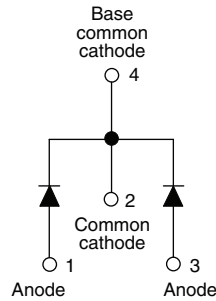

The VS-6CWQ03FNPbF surface mount, center tap, Schottky rectifier series has been designed for applications requiring low forward drop and small foot prints on PC board. 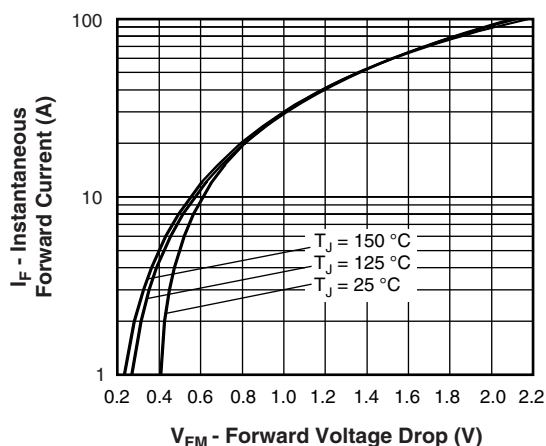


Fig. 1 - Maximum Forward Voltage Drop Characteristics (Per Leg)

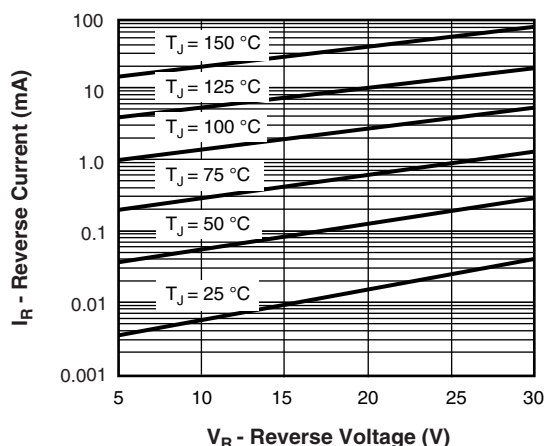


Fig. 2 - Typical Values of Reverse Current vs. Reverse Voltage (Per Leg)

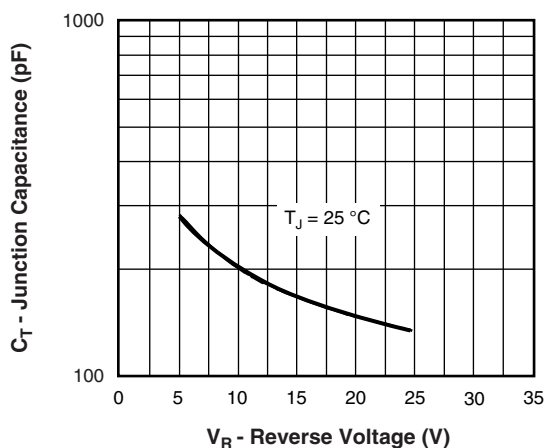
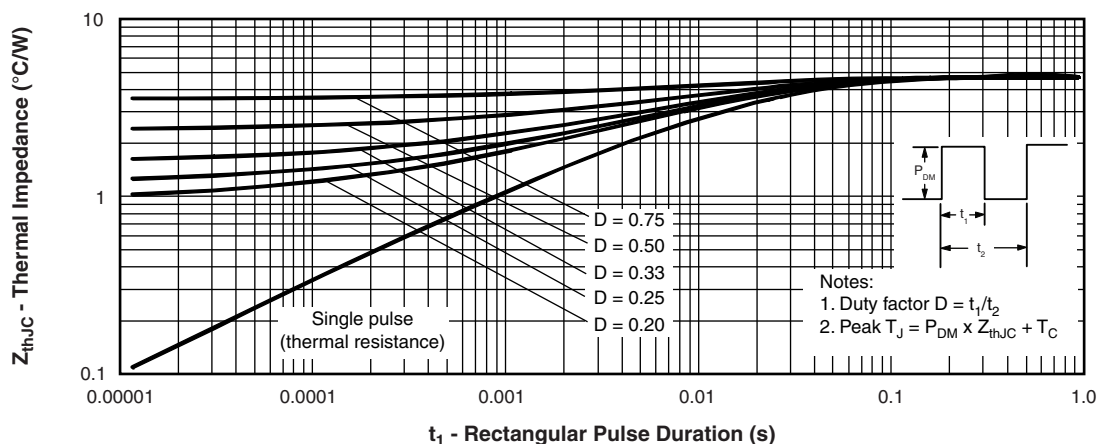


Fig. 3 - Typical Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage (Per Leg)


Fig. 4 - Maximum Thermal Impedance Z_{thJC} Characteristics (Per Leg)

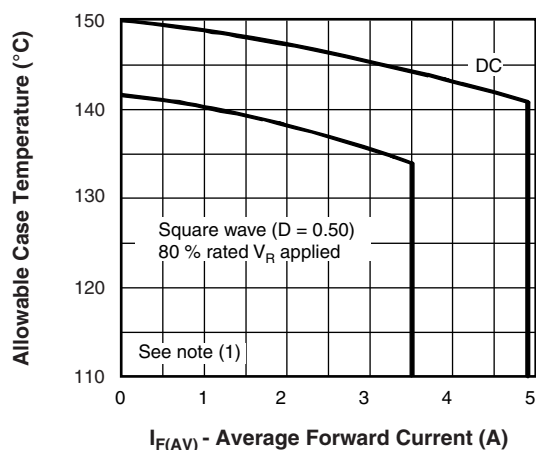


Fig. 5 - Maximum Allowable Case Temperature vs. Average Forward Current (Per Leg)

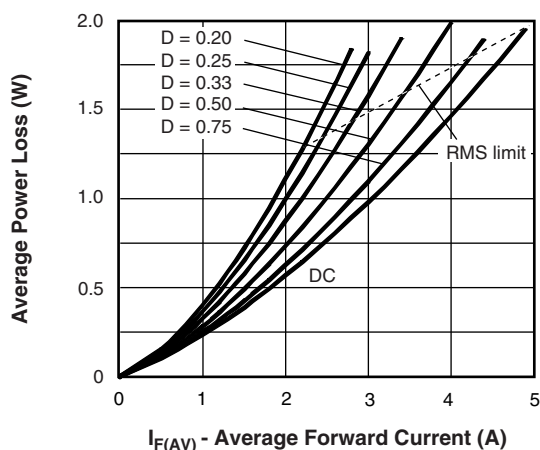


Fig. 6 - Forward Power Loss Characteristics (Per Leg)

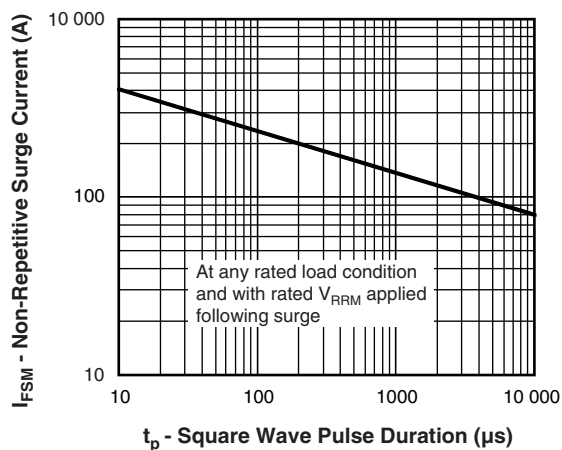


Fig. 7 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current (Per Leg)
