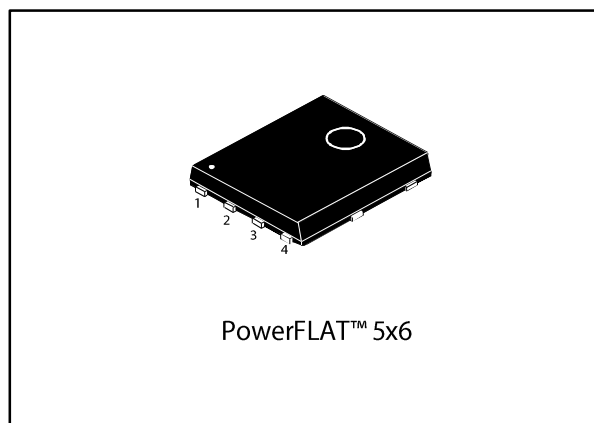
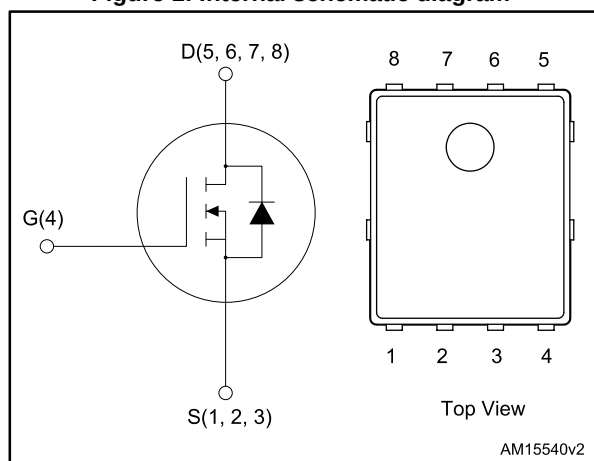


