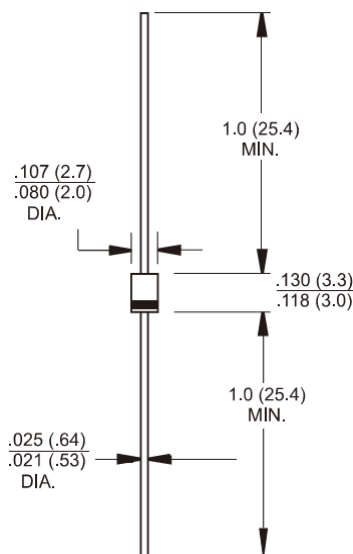

FIG.1 MAXIMUM FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

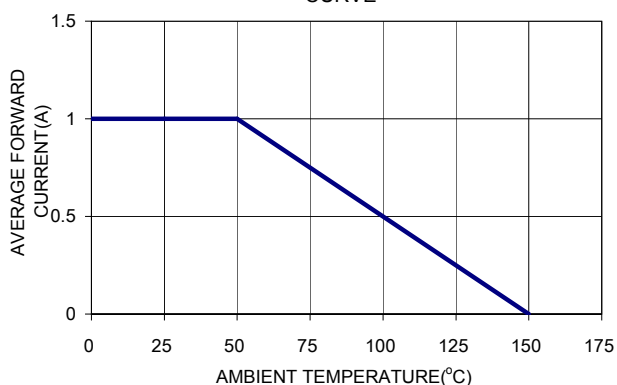


FIG. 2 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS

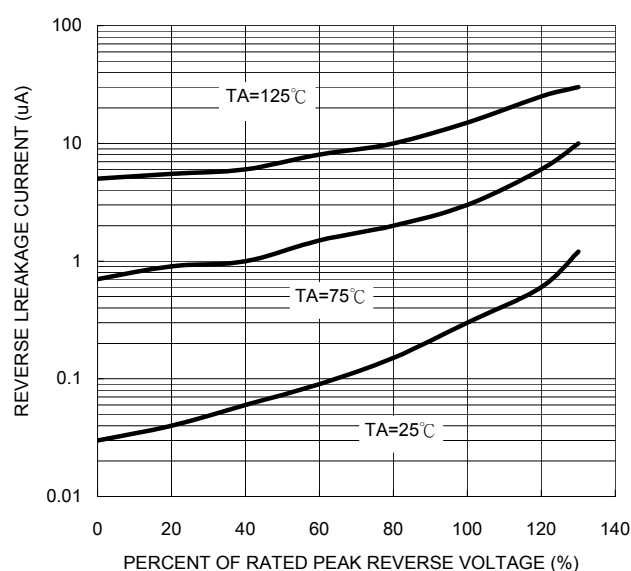


FIG. 3 MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

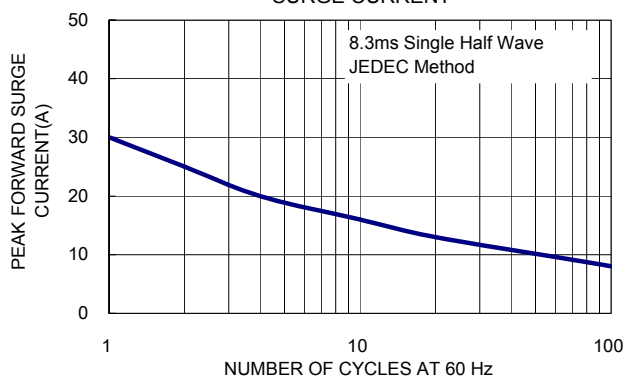


FIG. 4 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

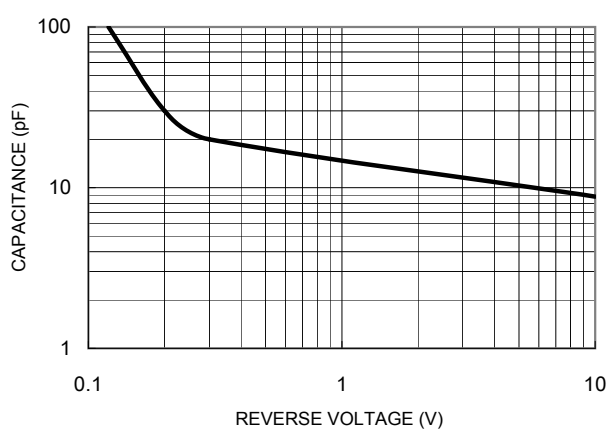


FIG. 5 TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS
