
●Application

●Features

- 1) A collector current is large.
- 2) $V_{CE(sat)} \leq -250\text{mV}$
At $I_C = -1.5\text{A}$ / $I_B = -30\text{mA}$






Fig.1. DC current gain vs. collector current




Fig.2 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current




Fig.3 Base-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current




Fig.4 Grounded emitter propagation characteristics





Fig.5 Gain bandwidth product vs. emitter current
