

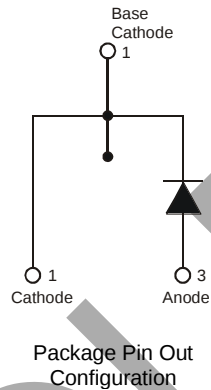

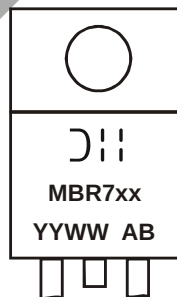

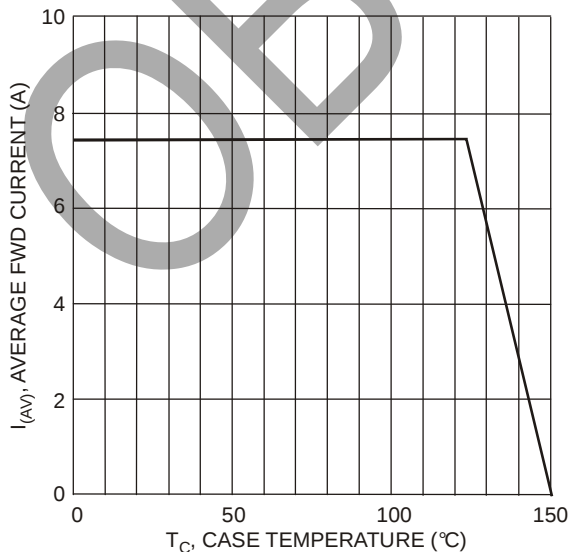


Fig. 1 Fwd Current Derating Curve

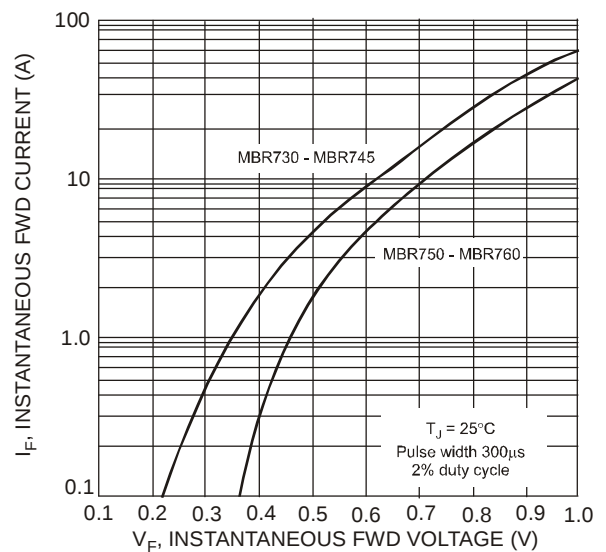


Fig. 2 Typ Instantaneous Fwd Characteristics

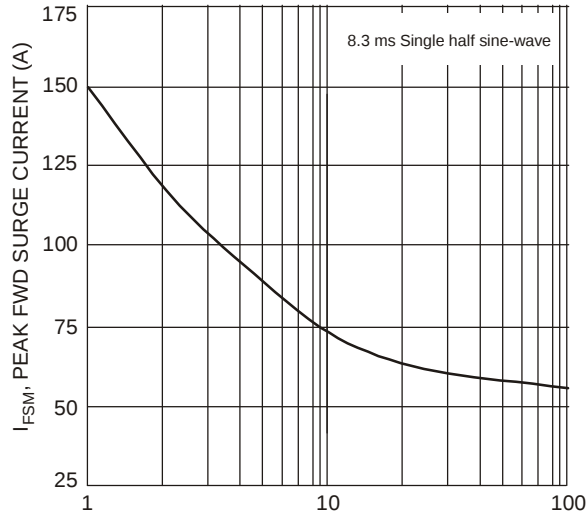


Fig. 3 Max Non-Repetitive Surge Current

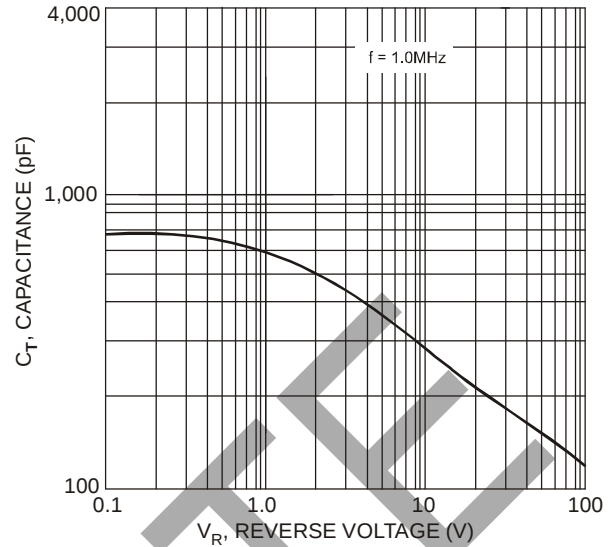


Fig. 4 Typical Total Capacitance

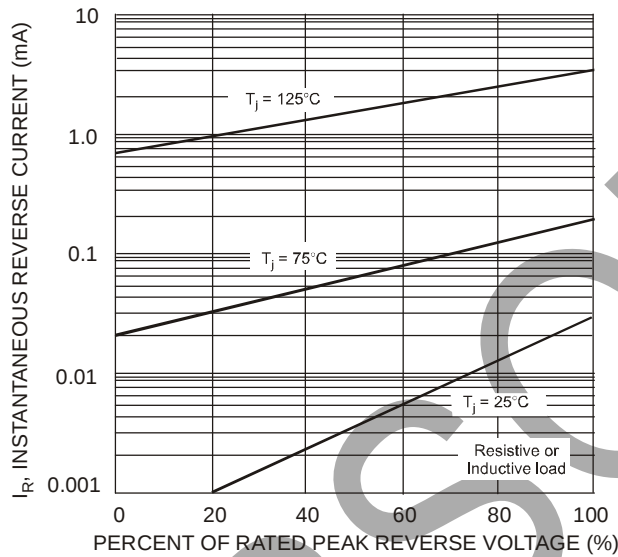
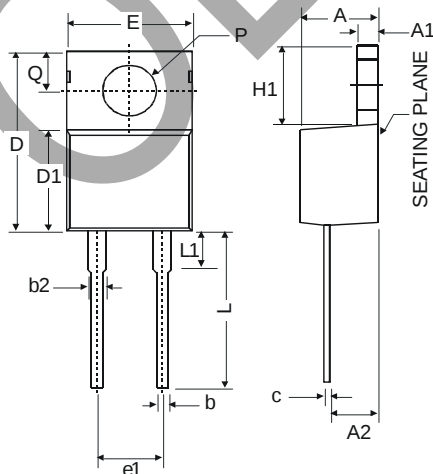


Fig. 5 Typical Reverse Characteristics