Figure 1: Internal schematic diagram

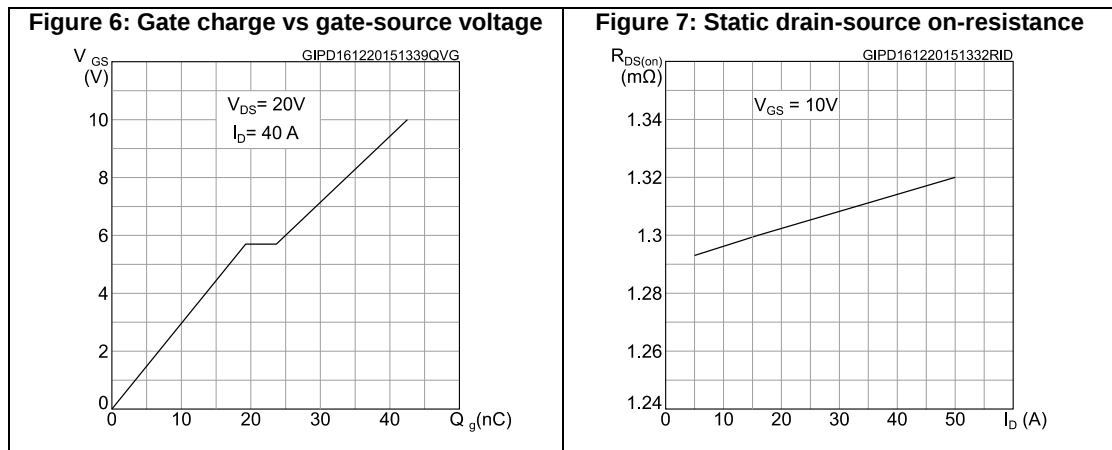
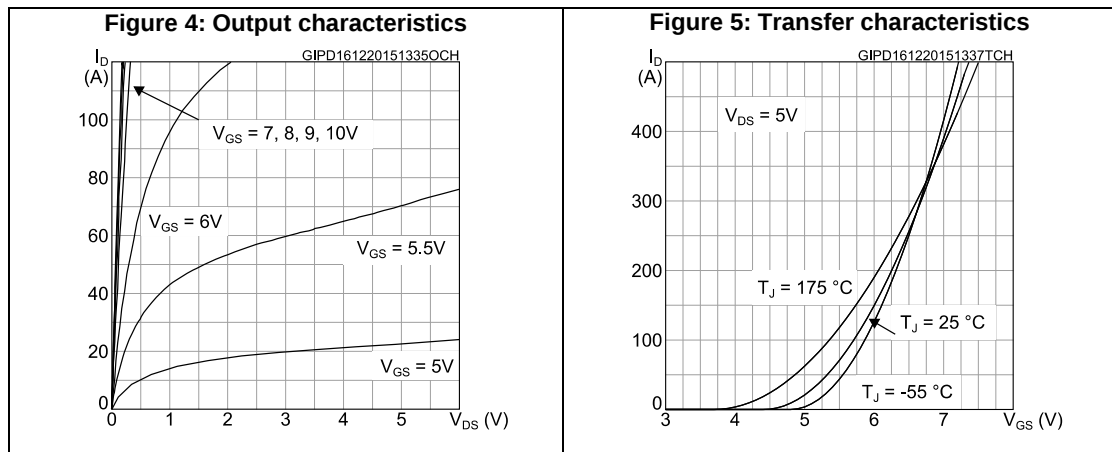
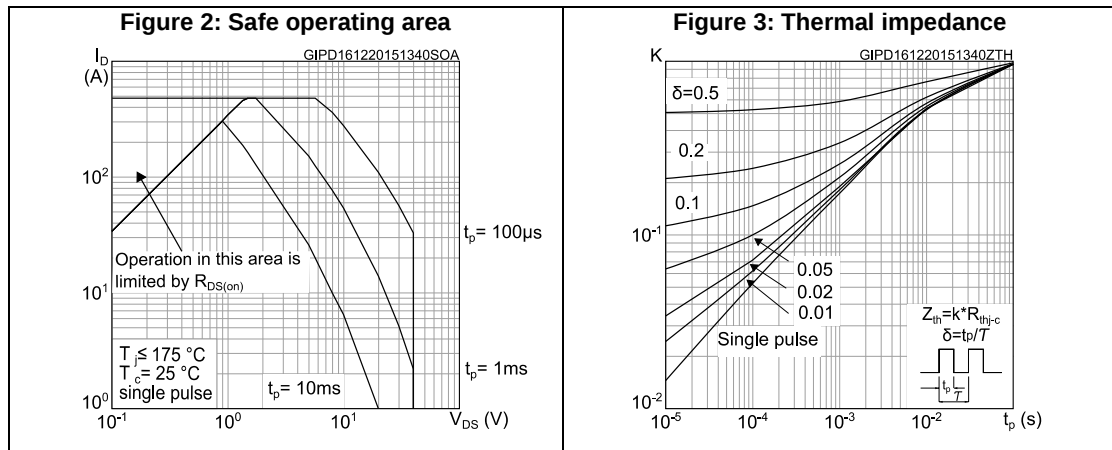


Figure 8: Capacitance variations

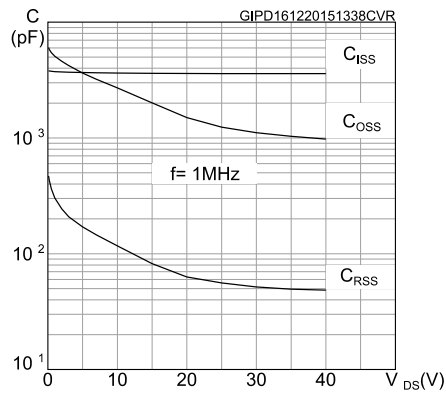


Figure 9: Normalized on-resistance vs temperature

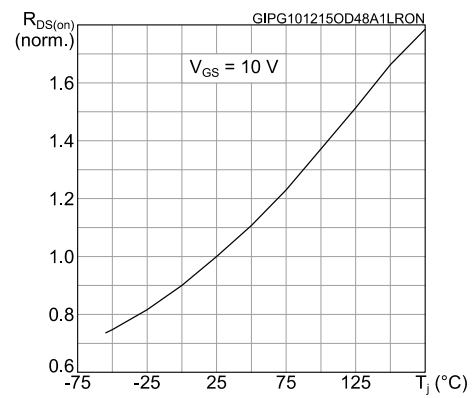
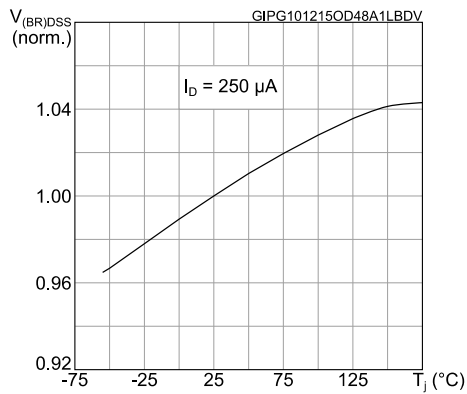
Figure 10: Normalized $V_{(BR)DSS}$ vs temperature

