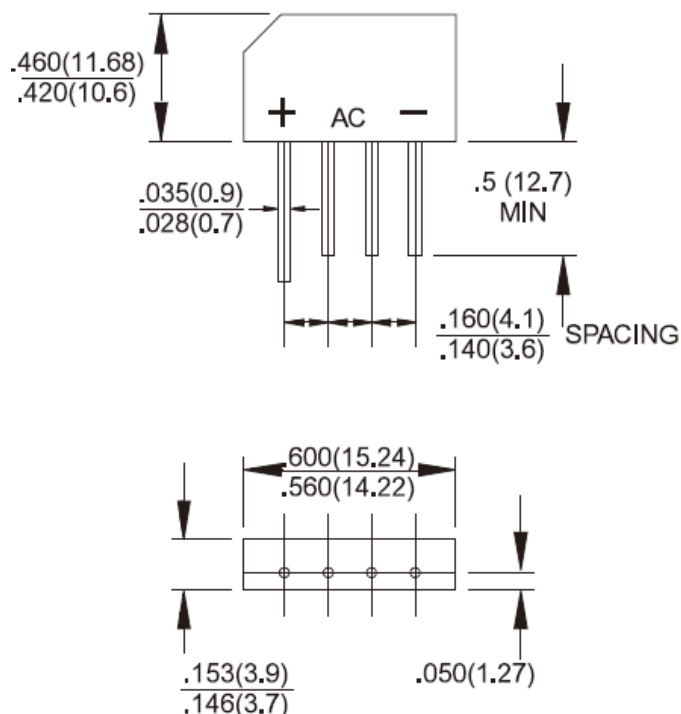

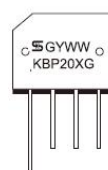

FIG. 1 FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

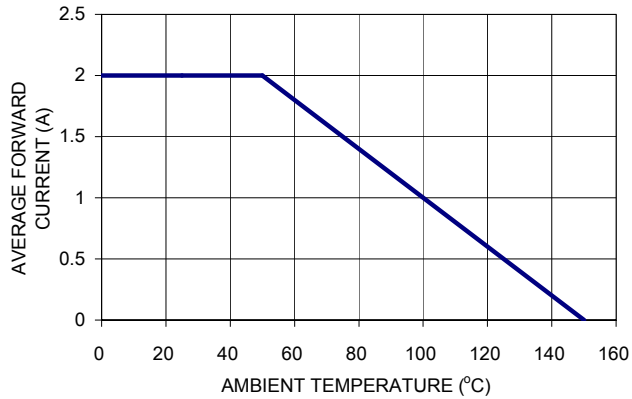


FIG. 2 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS PER BRIDGE ELEMENT

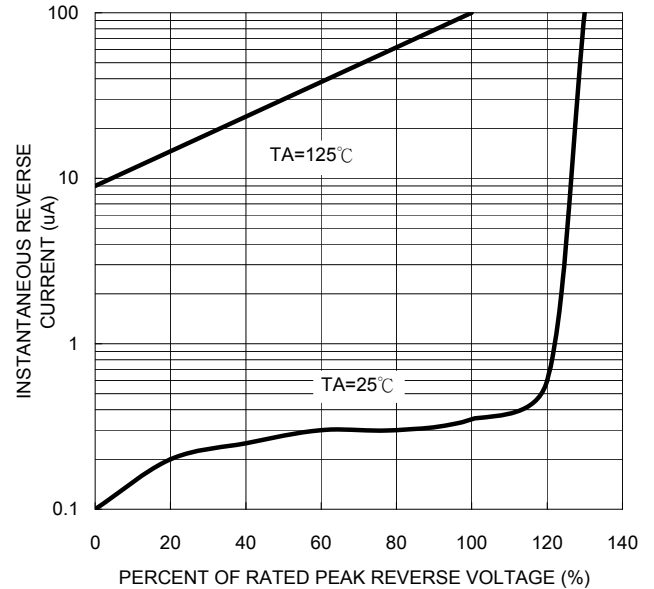


FIG. 3 MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER BRIDGE ELEMENT



FIG. 4 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

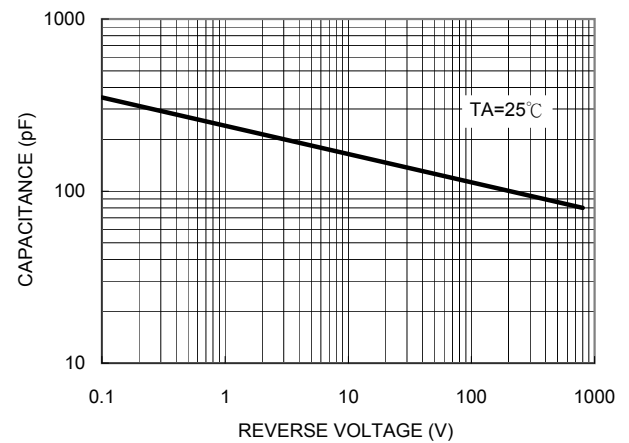


FIG. 5 TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS PER BRIDGE ELEMENT
