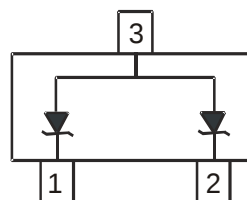

Top View

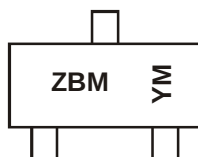


Device Schematic

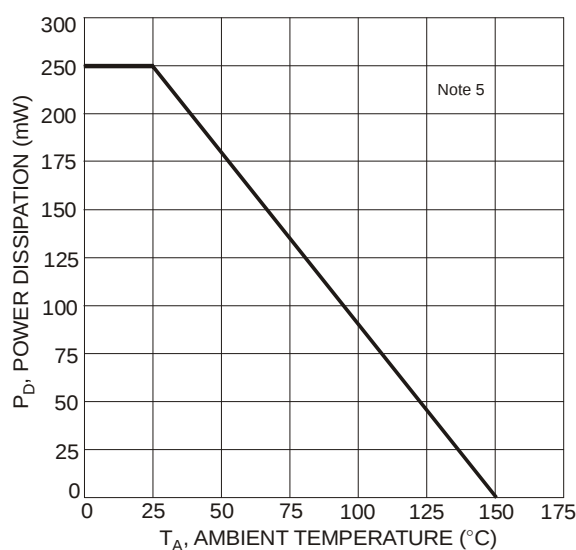


Figure 1 Power Derating Curve

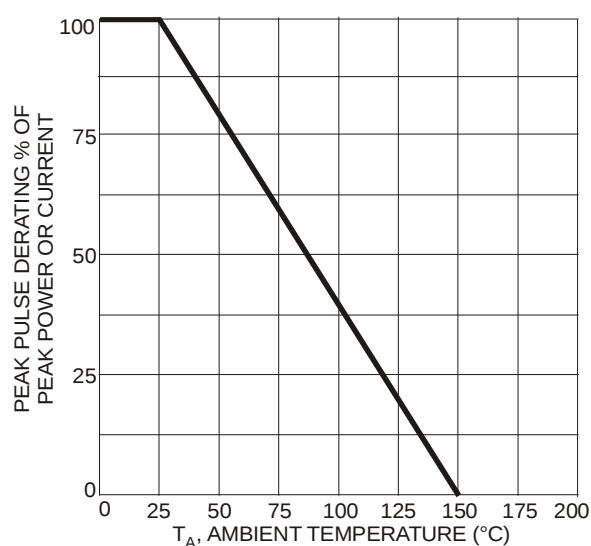
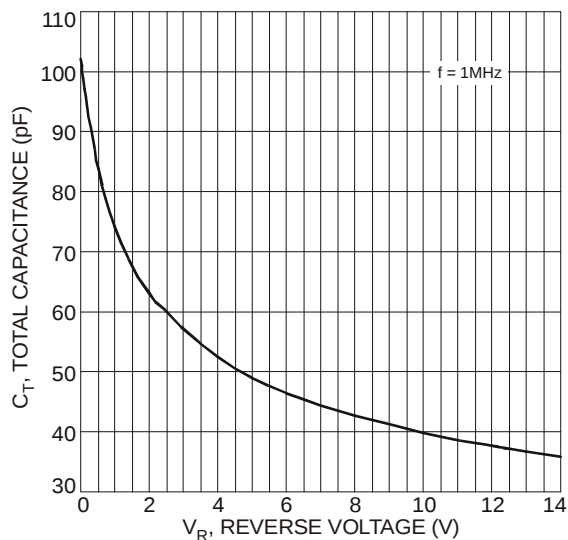