Figure 11: Normalized gate threshold voltage vs temperature

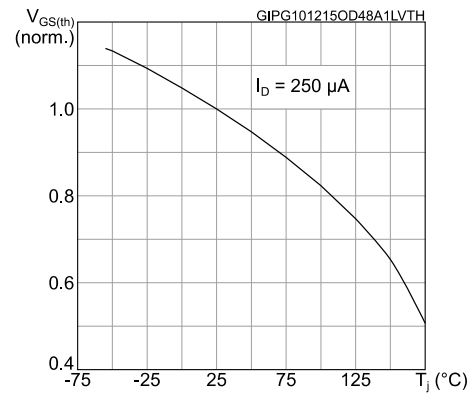
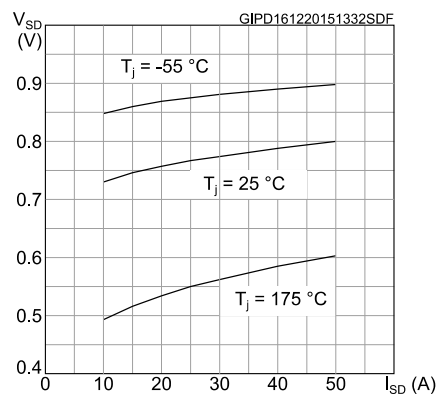
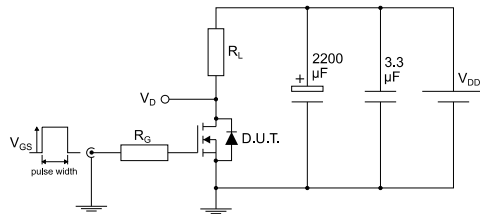


Figure 12: Source-drain diode forward characteristics



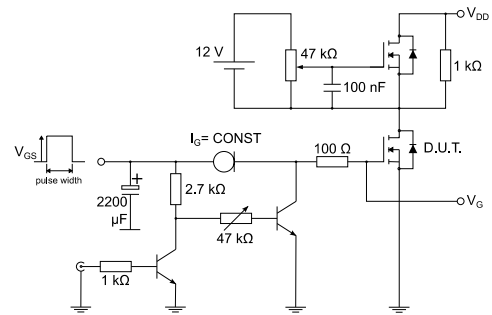

Figure 13: Test circuit for resistive load switching times



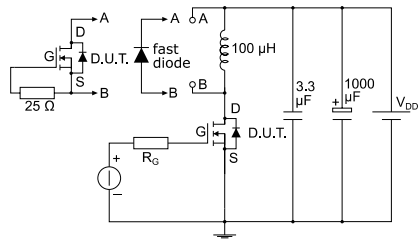
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Figure 14: Test circuit for gate charge behavior



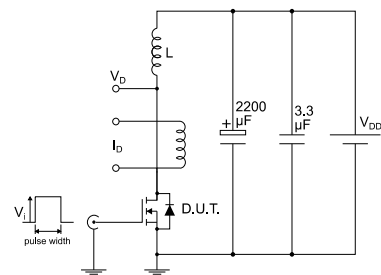
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Figure 15: Test circuit for inductive load switching and diode recovery times



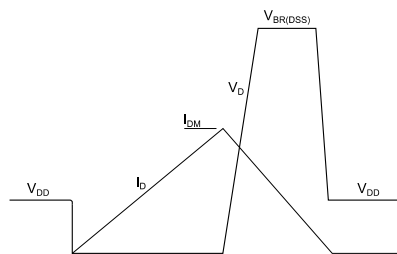
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Figure 16: Unclamped inductive load test circuit



