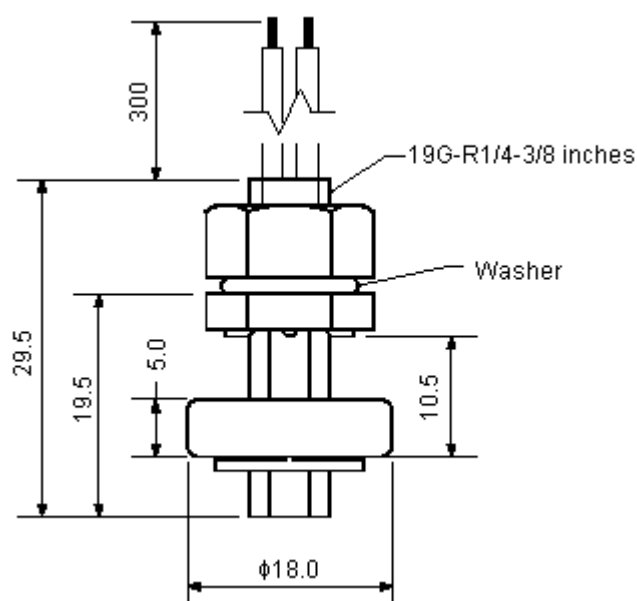
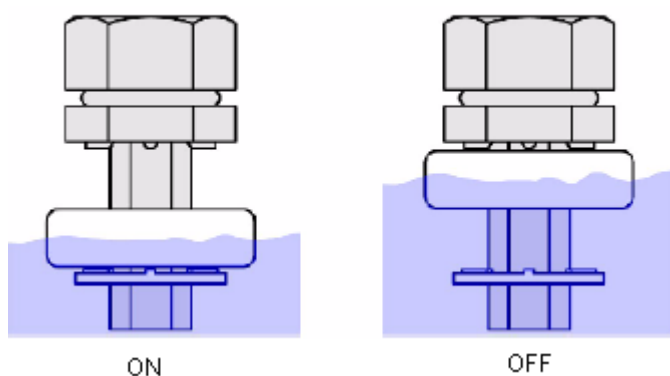


Magnetic Level Sensor
