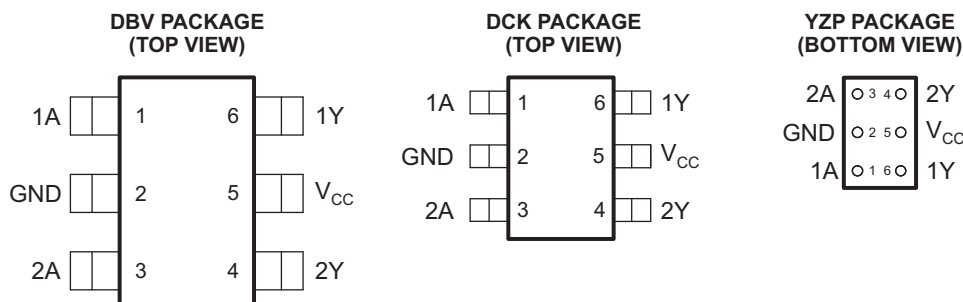

DESCRIPTION/ORDERING INFORMATION

This dual inverter is designed for 1.65-V to 5.5-V V_{CC} operation.

The SN74LVC2GU04 contains two inverters with unbuffered outputs and performs the Boolean function $Y = \bar{A}$.

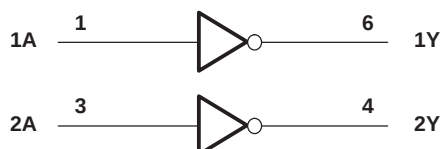

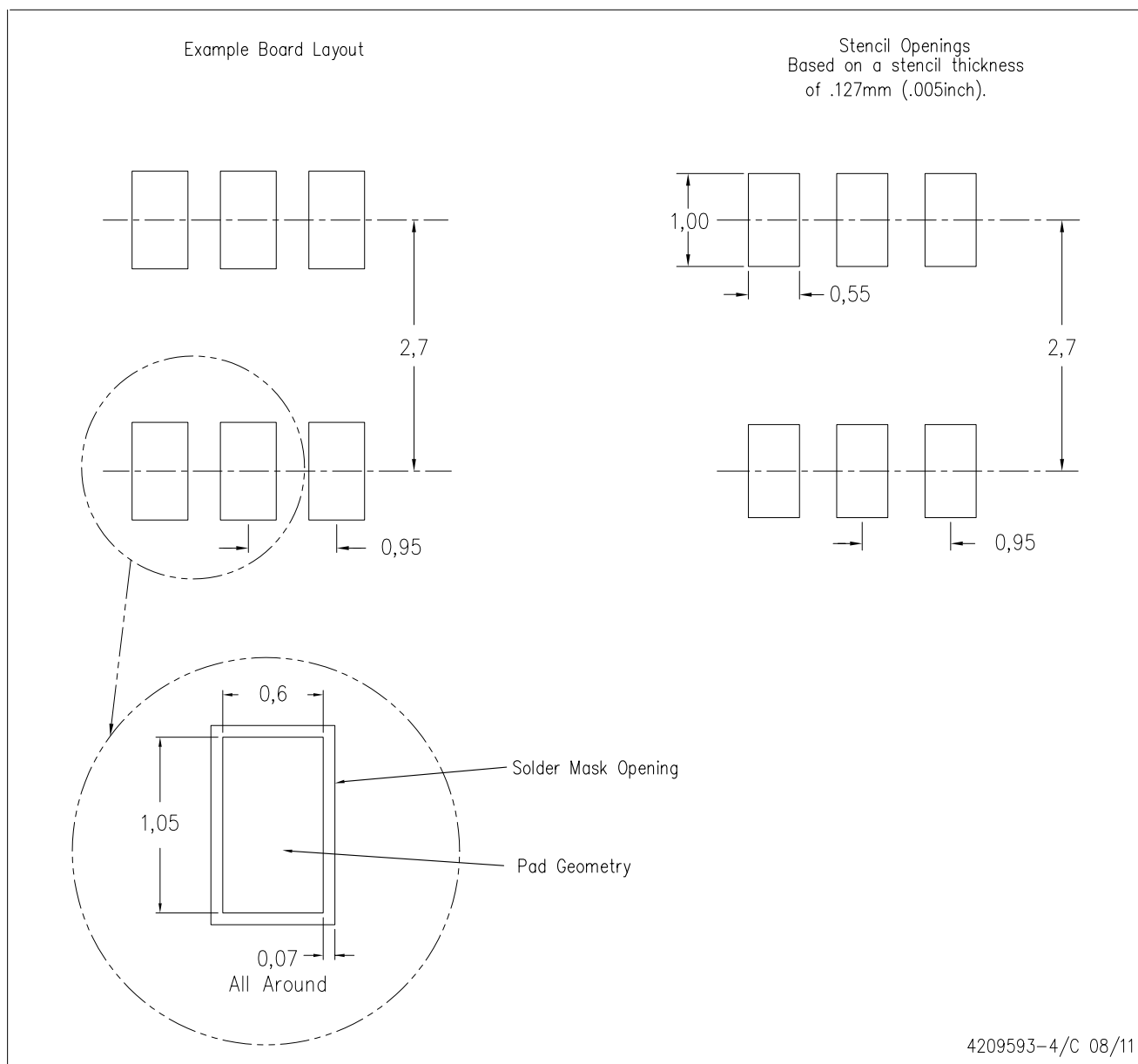
