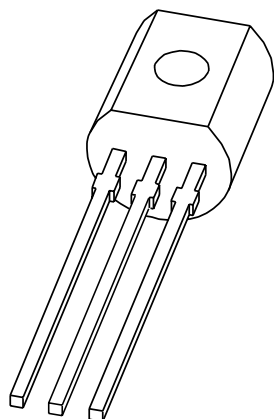

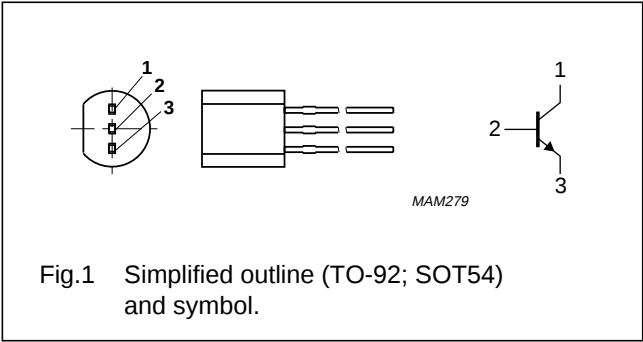

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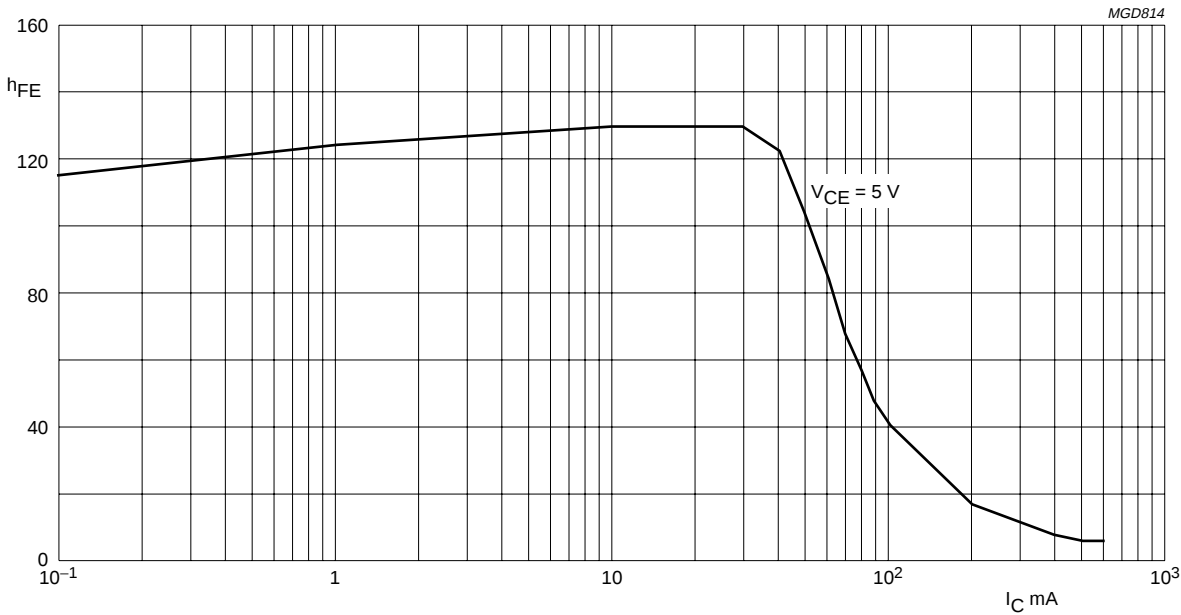


Fig.2 DC current gain; typical values.

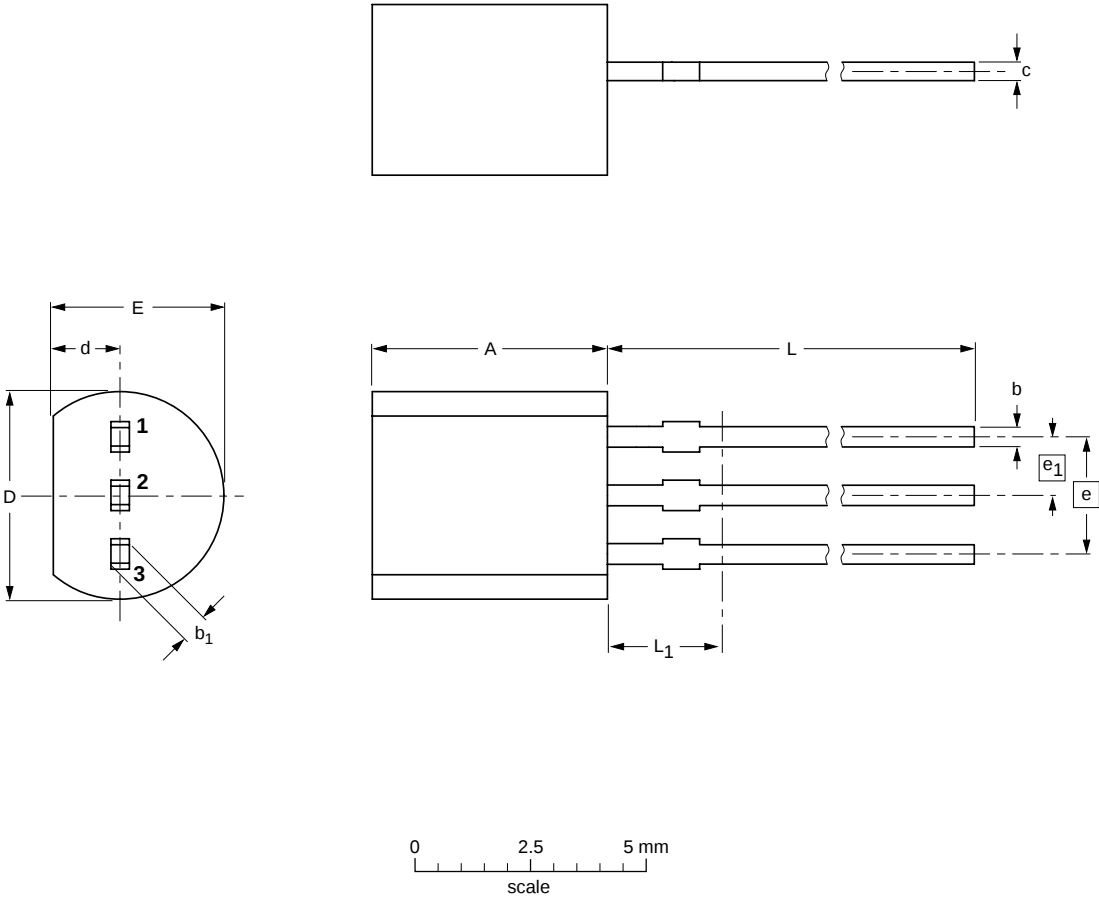
