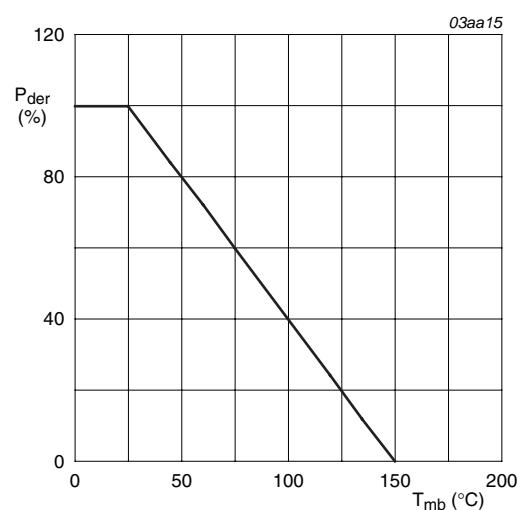

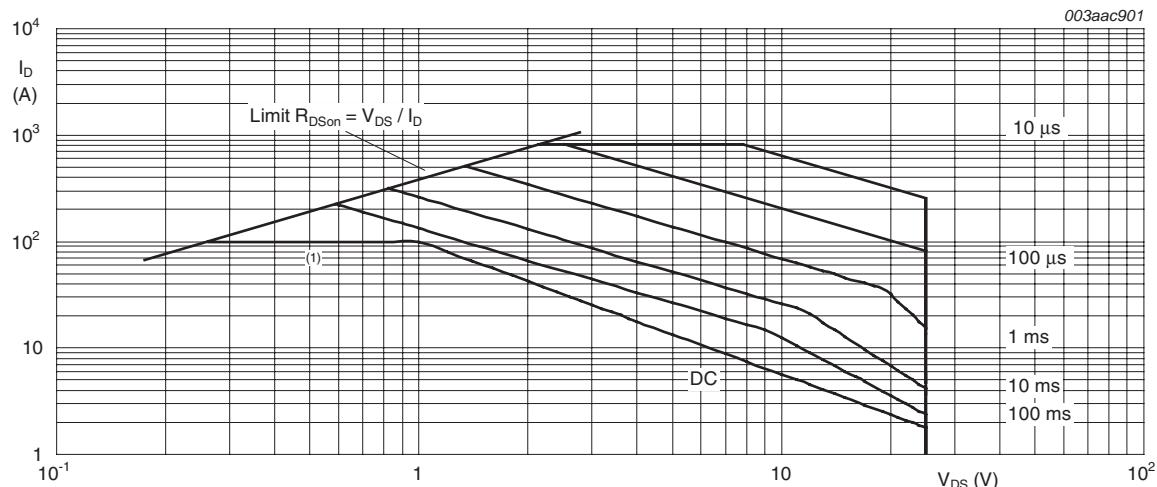

**Fig 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature**



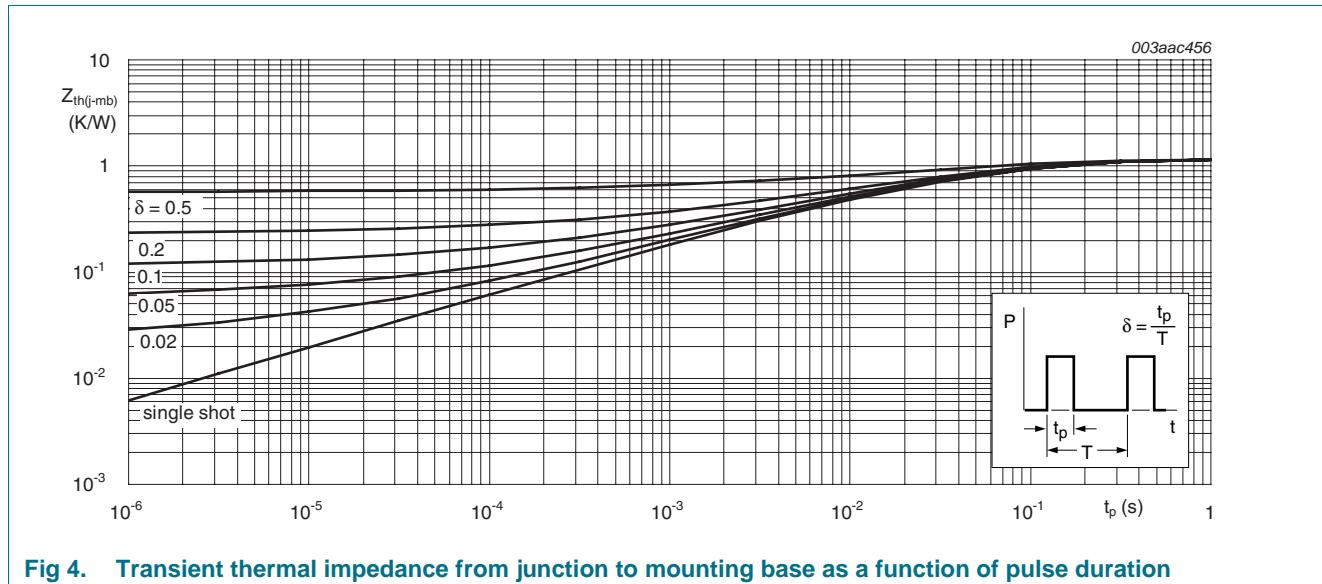

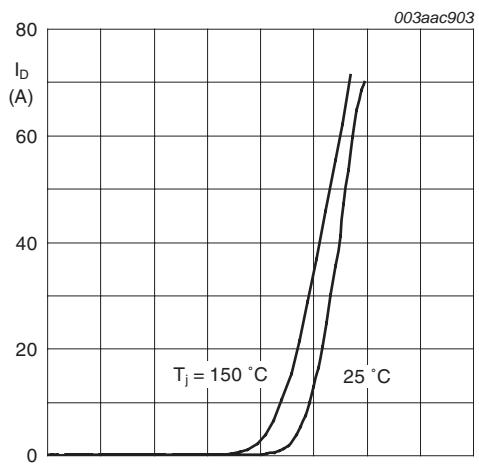

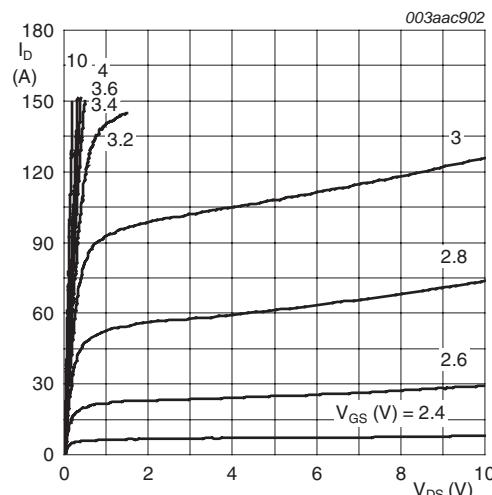

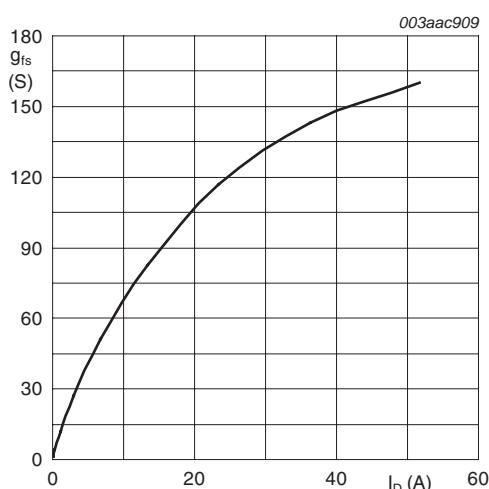