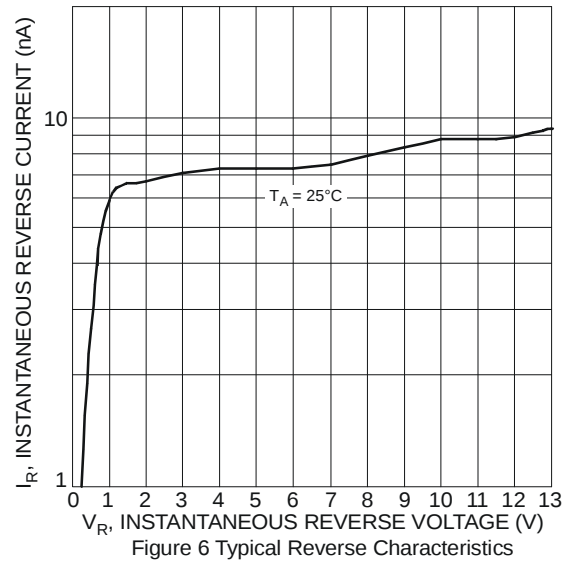
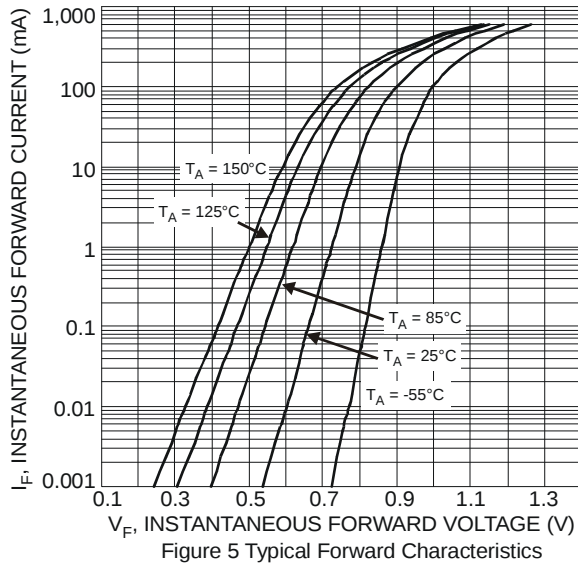
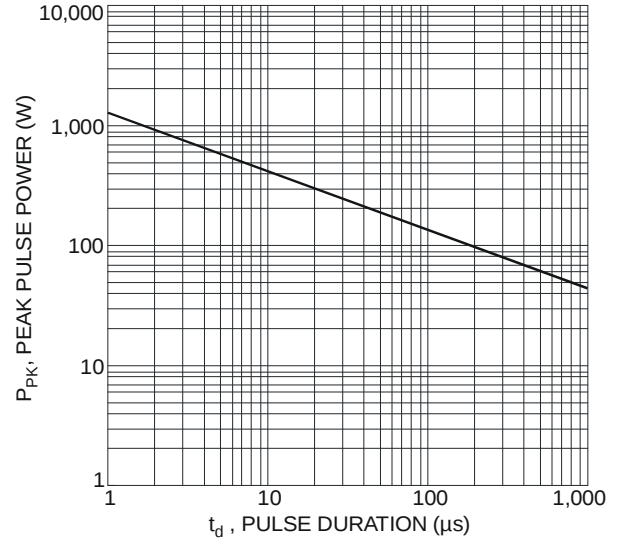
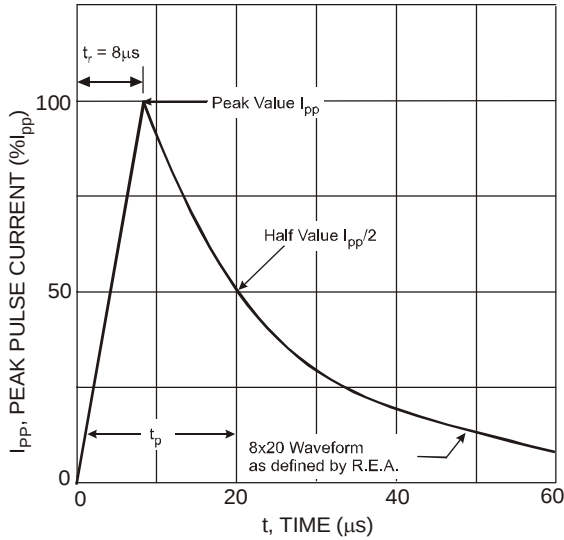
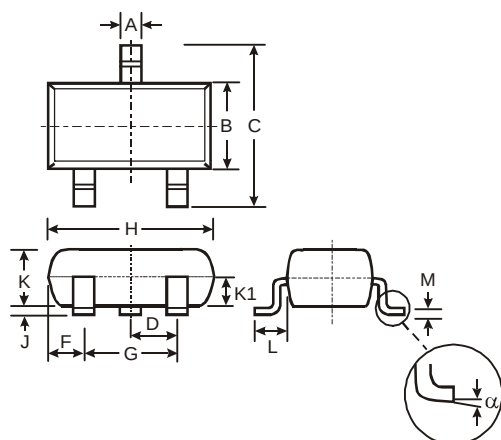


Figure 2 Power Dissipation vs. Ambient Temperature

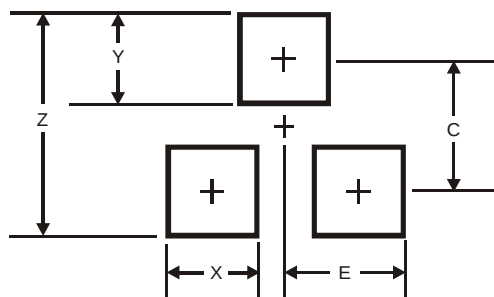