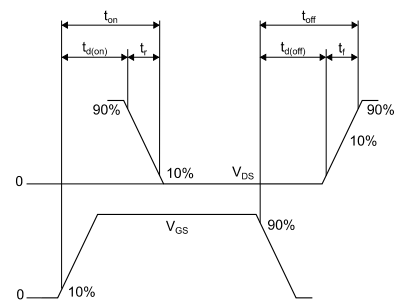
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Figure 17: Unclamped inductive waveform

Figure 19: PowerFLAT™ 5x6 WF type C package outline

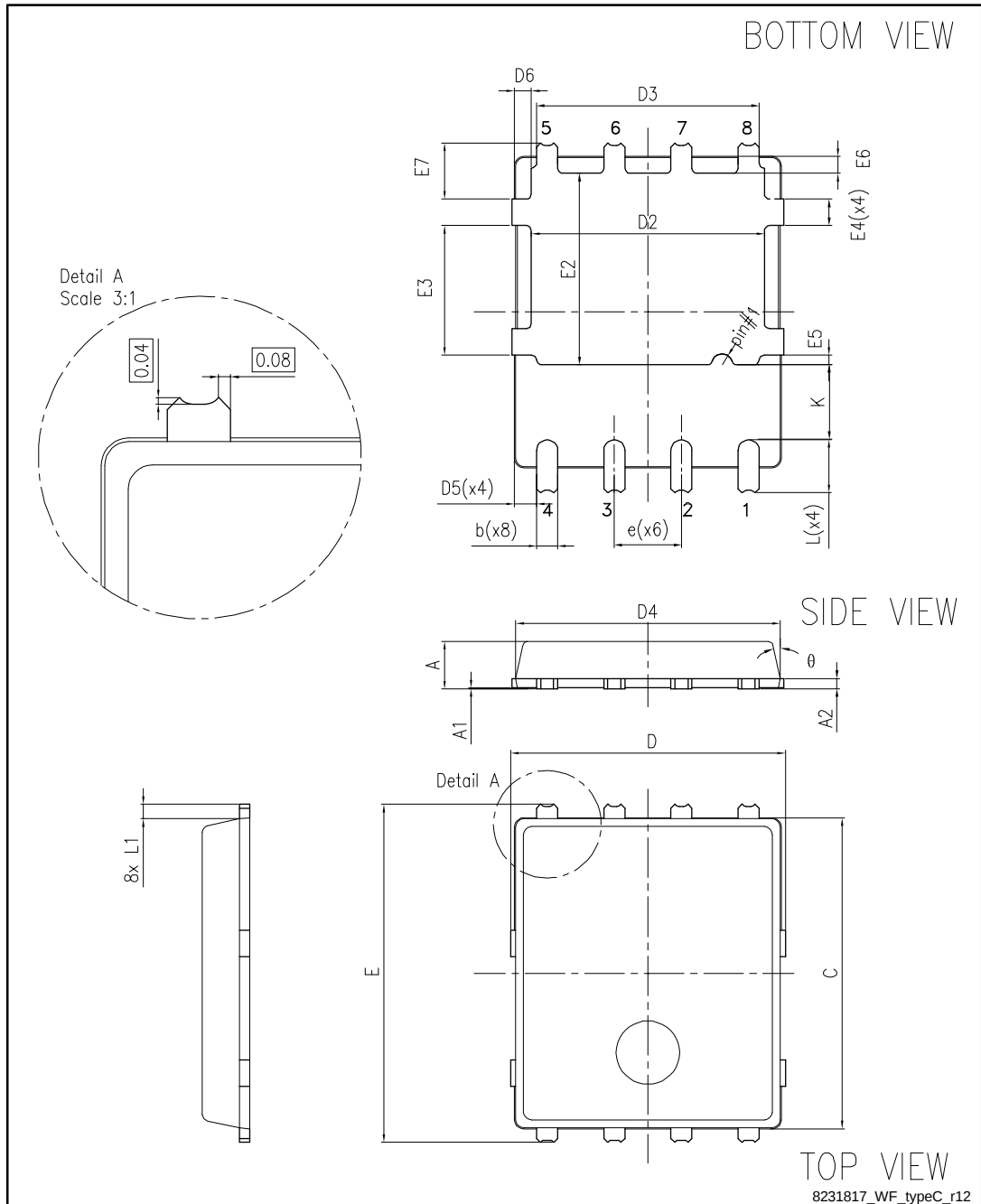

Figure 22: PowerFLAT™ 5x6 package orientation in carrier tape

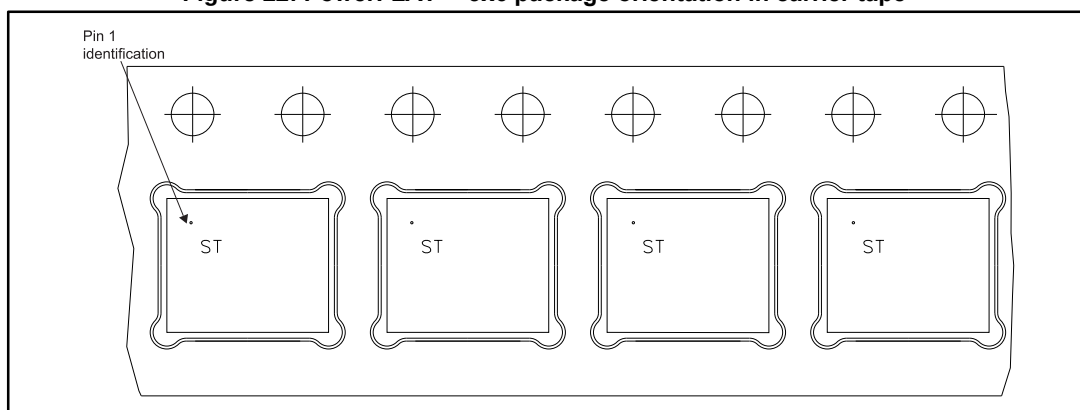
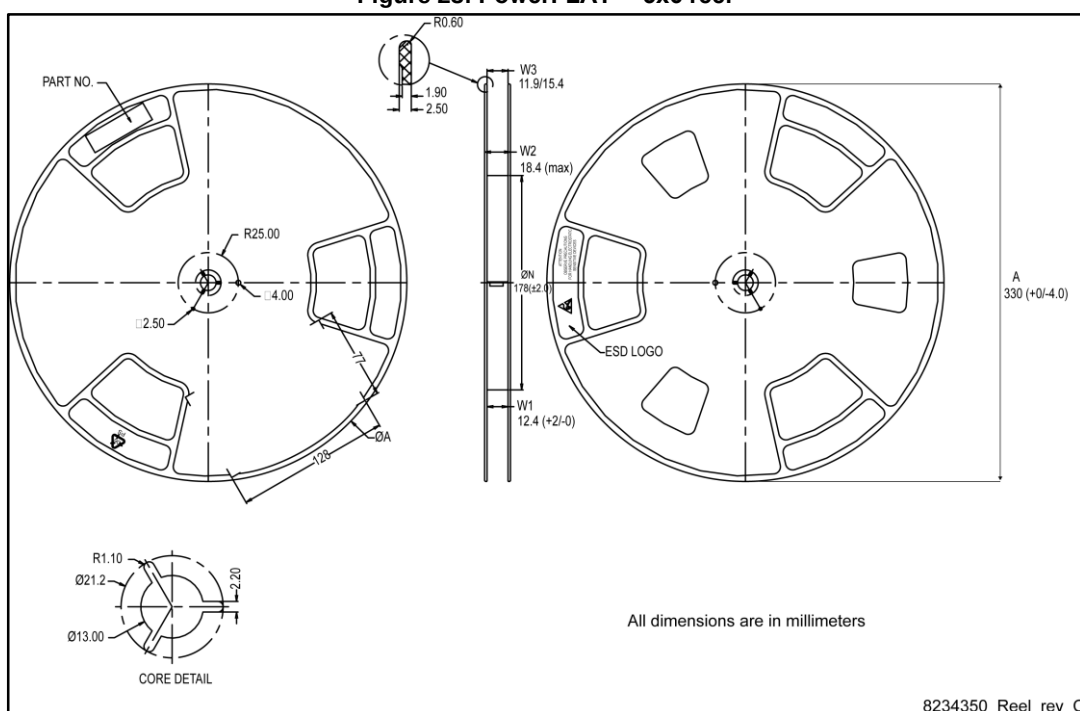


Figure 23: PowerFLAT™ 5x6 reel
