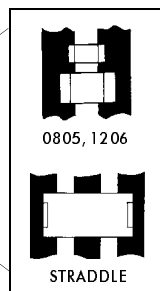
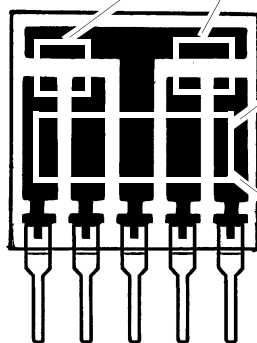
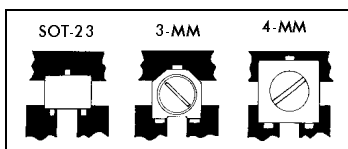

DESIGN SUPPORTS MULTIPLE CIRCUIT APPLICATIONS

The model 6405 can support two 3 terminal devices and several 2 terminal devices. The 6410 repeats the basic pattern twice, and the 6415 three times. The universal mounting zones for 2 and 3 terminal devices support a range of device sizes. The basic pattern provides for the construction of moderate density circuit elements. Foil modifications can create additional component zones or re-configure connection layout. Models 6410 and 6415 support higher density applications.

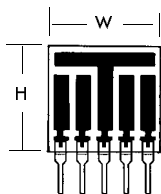


SIP PINS ON .100 in. Centers

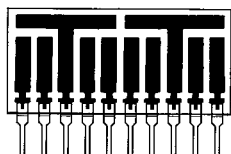

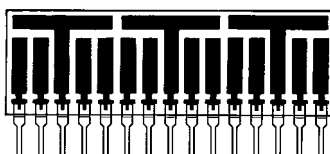

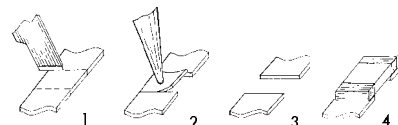

FOIL MODIFICATIONS EXPAND VERSATILITY

Typical of many Surfboards are large pad areas which which may be modified to create additional part mounting zones or expand layout options.

- 1: Score foil with sharp razor to define new zone.
- 2: Apply heat with iron to delaminate foil section.
- 3: New mounting zone has been created.
- 4: Solder component to new mounting zone.
