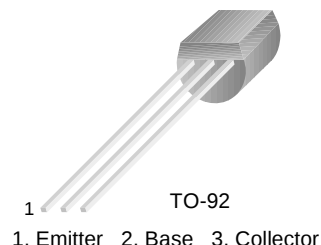

- Collector Power Dissipation : $P_C=500\text{mW}$
- Suffix "-C" means Center Collector (1. Emitter 2. Collector 3. Base)

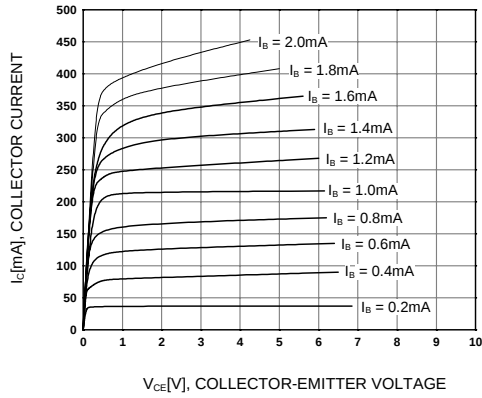


Figure 1. Static Characteristic

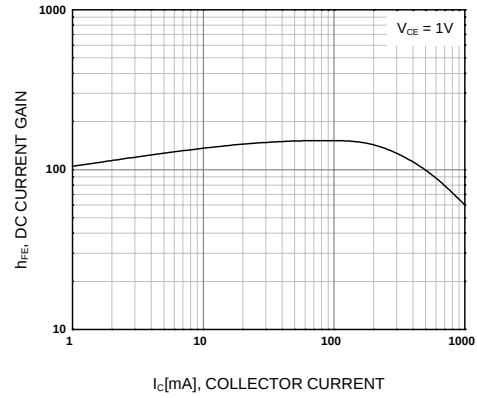


Figure 2. DC current Gain

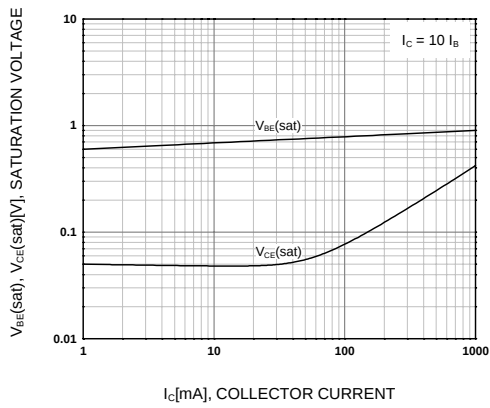


Figure 3. Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage
Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

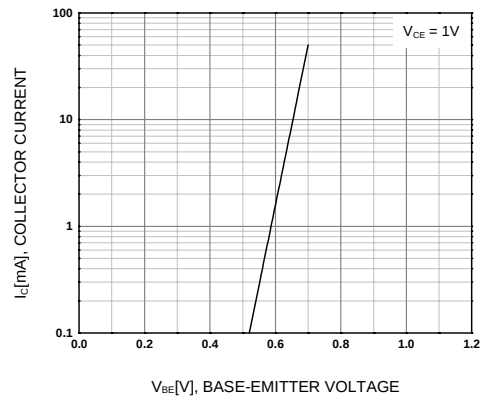


Figure 4. Base-Emitter On Voltage

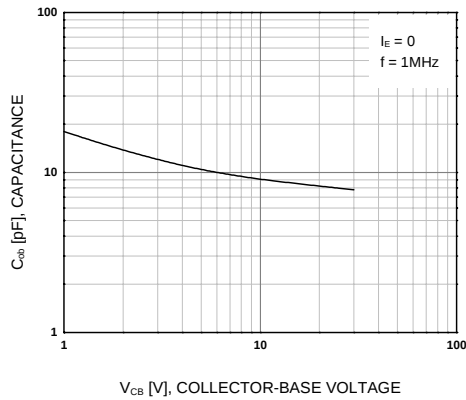
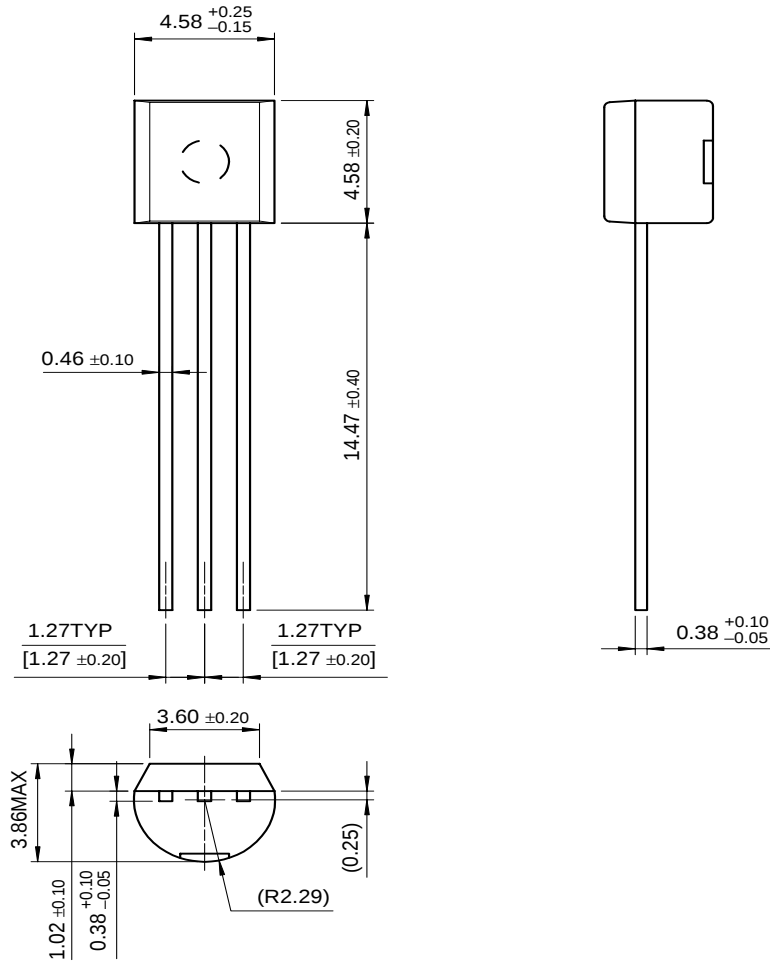


Figure 5. Collector Output Capacitance
