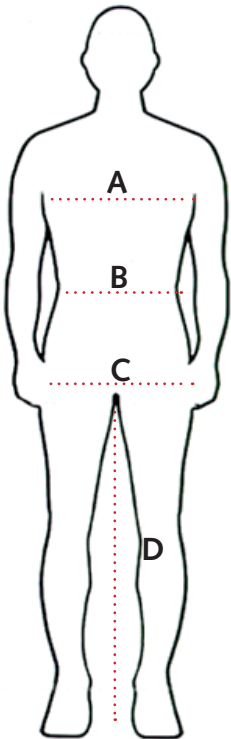
- A. Chest width:

New size chart for S-M-L-sizes (Men's)

For several years now, work has been going on within the European standards organisation CEN to develop a common standard for garment sizes. Providing garments with common size markings will make it easier to choose the right size. The suppliers who choose to adapt themselves to the standard will base their sizes on the same basic data, which will be for your benefit.

The standardisation work has not yet been entirely completed, but we have already started adapting the sizes of our latest collections by changing the base for S-M-L sizes. To make it easier, we have marked the models concerned in the catalogue with our Björnkläder bear. In addition, there is a separate size chart describing what constitutes the differences.