Fig 5. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values



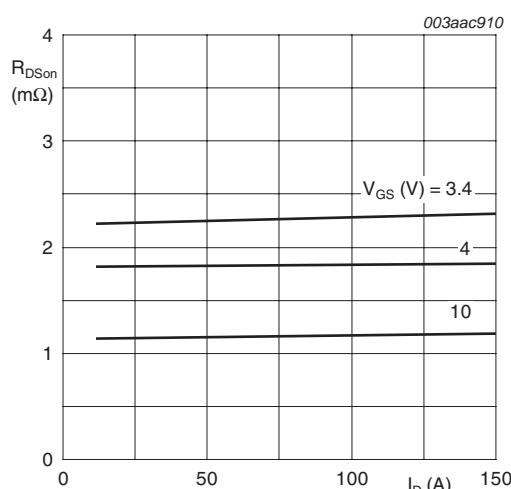

Fig 6. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



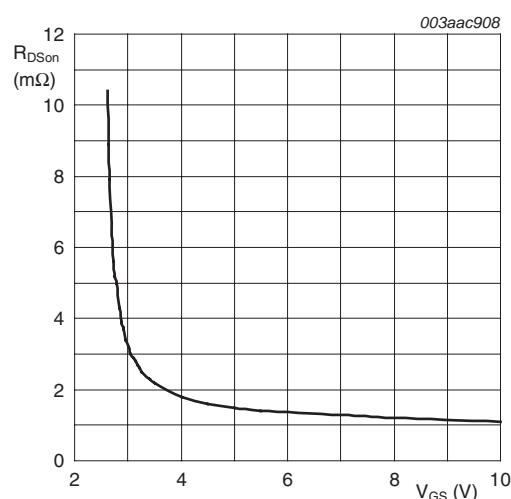

Fig 7. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values



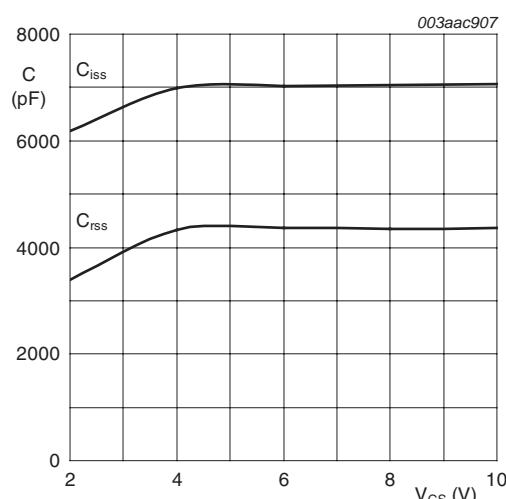

