Wire connection with CAGE CLAMP®S



Actuate the clamp using a screwdriver (blade width 2.5 mm/0.098 in) to connect flexible conductors and insert the stripped conductor up to the stop. Solid conductors can be plugged directly.

Preparation



We recommend to pull the pre-latched strain relief housing over the conductor prior to conductor connection. However, the strain relief can be mounted at a later time as well.



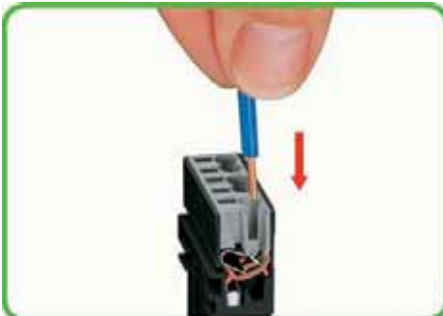
1. Strip length, outer insulation = 55 mm / 2.16 in

Open clamping point with screwdriver (blade width 2.5mm/0.098 in) and insert stripped conductor up to the stop.

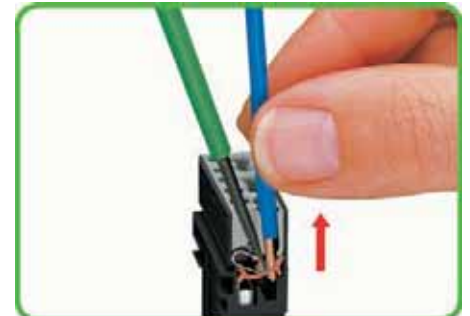

Simply break or cut off the coding pin on the socket.



Fit the coding pin into the connector (break first) so that the pin engages.

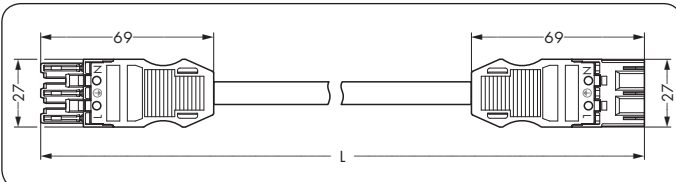
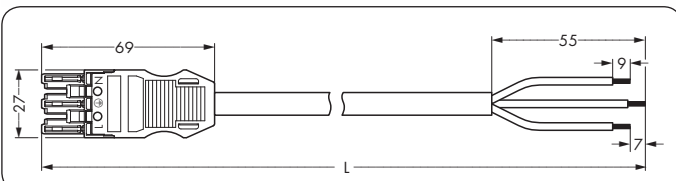
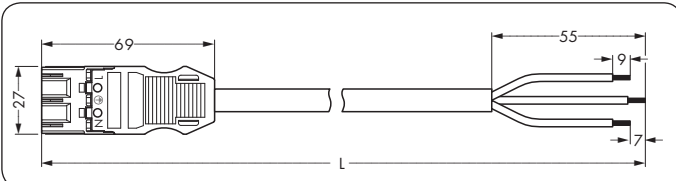
Internal circuit of the 770-638 distribution connector for single-pole switch or two-way circuits.

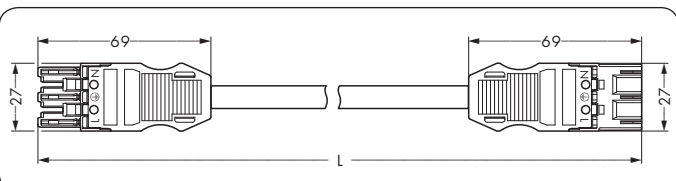
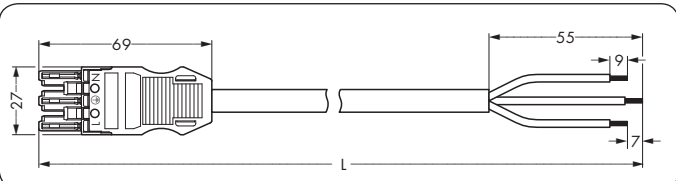


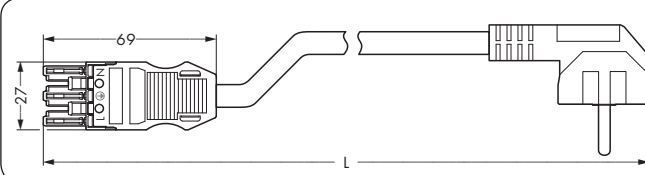

Question 1:

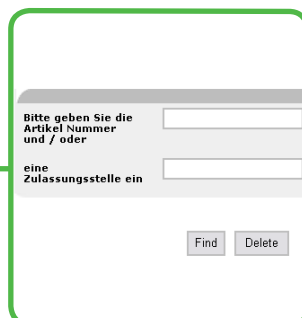
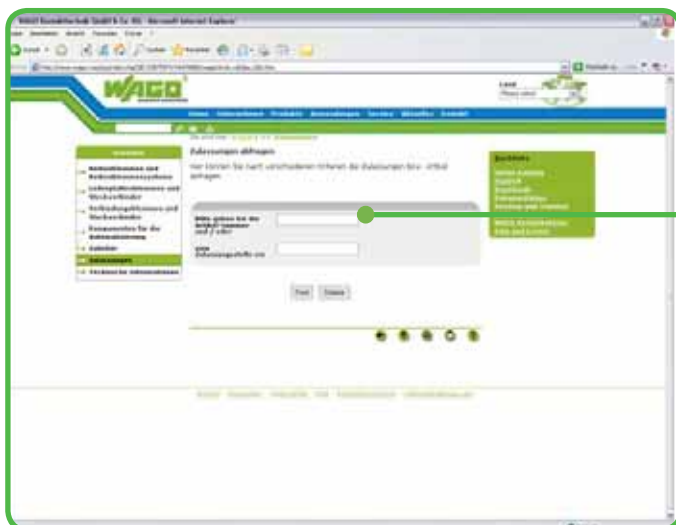

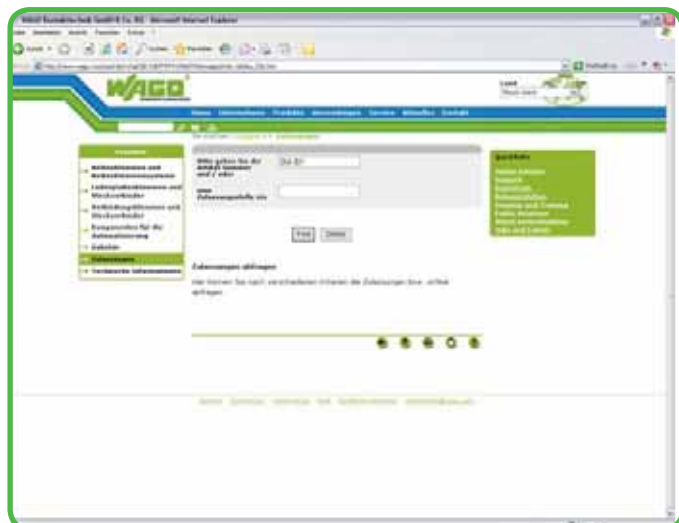