PLASTIC SMALL-OUTLINE PACKAGE



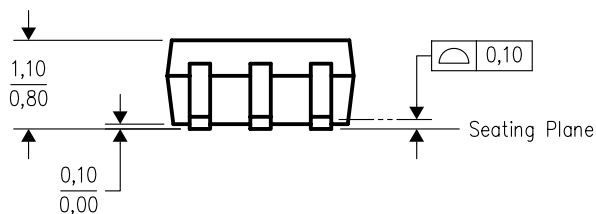

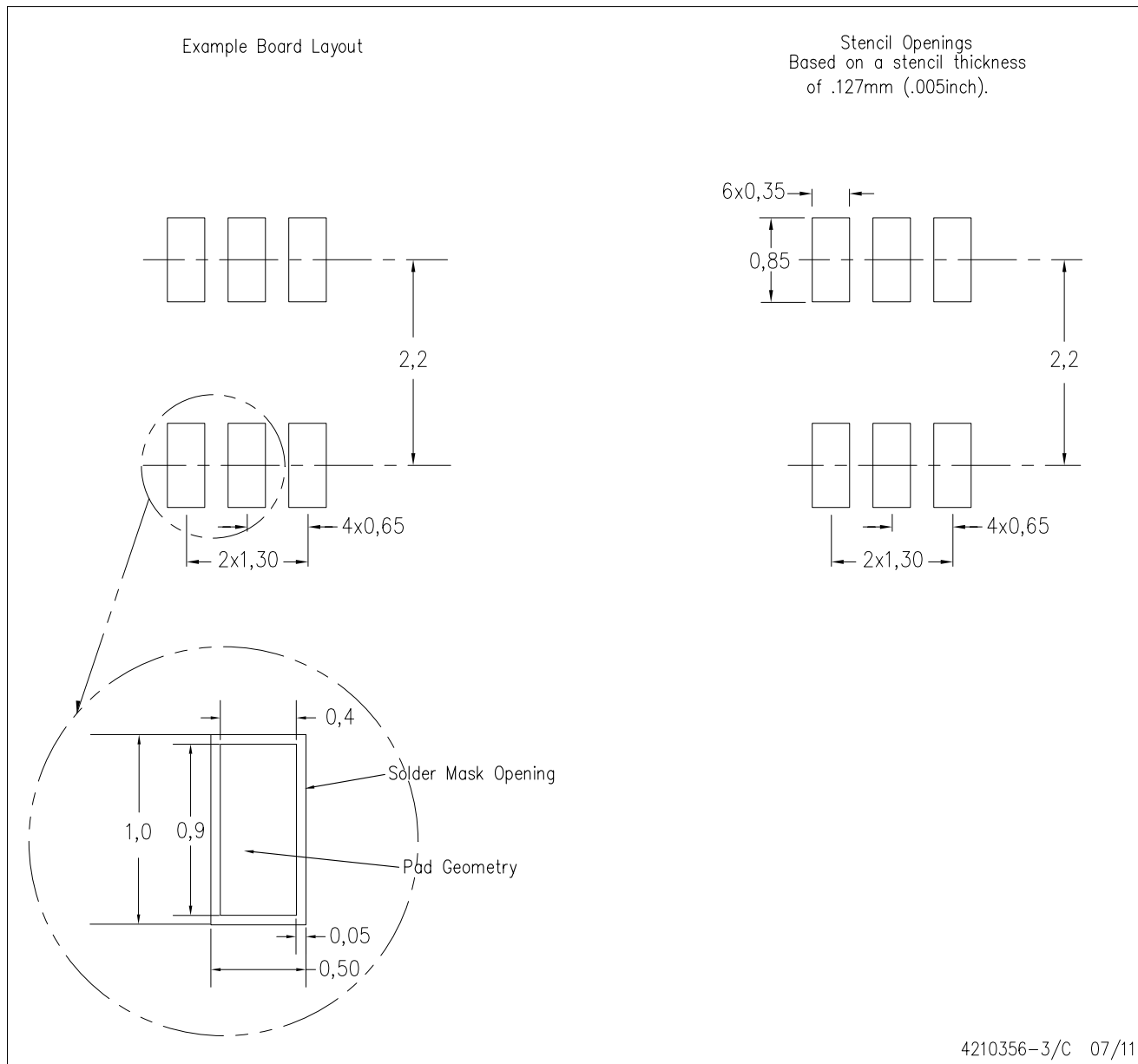

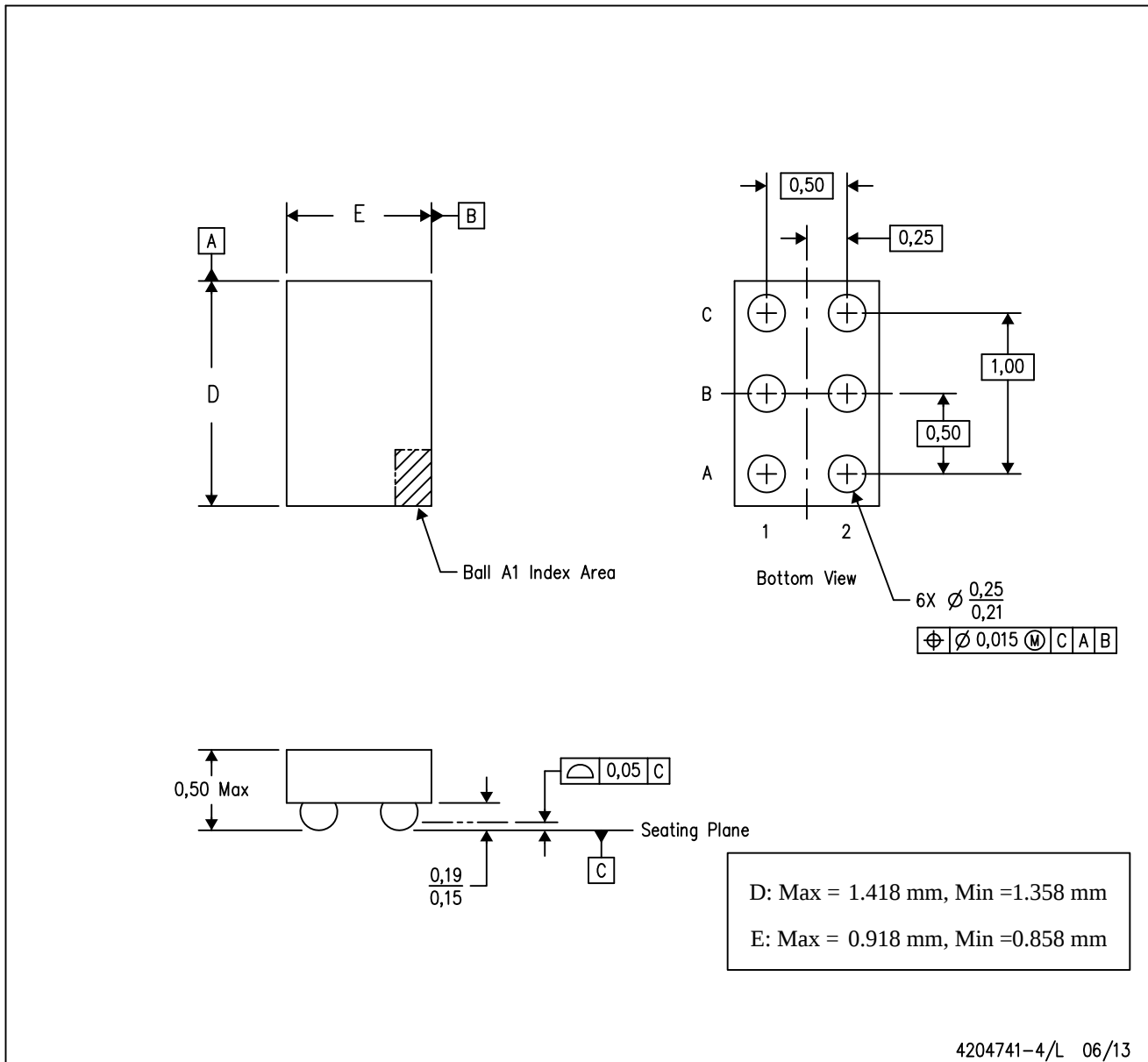