Fig 8. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values



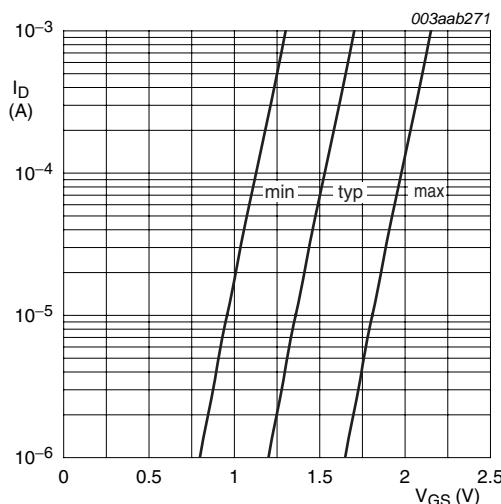

**Fig 9. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**



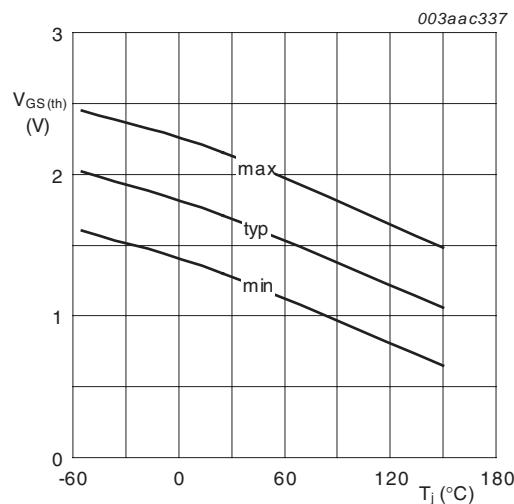

**Fig 10. Input and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**



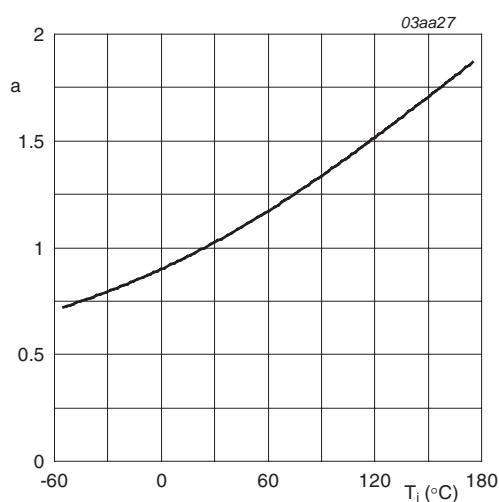

