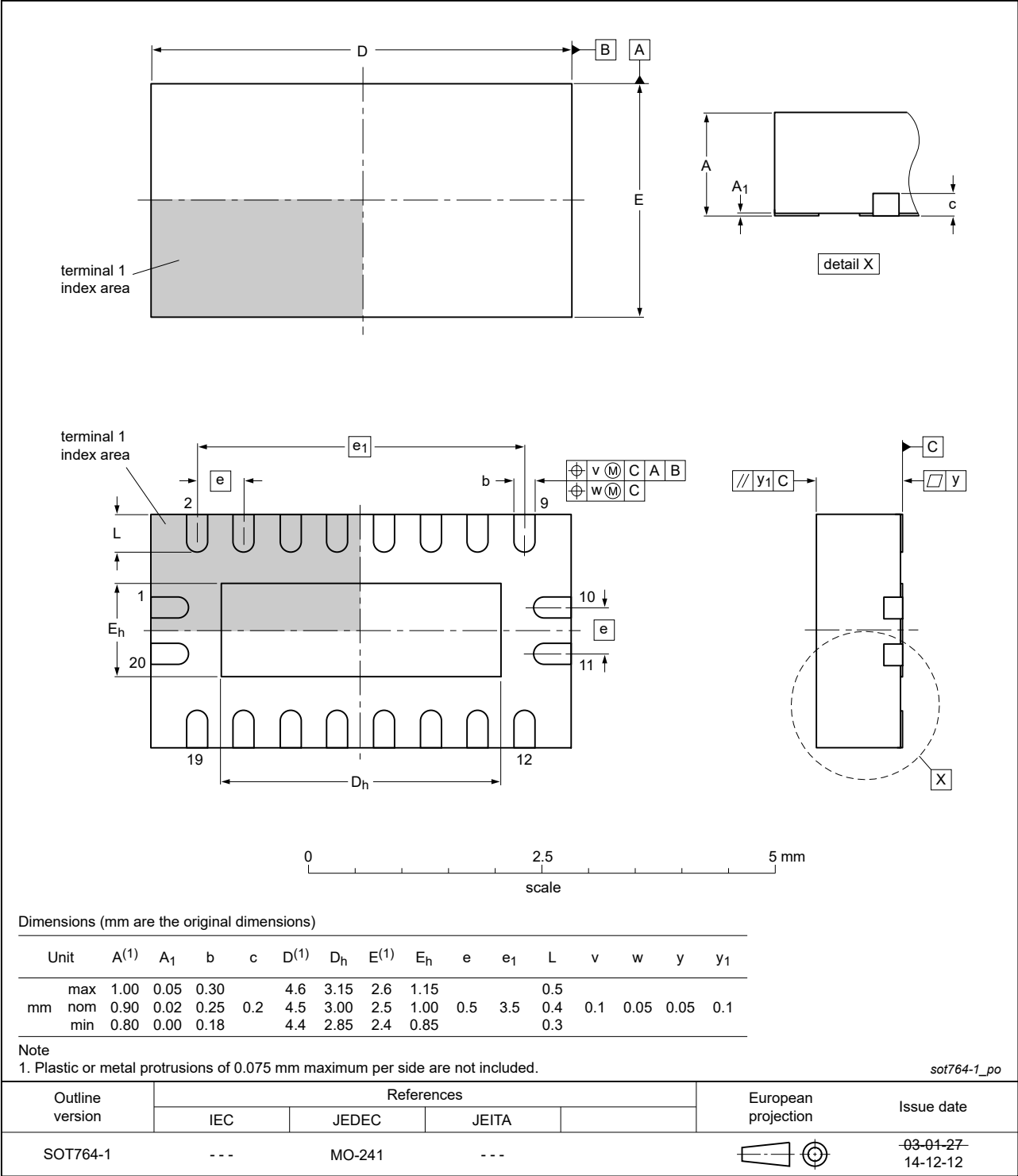


Fig. 9. Package outline SOT764-1 (DHVQFN20)
