


Typical phase noise plot for 5 oscillators at different output frequencies.




For Optimum Jitter Performance, Pletronics recommends:

- a ground plane under the device
- no large transient signals (both current and voltage) should be routed under the device
- do not layout near a large magnetic field such as a high frequency switching power supply
- do not place near piezoelectric buzzers or mechanical fans.