**Fig 11. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage**



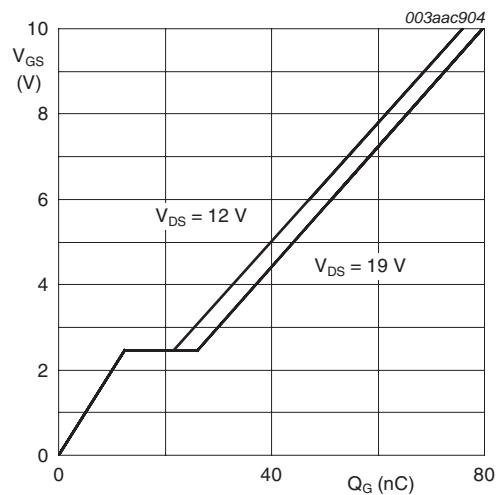

**Fig 12. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature**



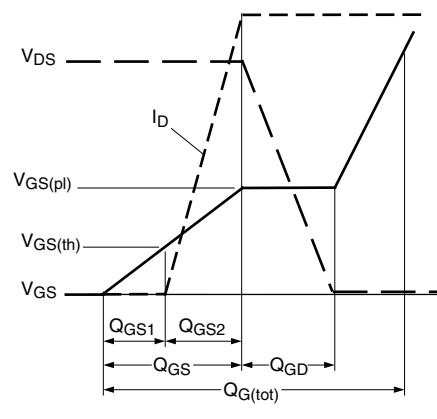

**Fig 13.** Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

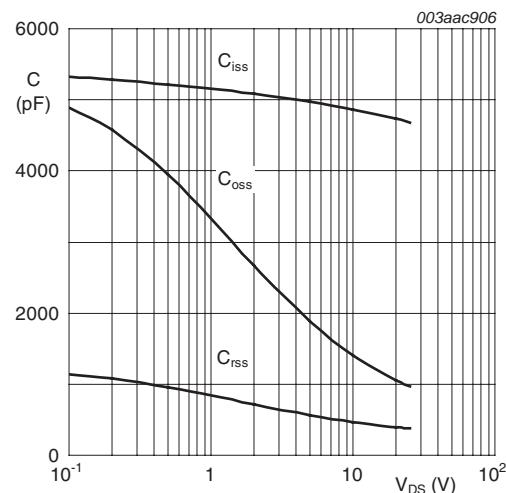

**Fig 15.** Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

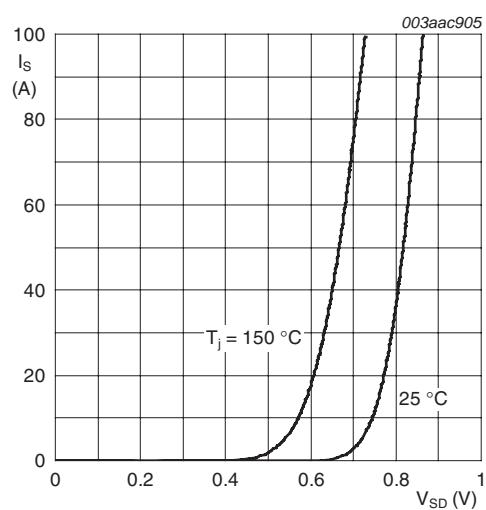


**Fig 14.** Gate charge waveform definitions

**Fig 16.** Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



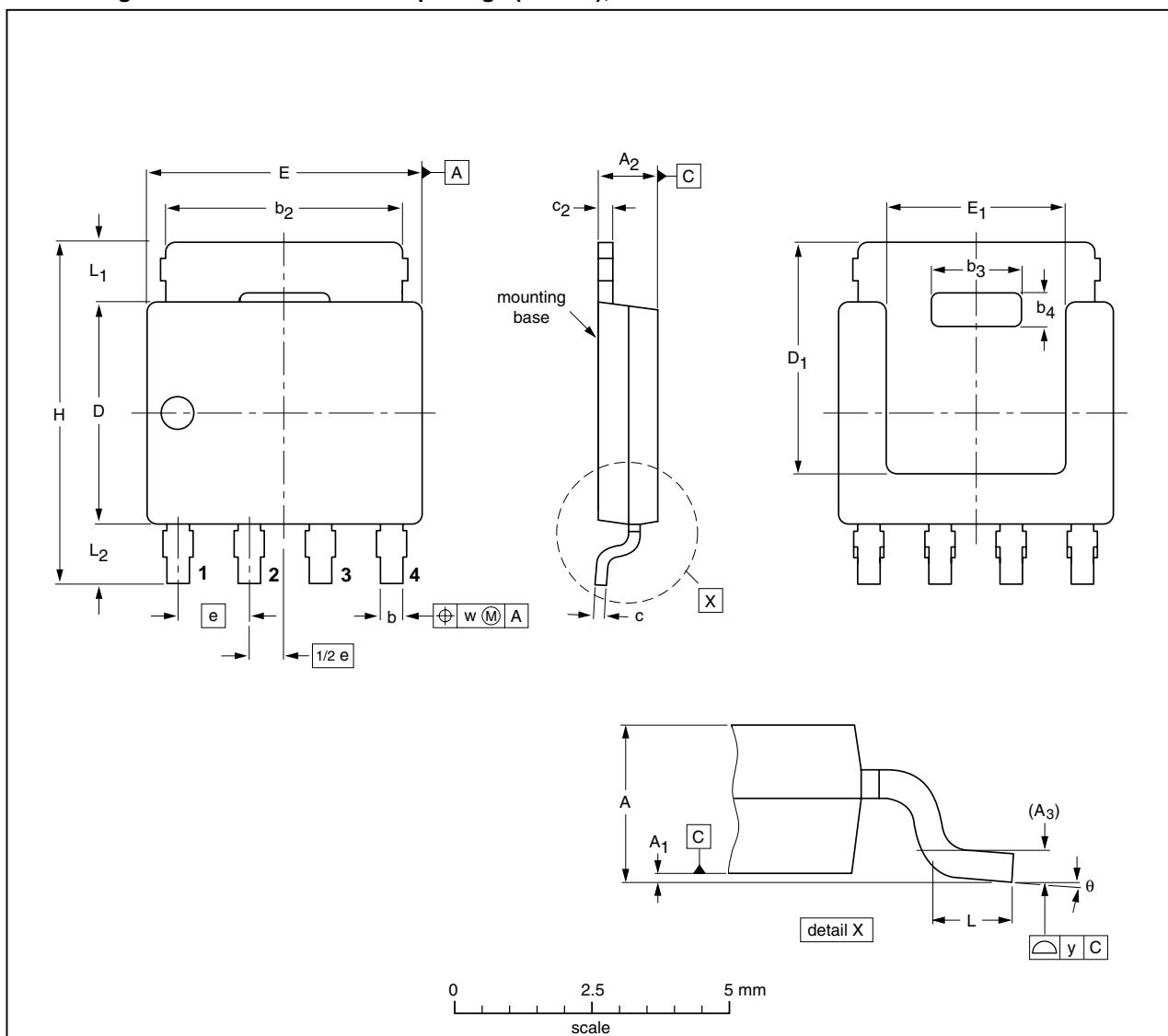
